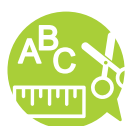

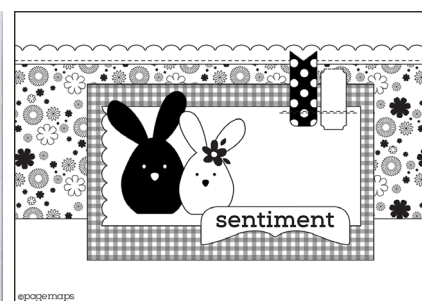

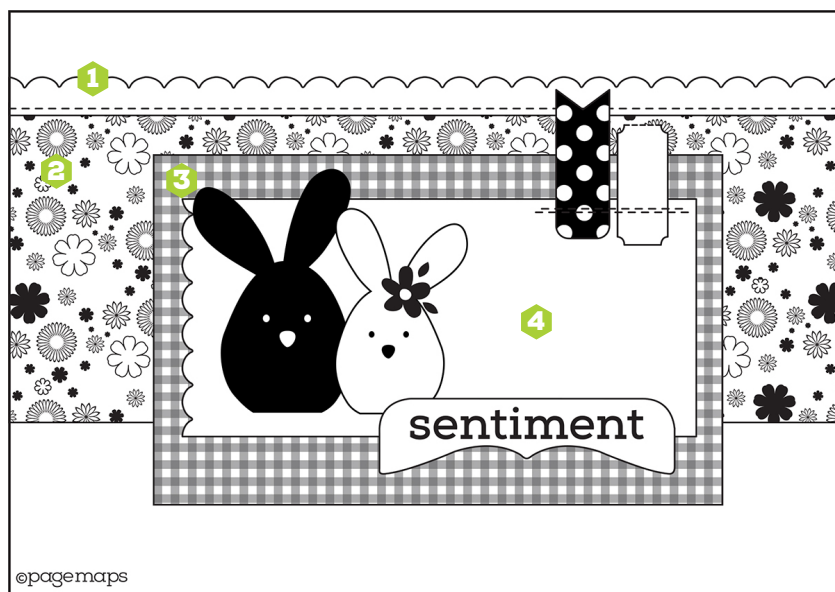


card dimensions

7" x 5"

opens at bottom





trimming dimensions

- 1 7" x .5"
- 2 7" x 2.5"
- 3 4.75" x 3"
- 4 4.25" x 2"



card instructions

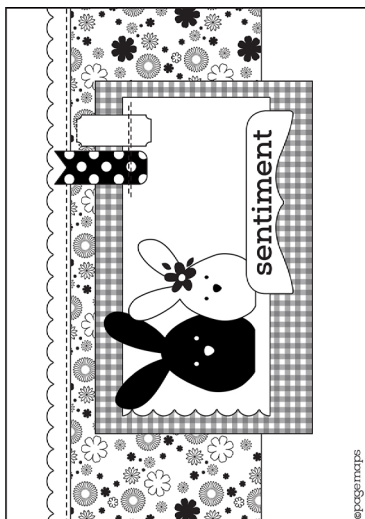
- 1 Make a 5"x7" card base from white cardstock, with opening on the bottom.
- 2 Trim a 4.75"x6.75" piece from lime green cardstock.
- 3 Using a scallop border punch, punch a 4.75" length from textured white cardstock. Trim scallop piece to 4.75"x.25".
- 4 Trim a 3.5"x4.75" piece from Authentique Promise One (pink) patterned paper. Adhere white scallop piece to one long edge. Center over lime green piece with white scallop on the bottom and adhere. Machine-stitch top and bottom edges of pink piece, if desired.
- 5 Trim a 4"x3.75" piece of music note paper from the Authentique Promise 6x6 paper pad. Using a corner rounder, round the top two corners. Adhere to the pink piece with dimensional adhesive, centered.
- 6 Using an oval die or template, cut a 3.5"x2.75" oval from blue gingham paper found in the 6x6 paper pad. Distress edges with walnut ink, if desired. Adhere white pom-pom trim around the back edge of the oval as shown. Adhere to center of music note paper with adhesive tape.
- 7 Using an electronic die cutting machine and PageMaps U cutting files, die cut the large and small bunnies using white cardstock. Using gray chalk ink, shade the edge of each bunny's face. Using pink chalk, shade in two cheeks on each bunny. Attach small brown enamel dots to each bunny for eyes and a medium pink enamel dot to each for a nose. Adhere bunny heads to the top of the blue gingham paper, as shown, using dimensional adhesive.
- 8 Remove "Happy Easter" sentiment banner from die cut sheet. Adhere below the bunny heads.
- 9 Tie a green gingham bow. Using fabric glue, adhere below the bunny heads as shown.
- 10 Adhere orange felt flower to the top right bunny's ear with fabric glue.
