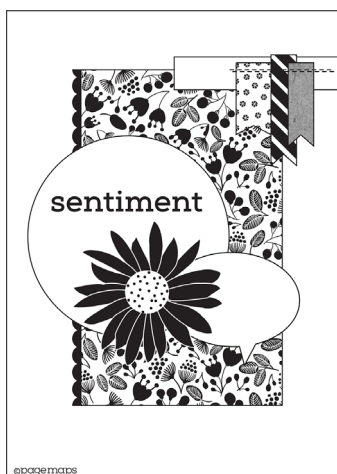

### suggested supplies

Crate Paper Notes & Things:

- 6x6 paper pad

Dear Lizzy:

- Chipboard shapes
- Epoxy stickers

Dear Lizzy Day Dreamer:

- 6x6 paper pad
- Freckled Fawn alpha stickers  
Kraft cardstock  
PMU exclusive die cutting file



### basic tools

Favorite adhesive

Paper trimmer

Dimensional adhesive

Electronic die cutter

Scallop border punch

3" circle punch/die

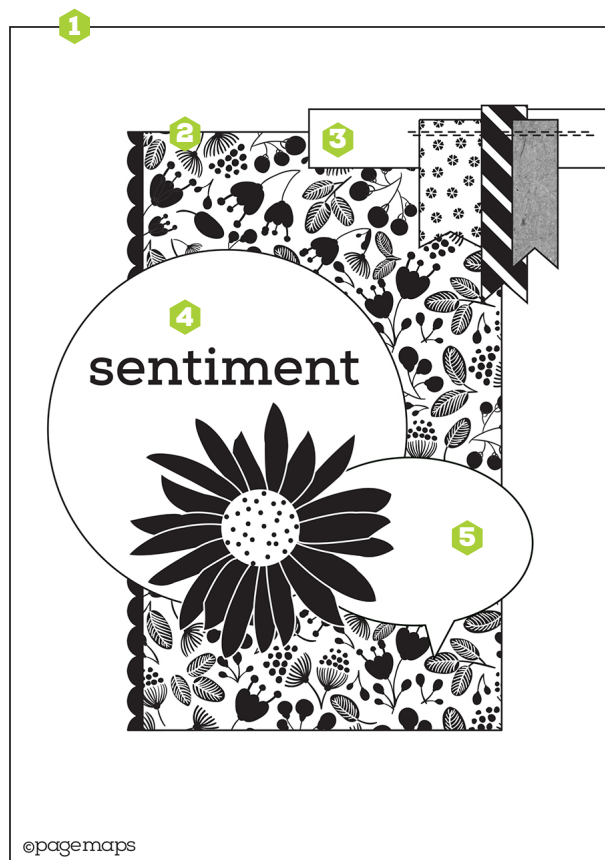
Tan thread

Paper piercer (optional)



### card dimensions

3.75" x 5.25", opens on the right



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## card instructions

- 1 Make a 4.25" x 5.5" card base from kraft cardstock, with the opening on the right.
- 2 Trim a 3" x 5" piece of Crate Paper Notes & Things floral paper. Adhere it to the front of the card, 1/2" in from the left edge and 3/8" down from the top edge.
- 3 Trim a .25"x5" piece of Crate Paper Notes & Things teal/white dot paper. Using a scallop border punch, punch one long edge. Adhere it directly to the left of the floral piece.
- 4 Trim a 2.5" x .5" strip of multi diagonal paper. Cut a v-notch into the left end. Adhere it to the top of the card, 1/2" down from the top edge and flush with the right edge.
- 5 Punch or die cut a 3" circle from Dear Lizzy Day Dream light blue paper. Hand or machine stitch around the interior edge using tan/kraft thread.
- 6 Adhere it to the left edge of the card, 2" down from the top edge and allowing 1/2" of the circle to fall off the left edge. Trim the excess.
- 7 Using the PMU exclusive die cutting file, die cut the smaller speech bubble from Crate Paper Notes & Things peach/white dotted paper. Cut the larger speech bubble from Dear Lizzy Day Dreamer light pink paper. Adhere the two together.
- 8 Spell out sentiment across the center of the speech bubble. Hand or machine sew a straight stitch horizontally through the letter stickers using tan/kraft thread.
- 9 Adhere the speech bubble to the top of the blue circle, 1.25" down from the top edge and 1/2" in from the left edge.
- 10 Adhere the Dear Lizzy chipboard typewriter to the bottom of the card, 1/2" in from the right edge and 3/4" up from the bottom edge.
- 11 Using scrap papers of your choice, trim four small strips of 1/2" wide paper ranging from 1" to 1.5" long. Cut a v-notch into the bottom of each strip.
- 12 Referring to the photo, adhere the strips across the diagonal striped piece, overlapping as shown. Hand or machine sew a straight stitch horizontally through the pennants using tan/kraft thread.
- 13 Add a small light pink epoxy heart to the left of the typewriter and a small light pink and dark pink epoxy heart to the pennants as shown.



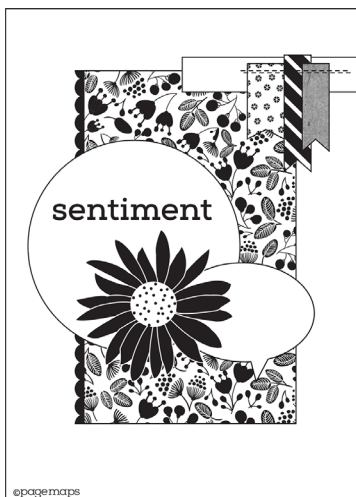
## trimming dimensions

- 1 5" x 7" base card
- 2 3" x 5"
- 3 2.5" x .5"
- 4 3" dia.
- 5 2" x 1.5"

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## cutting files

NOTE: cutting files are provided in .silhouette, .svg and .dxf formats and work with most leading electronic die cutters (Silhouette, Boss Kut, Cricuit Explorer, Pazzle, etc.) that can open these file formats. If you do not have an electronic die cutter, you can print this page and hand-cut the shapes with a craft knife or small scissors.
