### basic tools

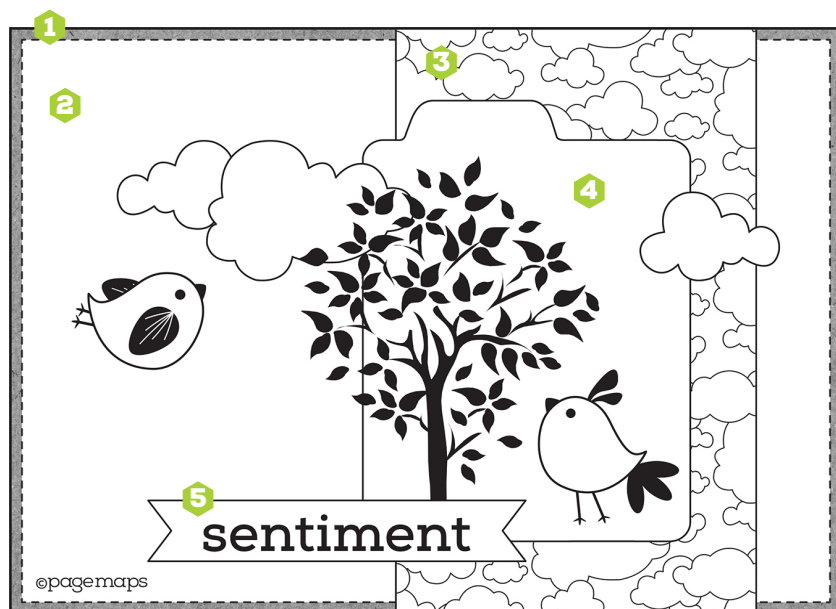
Favorite adhesive  
Wet craft adhesive  
Clear adhesive  
Glue dots  
Paper trimmer  
Butterfly punch  
Electronic die cutter



### card dimensions

7" x 5" tall,  
opens at the bottom





### trimming dimensions

- 1 7" x 5" (base)
- 2 6.75" x 4.75"
- 3 3" x 5"
- 4 2.75" x 3.75"
- 5 3" x .5"



### card instructions

- 1 Make a 7"x5" card base from kraft cardstock, with the opening on the bottom.
- 2 Trim a 7"x5" piece of light green herringbone paper and adhere to the card base.
- 3 Using clear adhesive, adhere a 7"x5" photo overlay, with gold dot border, onto the front of the card.
- 4 Trim a 6"x4" journal card and mat onto kraft cardstock, leaving a thin border. Center and adhere to the front of the card.
- 5 Locate the green/white stripe tag and insert a decorative yellow brad through the tag hole. Adhere the tag to the card, offset to the right.
- 6 Adhere the wood veneer frame over the tag, using craft glue or pop dots.
- 7 Adhere cluster of multi-color hearts to the left of the wood veneer frame.
- 8 Resize the PageMaps cutting file "Thinking of You" to 2.005"x3.885". Die cut the sentiment on peach dot paper. Cut a shadow mat from yellow damask paper with an offset factor of .075". Adhere the sentiment to the shadow mat. Adhere entire piece across the wood veneer frame.
- 9 Punch out six butterflies from the Sunburst (gold side) paper. Create dimensional butterflies by layering one on top of another and adhering with a glue pen along the midline. Flick up the wings to give the effect of flight.
- 10 Remove the banners from the sticker sheet and cut them down to create five shorter length banners. Attach them across the top, left edge of the journal card piece. Adhere enamel dots to card as desired.

## cutting files

NOTE: cutting files are provided in .silhouette, .svg and .dxf formats and work with most leading electronic die cutters (Silhouette, Boss Kut, Cricuit Explorer, Pazzle, etc.) that can open these file formats. If you do not have an electronic die cutter, you can print this page and hand-cut the shapes with a craft knife or small scissors.
