### POINSETTIA INTERLOCKING CARD by Becky Fleck



#### suggested supplies

My Mind's Eye Comfort & Joy:

- 6x6 paper pad
- Spellbinders dies:
- Build-A-Wreath
  - Poinsettia

Papermania cardstock

- pine green, barn red

Photoplay Paper glitter enamel dots

American Crafts cardstock

- kraft, white, red, light green

#### basic tools

Favorite adhesive

Paper trimmer

Wet adhesive

Foam adhesive

Fine-tipped scissors

Scallop border punch

Dye-based ink (optional)

Electronic die cutter

#### card dimensions

4.25" wide x 5.5" tall  
opens at center



### Designer Notes:

- 1 Inking the edges of the component pieces is optional and should be done before assembling the card.

### Instructions:

- 1 Trim a 4.25"x11" piece of dark green cardstock. From the left, short edge, score at 2.75" and 8.25. Fold in on each score to form a 4.25"x5.5" card base.
- 2 Open the exclusive Week 2 electronic die cutting file. Die cut the following pieces:
  - double scallop rectangle from white cardstock
  - two single scallop edged pieces from Comfort & Joy floral paper
  - Large oval (mat) from barn red cardstock
  - Small oval from kraft cardstock
  - Bracket frame from dark green cardstock
- 3 Adhere the white double scallop piece to the inside of the card, centered. Close both flaps.
- 4 With the scallops on the top edge, adhere one of the floral pieces to the top flap, aligned with the straight cut edge.
- 5 With the scallops on the bottom edge, adhere the second floral piece to the bottom flap, aligned with the straight cut edge.
- 6 Adhere the kraft oval to the dark red oval.
- 7 Using a manual die cutter, die cut the following pieces from the poinsettia dies:
  - one 1.75" poinsettia from barn red cardstock
  - one 1.75" poinsettia from dark red cardstock
  - one 1.75" poinsettia from Comfort & Joy red dot paper
  - one 1.25" poinsettia from barn red cardstock
  - one 1.25" poinsettia from dark red cardstock
  - two 1.25" poinsettia from Comfort & Joy red dot paper
- 8 Using a manual die cutter, die cut the following pieces from the Build-A-Wreath dies:
  - four pine branches from light green cardstock
  - four pine branches from dark green cardstock
  - two leaves from light green cardstock
  - two leaves from dark green cardstock
- 9 Ink the edges of all of the die cut pieces, if desired.
- 10 Layer and glue the large poinsettia in the following order, from the bottom up:
  - red dot-dark red-barn red-small red dot
- 11 Layer and glue the small poinsettia together in the following order, from the bottom up:
  - dark red-red dot-barn red
- 12 Pull up on the petals of each flower cluster for added dimension.
- 13 Referring to the photo, glue each poinsettia to the kraft oval, offsetting them as shown.
- 14 Tuck and glue a mix of light and dark green pine branches and leaves under and around each poinsettia.
- 15 Apply a gold glitter enamel dot to the center of each poinsettia.
- 16 Apply adhesive to the BOTTOM half of the dark green bracket frame. Adhere it to the front of the card, pressing firmly on the adhesive half.
- 17 Apply adhesive to the TOP half of the assembled ovals. Adhere the piece in the center of the bracket frame, pressly firmly on the adhesive half.
- 18 When the card is opened, the oval piece will open with the top flap and the bracket frame will open with the bottom flap.




## cutting files

NOTE: cutting files are provided in .silhouette, .svg, .png and .dxf formats and work with most leading electronic die cutters (Silhouette, Boss Kut, Cricuit Explorer, Pazzle, etc.) that can open and read these file formats. If you do not have an electronic die cutter, you can print this page and hand-cut the shapes with a craft knife or small scissors.
