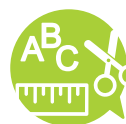

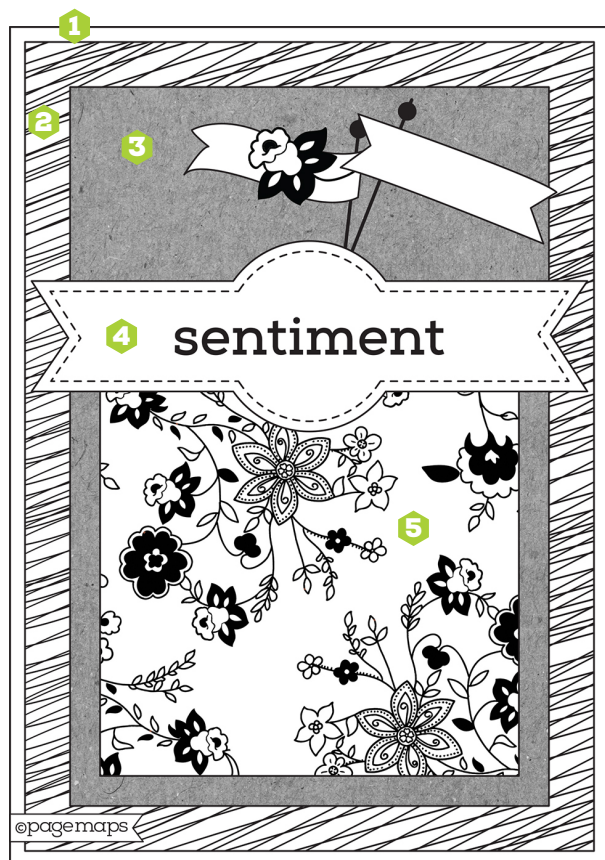

### card dimensions

5" x 7", opens on the right



### trimming dimensions

- 1 5" x 7" base card
- 2 4.75" x 6.75"
- 3 4" x 6"
- 4 4.5" x 1.5"
- 5 3.5" x 3.5"



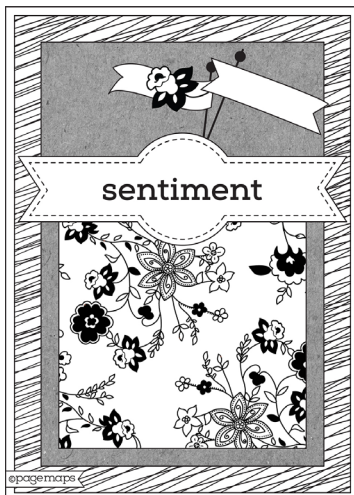
### card instructions

- 1 Make a 5"x7" card base from yellow cardstock.
- 2 Trim a 4.5"x6.5" piece from yellow chevron paper. Using dimensional adhesive, adhere to card base, centered.
- 3 Trim a 3.75"x5.75" piece of white cardstock. Add faux stitching along the perimeter with a brown pen. Center and adhere the white cardstock piece to the front of the card with dimensional adhesive.
- 4 Trim a 3.5" square piece from pink cloud paper. Center left to right on the white cardstock piece and adhere .25" from the bottom edge.
- 5 Using an electronic die cutter, cut the sentiment from white cardstock and the sentiment banner from pink cardstock.
- 6 Add faux stitching along the perimeter of the pink banner with brown pen. Adhere the sentiment to the center of the banner. Layer the banner over the top edge of the pink cloud piece and adhere with dimensional adhesive.
- 7 Locate the white and yellow sticker tags. Attach the white sticker tag to a piece of pink chevron washi tape. Trim tape to fit.
- 8 Slide each sticker tag onto its own stick pin. Insert the stick pins into the dimensional adhesive behind the sentiment banner. Secure the sticker tags with dimensional adhesive positioned on the backs of the stickers.
- 9 Attach the yellow crocheted heart to the lower, right corner of the card. Add two self-adhesive pearls.

NOTE: cutting files are provided in .silhouette, .svg and .dxf formats and work with most leading electronic die cutters (Silhouette, Boss Kut, Cricuit Explorer, Pazzle, etc.) that can open these file formats. If you do not have an electronic die cutter, you can print this page and hand-cut the shapes with a craft knife or small scissors.
