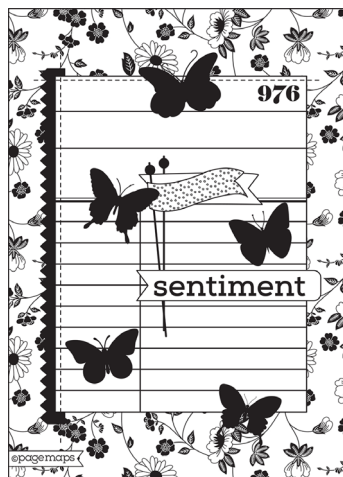

Neenah solar white cardstock

Maya Road:

- butterfly transparency, white

- 6mm and 4 mm sequins

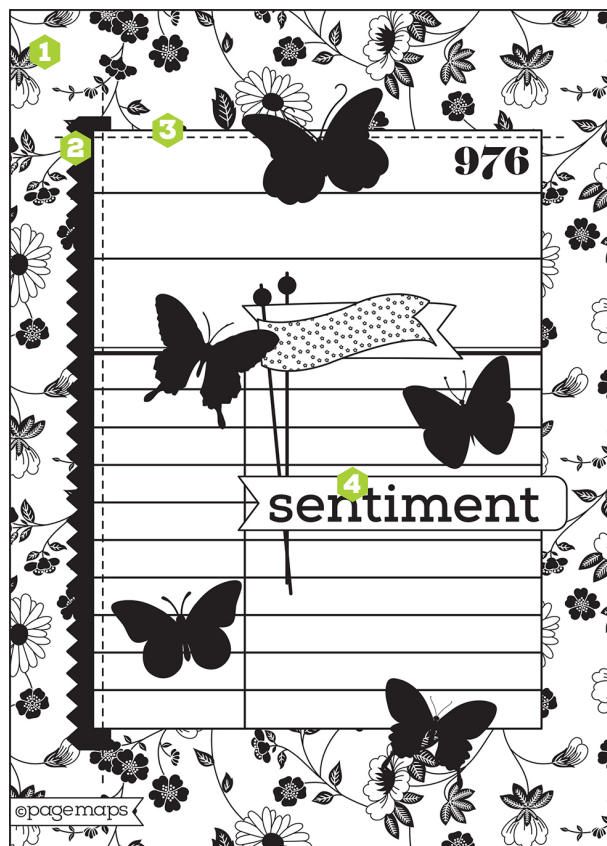

Sewing thread (rose)



card dimensions

4.25" wide x 5.5" tall, opens on right



trimming dimensions

- 1 5" x 7"
- 2 .375" x 5.25"
- 3 3.75" x 5"
- 4 2.75" x .5



card instructions

- 1 Make a 4.25"x5.5" card base from rose red cardstock with opening on the right.
- 2 Trim a 4"x5.25" piece of floral patterned paper. Adhere it to the center of the card.
- 3 Trim a .75"x5" piece of rose red cardstock. Die cut one long edge with the pinking edge die.
- 4 Trim a 2.5"x3.5" piece of striped yellow patterned paper.
- 5 Electronically die cut your focal floral rectangle from white cardstock.
- 6 Place die cut rectangle over a piece of vellum and, using a pencil, trace the outside of the flowers onto the vellum. Cutting just inside the pencil lines, hand cut the vellum flowers. Adhere the vellum flowers to the backs the flowers on the white die cut piece using small amounts of wet adhesive.
- 7 Adhere the yellow patterned paper piece to the back of the die cut piece using a sewing machine-friendly adhesive or your favorite dry adhesive used sparingly.
- 8 Machine or hand stitch around the border of the die cut piece as shown.
- 9 Trim a 2.75"x3.75" piece of coastal cabana cardstock. Adhere white die cut piece to the center.
- 10 Trial position the die cut ensemble on the front of the card base. Locate the position for the pinked, cardstock strip. Lightly adhere and stitch strip to card base. Adhere die cut ensemble to card front, slightly overlapping the pinked strip.
- 11 Electronically cut the banner shape from coastal cabana cardstock. Using a powder tool, prep banner for embossing. Stamp sentiment onto banner and heat emboss with white embossing powder.
- 12 Wrap 6-7" of thread around your fingers. Remove thread and adhere loose circles to back of banner with a small amount of adhesive. Adhere banner/thread piece as shown.
- 13 Adhere sequins and butterfly transparency using wet adhesive.



custom color sequins



Gather your supplies: clear sequins, a Copic pen of your color choice (or other alcohol pen), dry adhesive.



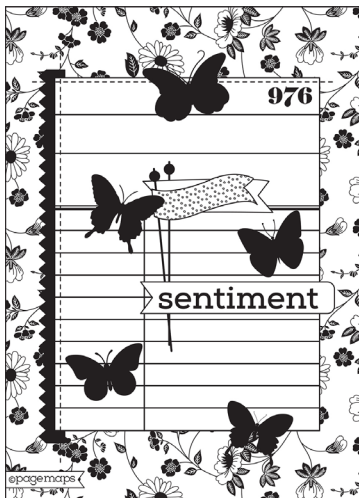
Place a line of dry adhesive across a scrap of paper. Adhere the sequins to the adhesive, cup side up.



Color the sequins with the brush end of the Copic pen and allow them to dry. Adhere to your project with a dab of wet adhesive.

cutting files

NOTE: cutting files are provided in .silhouette, .svg and .dxf formats and work with most leading electronic die cutters (Silhouette, Boss Kut, Cricuit Explorer, Pazzle, etc.) that can open these file formats. If you do not have an electronic die cutter, you can print this page and hand-cut the shapes with a craft knife or small scissors.
