

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## BIRTHDAY TUNNEL CARD by Becky Fleck



### suggested supplies

- Crate Paper Confetti
- 6x6 paper pad (typewriter words)
- Bazzill Basics cardstock:
- three shades of yellow
- Sassy Cheryl's digital stamp:
- Sneaky Bear cupcake
- Tim Holtz Distress Ink reinkers (variety)
- Tim Holtz Distress ink pad
- scattered straw
- 90# watercolor paper
- PageMaps Exclusive Cutting Files



### basic tools

- Favorite adhesive
- Paper trimmer
- Wet adhesive
- Foam adhesive
- Fine-tipped scissors
- Inking sponge
- Color pencils, pens, inks (your choice)
- Electronic die cutter



### card dimensions

4.25" wide x 5.5" tall  
opens on right





### Designer Notes:

- 1 Inking the edges of the component pieces is optional and should be done before assembling the card.
- 2 To design card with less bulk, use scraps of chipboard in place of foam adhesive.
- 1 Make a 4.25"x5.5" card base from dark yellow cardstock with opening on the right.
- 2 Open the exclusive Week 2 electronic die cutting file. Die cut the following pieces:
  - small circle base from dark yellow cardstock
  - med circle piece from med yellow cardstock
  - large circle piece from light yellow cardstock
  - x-large circle piece from typewriter paper
- 3 Score the small circle base at 4.25" and fold it in half. This will be your card base.
- 4 Trim a 4"x5.25" piece of white cardstock (or a paper medium that works with the type of coloring technique you plan to use for your stamp image). For this example, the piece was cut from 90# watercolor paper.
- 5 Determine the position of your stamp image so that a portion of the design shows through the small hole on the front flap of the card base. Stamp your image onto the 4"x5.25" piece.
- 6 Color your image with a medium of your choice. For this example, the image was colored with Tim Holtz Distress Ink reinkers.
- 7 Adhere the piece to the inside center of the card base.
- 8 Using foam adhesive or scrap chipboard, adhere the medium yellow circle piece to the center front of the card.
- 9 Using foam adhesive or scrapchipboard, adhere the the light yellow circle piece onto the medium yellow piece, aligned on all sides.
- 10 Using an inking sponge and Tim Holtz Distress Scattered Straw, ink the four corners and edges of the typewriter circle piece.
- 11 Using foam adhesive or scrap chipboard, adhere the typewriter piece to the top of the card.


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
## cutting files

NOTE: cutting files are provided in .silhouette, .svg, .png and .dxf formats and work with most leading electronic die cutters (Silhouette, Boss Kut, Cricuit Explorer, Pazzle, etc.) that can open and read these file formats. If you do not have an electronic die cutter, you can print this page and hand-cut the shapes with a craft knife or small scissors.


x-large circle piece
