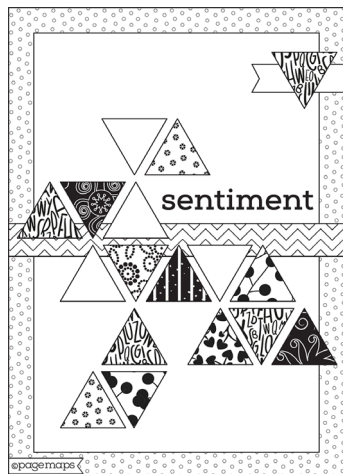

**basic
tools**

Favorite adhesive

Paper trimmer

Dimensional adhesive

Wet adhesive or glue dots

Scallop border punch

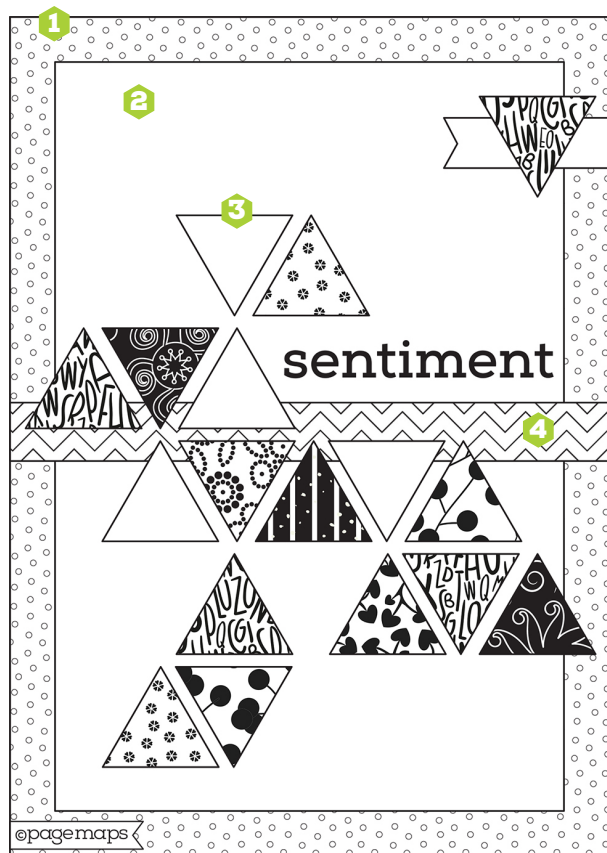
1" circle punch

Spellbinders pinwheel die (optional)
electronic or manual die cutter



**card
dimensions**

4.5" wide x 6.5" tall, opens on right



trimming dimensions

- 1 5" x 7"
- 2 4.25" x 6.25"
- 3 1" tall triangle
- 4 5" x .75"

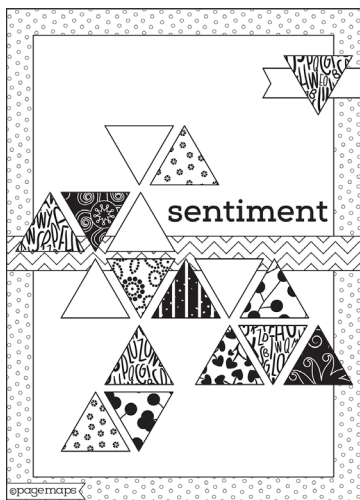


card instructions

- 1 Make a 4.5" x 6.5" white card base with the opening on the right.
- 2 Trim a 4.5"x6.5" piece from yellow wood-grain paper. Trim a 3.75"x5.5" piece from pink/teal diamond paper.
- 3 Trim a 3.5"x5.25" piece from green geometric paper and machine stitch around the perimeter.
- 4 Adhere the green piece onto the center of the pink/teal block, then adhere entire ensemble to the center of the card.
- 5 Trim a 6"x1" strip of teal/white circles paper and a piece of white trim to the same length. Punch a scallop border along one long edge of the teal/white piece. Adhere trim to the top edge of the teal/white scallop piece. Wrap ensemble around card as shown and adhere.
- 6 Punch five 1" circles. Adhere to card in random pattern.
- 7 Adhere tree branch and bird with dimensional adhesive.
- 8 Using either the Spellbinders pinwheel die or the PMU exclusive electronic cutting file, die cut five pinwheels from teal/pink patterned paper. Fold pinwheels and adhere tips in the center using wet adhesive or glue dot. Cover centers with self-adhesive gray pearls. Adhere completed pinwheels to card as shown.
- 9 Double 8" of yellow baker's twine and tie into a bow. Open up the prongs on the back of a large decorative brad. Position the bow between the prongs and close the prongs. Pierce the prongs through the front panel ensemble as shown and open the prongs to secure.
- 10 Adhere the entire front panel assembly to the card base.

NOTE: cutting files are provided in .silhouette, .svg and .dxf formats and work with most leading electronic die cutters (Silhouette, Boss Kut, Cricuit Explorer, Pazzle, etc.) that can open these file formats. If you do not have an electronic die cutter, you can print this page and hand-cut the shapes with a craft knife or small scissors.
