- Grout gray, tangerine orange cardstock

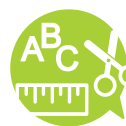

card dimensions

4.25" wide x 5.5" tall, opens on right



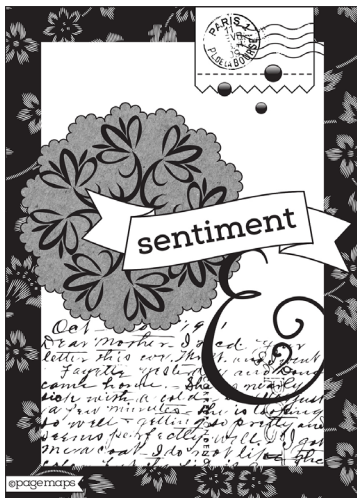
- 1 5" x 7"
- 2 4" x 6"
- 3 1.5" x 1.25"
- 4 3.25" dia.



- 1 Make a 4.25"x5.5" cardbase from grout gray cardstock with the opening on the right.
- 2 Trim a 5"x3.75" piece from white cardstock. Adhere the small chevron stencil onto it and airbrush with Copic markers. Remove stencil and adhere airbrushed piece to card base. (DESIGNER NOTE: As an alternative to the airbrush, use an inking sponge or dauber to apply ink over the stencil.)
- 3 Die cut frame from white cardstock and adhere to card using dimensional adhesive.
- 4 Die cut tab piece from tangy orange cardstock and adhere to top, right of card as shown.
- 5 Die cut two candy jars, one from white cardstock and one from clear acetate. Die cut a stitched circle from gray cardstock.
- 6 Using tangy orange, gumdrop green, grout gray and blueberry dye inks, stamp jellybeans in the white die cut jar. Die cut a few extra jellybeans from colored cardstock to add outside of the jar.
- 7 Electronically die cut top and bottom layers of the sentiment banner from white cardstock. Using blueberry and tangy orange inks, stamp sentiment onto top layer. Adhere top layer to bottom layer.
- 8 Using a sponge dauber, ink the edges of the candy jar and the sentiment strip with gray ink.
- 9 Adhere acetate die cut to the front of the stamped candy jar with wet adhesive. Adhere lid to jar.
- 10 Tie orange/white baker's twine into a bow and adhere it to the bottom of the jar. Adhere a small piece of baker's twine to the top edge of the orange tab as shown.
- 11 Finish gray button with baker's twine and adhere button to tab.
- 12 Using dimensional adhesive, adhere gray circle, candy jar ensemble, jelly beans and sentiment banner as shown.
