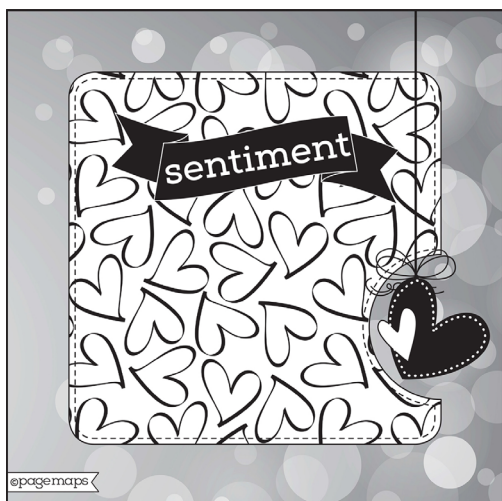

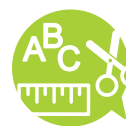

5" square, opens on bottom





### trimming dimensions

- 1 6" x 6" (base card)
- 2 4.5" x 4.5"
- 3 3.5" x 1"
- 4 1.25" x 1.25"



### card instructions

- 1 Make a 5" square card base from white cardstock, with the opening on the right.
- 2 Trim a 5" square piece of Medallion (multi-color side) patterned paper. Adhere it to the front of the card base.
- 3 Trim a 3.75" square piece of white cardstock. Round the top, right and bottom, left corners.
- 4 Trim a 3.5" square piece of Medallion (pink side) patterned paper. Round the top, right and bottom, left corners. Adhere the pink piece to the white cardstock piece, centered.
- 5 Locate the round blue die cut from the Die Cuts and Transparencies pack and adhere to the right edge of the pink/white panel, allowing approximately 1/3 of the die cut to overlap the edge. Trim away the excess (over-hanging) portion of the die cut. Adhere entire panel to the card base with dimensional adhesive.
- 6 Locate flower die cut. Center and adhere to round blue die cut with dimensional adhesive.
- 7 Locate the "just loving life" die cut and trim away the kraft/green striped edge. Save sentiment piece. Trim the ends of the kraft/green piece so that they are straight. Tuck one end under the bottom of the flower to create a stem and adhere in place. Trim away any excess.
- 8 Adhere the "just loving life" sentiment to the top, left corner of the pink patterned paper piece.
- 9 Locate the leaf transparency. Place a glue dot on the back bottom (rounded) edge. Adhere leaf to a scrap piece of white cardstock. Fussy cut around the leaf. Tuck the leaf underneath the flower stem at an angle and adhere.
- 10 Tie a double bow from baker's twine and adhere it to the flower stem.
