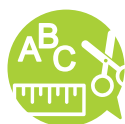

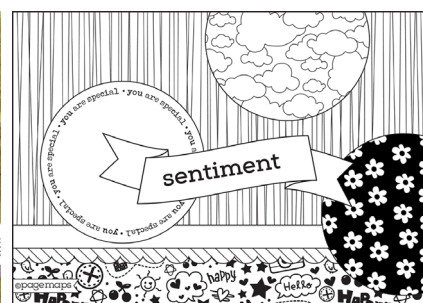

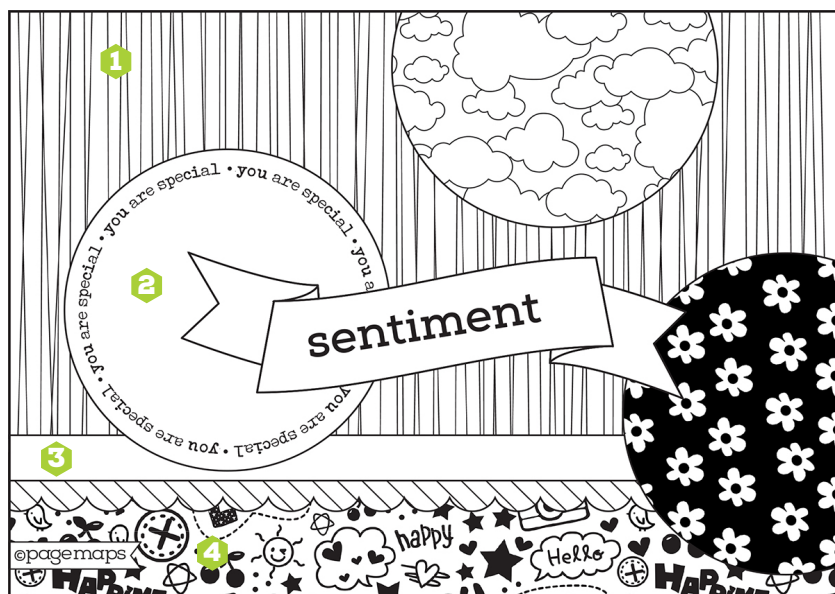
paper trimmer

card dimensions

7" x 5"
opens at bottom





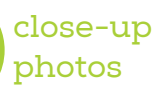
trimming dimensions

- 1 7" x 3.5"
- 2 2.75" dia.
- 3 7" x .5
- 4 7" x 1"



card instructions

- 1 Make a 7"x5" card base from kraft cardstock, with opening on the bottom.
- 2 Trim a 7"x5" piece from corrugated kraft paper.
- 3 Trim a 9" length of green ribbon. Adhere 0.25" from bottom edge of card using double-sided. Wrap ends around back of corrugated piece and secure. Adhere corrugated piece to front of card base.
- 4 Trim a 7" length of green flower trim. Using double-sided, adhere trim above and slightly overlapping green ribbon.
- 5 Using an electronic die cutting machine and PageMaps U cutting file, trim the smallest banner pattern from light yellow cardstock.
- 6 Die cut the largest banner pattern from green cardstock.
- 7 Adhere yellow banner on top of green banner, centered
- 8 Stamp "Thinking of You" sentiment in black ink on the left side of the banner.
- 9 Adhere "Truly amazing in every way" and "Thank" chipboard pieces on right side of banner as shown.
- 10 Adhere banner assembly to card using dimensional adhesive.
- 11 Locate floral pattern chipboard. Adhere, tucked slightly under banner piece as shown.
- 12 Adhere two silver pearls to the body of each butterfly. Adhere butterflies to card.





cutting files

NOTE: cutting files are provided in .svg and .dxf formats and work with most leading electronic die cutters (Silhouette, Boss Kut, Pazzle, etc.). If you do not have an electronic die cutter, you can print this page and hand-cut the shapes with a craft knife or small scissors.
