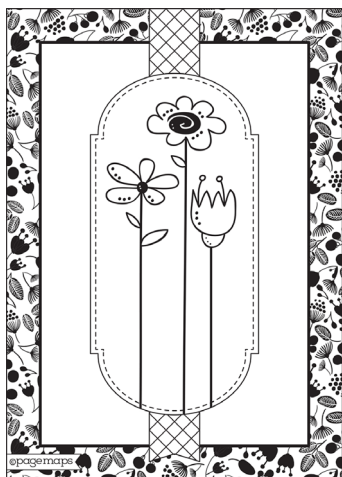

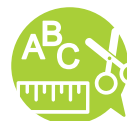

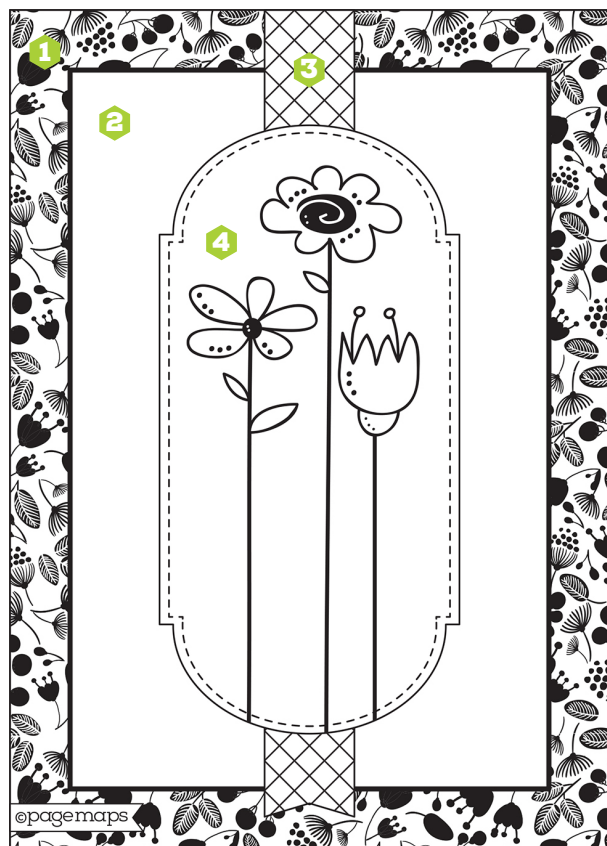

card dimensions

4.25" x 5.5", opens on the right





trimming dimensions

- 1 5" x 7" base card
- 2 4" x 6"
- 3 .75" x 6.75"
- 4 2.5" x 5"

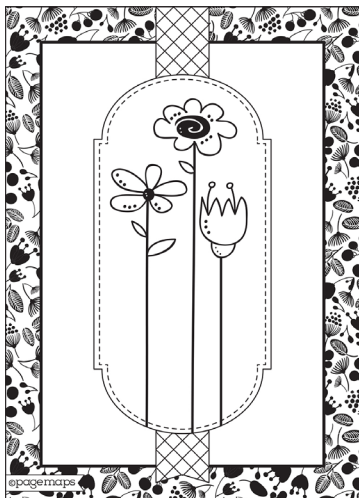


card instructions

- 1 Make a 4.25"x5.5" card base from white cardstock, with the opening on the bottom.
- 2 Trim a 4"x5.25" piece from blue hexagon paper.
- 3 Trim two pieces of white cardstock, one 3.25"x4.5" and the other 3"x4.25".
- 4 Adhere small brick stencil to the 3"x4.25" piece of white cardstock. Spread texture paste evenly over the stencil and wipe off excess. Allow to dry completely. Remove stencil.
- 5 Adhere the textured brick piece to the 3.25"x4.5" piece of white cardstock, centered.
- 6 Center seam binding vertically onto the center of the textured brick piece. Wrap the seam binding over the bottom edge of the brick piece and adhere to the back side.
- 7 Center the textured piece onto the blue patterned piece and adhere. Wrap the loose end of the seam binding over the top edge of the blue piece and adhere to the back side.
- 8 Adhere the textured brick/blue hexagon panel to the card base, centered.
- 9 Using X-Press It Blending Card and the Page-Maps cutting file, electronically die cut the focal label.
- 10 Stamp the lilac image onto the label with tuxedo black ink and color with Copic markers. Color the areas behind or in between the lilac blooms with BV25 and C5 markers (darker in shadow areas). Color the blooms in the foreground with V12, RV55 and RV66 markers. Center each bloom with a white glaze pen dot. Add color to the background with BG000 and the Colorless Blender, blending from the image outward.
- 11 Using tuxedo black ink, stamp sentiment in top, right corner of the focal label. Center and adhere the label to the card with dimensional adhesive. Adhere three blue enamel dots below the sentiment.

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cutting files

NOTE: cutting files are provided in .silhouette, .svg and .dxf formats and work with most leading electronic die cutters (Silhouette, Boss Kut, Cricuit Explorer, Pazzle, etc.) that can open these file formats. If you do not have an electronic die cutter, you can print this page and hand-cut the shapes with a craft knife or small scissors.
