suggested supplies

Photoplay Paper Happy Glamper:

- 12x12 multi floral
- 12x12 journal strips
- 12x12 journal cards (orange floral)
- 12x12 element stickers

American Crafts cardstock

- yellow, navy blue

Stampin' Up cardstock:

- whisper white

Waxed linen twine (pink, 6")

card dimensions

5.5" x 5.5" square
opens at bottom



Designer Notes:


- 1 Inking the edges of the component pieces is optional and should be done before assembling the card.
- 2 Hand-stitching can be replaced with machine stitching or faux stitching using a journaling pen.

Instructions:

- 1 Trim a 5.5"x11" piece of navy blue cardstock. Score the piece at 5.5" and fold it in half. This will be the card base.
- 2 Trim a 5.25"x5.25" square of white cardstock.
- 3 From the 12x12 sheet of Happy Glamper Journal Strips, cut the following pieces:
 - 5"x0.5" strip of green diagonal stripe
 - 5"x.625" strip of pink multi dot
 - 5"x.875 strip of multi-loops
 - 5"x.375 strip of teal dot
 - 5"x.75 strip of red gingham
 - 5"x.62 strip of yellow multi-dot
 - 5"x.75 strip of orange/white floral
- 4 Arrange the strips horizontally on the 5.25" white cardstock square, spacing them evenly apart and centering each strip left to right. When you are happy with the arrangement, glue each strip in place.
- 5 Adhere the assembled white square to the center of the card base.
- 6 Trim a 4"x4" square from the multi floral paper.
- 7 Hand-stitch around the interior edge of the floral square using white thread.
- 8 Open the exclusive Week 1 electronic die cutting file. Die cut three butterflies from yellow cardstock.
- 9 Score and fold each butterfly in half. Keep butterflies folded in half.
- 10 Apply wet adhesive to one half of one butterfly. Pair it up with another folded butterfly until both halves are evenly aligned. Repeat on the opposite side with the third butterfly.
- 11 Apply adhesive to the exposed "back" of the 3d butterfly. Adhere it to the center of the floral square, allowing the wings to pop up in a 3d fashion.
- 12 Trim two 2" pieces of pink waxed linen. Wrap each piece around a knitting needle or other small, round object to form antenna.
- 13 Dip the ends of each antenna into wet adhesive and tuck them under the head of the butterfly. Pull up gently on each antenna.
- 14 Locate the "hi ya cutie pie" sticker on the Happy Glamper element sticker sheet. Apply baby powder to the back of the sticker.
- 15 Using foam adhesive, adhere the sticker beneath the butterfly, centered left to right.
