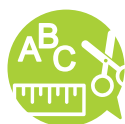

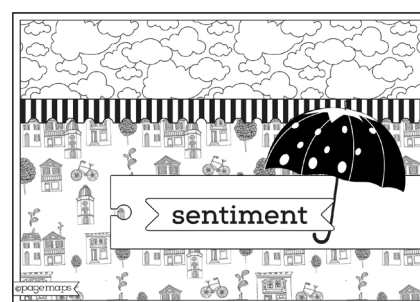

trimming dimensions

- 1 6.75" x 1.5"
- 2 6.75" x .5"
- 3 6.75" x 3.25"
- 4 5.25" x 1.25"

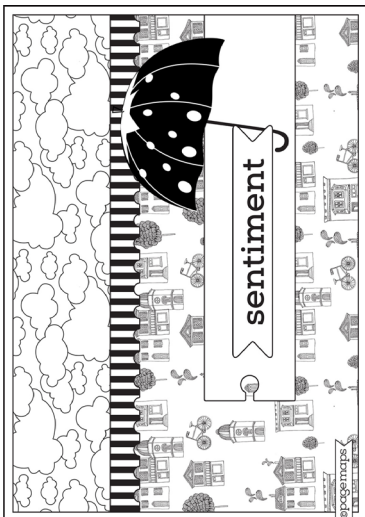


card instructions

- 1 Make a 7"x5" card from kraft cardstock, with the opening on the bottom.
- 2 Trim a 6.75"x1.25" piece of airplane patterned paper. Adhere it to the top of the card using foam adhesive, creating a margin from the kraft base around all three sides.
- 3 Trim a 6.75"x3.625" piece of multi striped patterned paper, with the stripes running vertical.
- 4 Using the Papertrey Ink scalloped bookmark die, die cut the bookmark shape horizontally from the striped piece as shown.
- 5 Adhere the die cut piece directly below the airplane piece using foam adhesive.
- 6 On the exposed kraft base inside the die cut, stamp the number stamp across the lower half using Versamark.
- 7 Carefully sprinkle on red embossing powder, avoiding the numbers you do not want to emboss. Heat emboss with a heat gun.
- 8 Attach fabric brackets from a sheet of alpha stickers around the numbers you want to enhance. If they are not consecutive, add a pair of brackets to each one.
- 9 Spell out "best wishes" above the stamped numbers as shown using micro mini blue alpha stickers.
