- dark peach, teal

Sizzix layered flower dies

Stampin' Up leaves die

Doodlebug enamel dots (white)

Designer Notes:

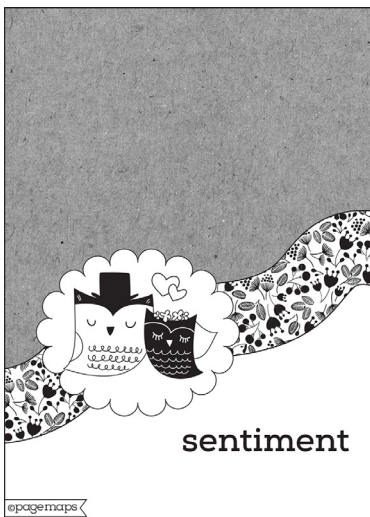
- 1 Inking the edges of the component pieces is optional and should be done before assembling the card.

Instructions:

- 1 Open the exclusive Week 4 electronic die cutting file. Die cut the following pieces:
 - Card base from teal cardstock
 - Card base bottom from teal cardstock
 - Top mat from Dear Lizzy Saturday floral
 - Bottom mat from Dear Lizzy Saturday floral
 - "Hello" from dark peach cardstock
- 2 From the bottom, straight edge of the card base, measure and score at 5.5". Fold the curved flap over to the front.
- 3 Adhere the floral top mat to the center of the curved flap.
- 4 Adhere the floral bottom mat to the center of the bottom card base piece.
- 5 Manually die cut four flower layers in descending size from various shades of yellow patterned paper.
- 6 Layer and glue the flower pieces together.
- 7 Manually die cut three small leaves from a scrap of green patterned paper.
- 8 Tuck the leaves under the layered flower as shown.
- 9 Apply a large white enamel dot to the center of the flower.
- 10 Trim a 4"x5.25" piece of Dear Lizzy Saturday pink diagonal stripe. Adhere it to the center of the inside of the card. Close the card flap.
- 11 Using temporary adhesive, adhere the bottom base assembled piece to the bottom of the inside card, aligning it on all three sides.
- 12 Apply adhesive to the top and bottom back edges of the "hello" die cut and glue it over the gap to connect the bottom base piece to the top flap as shown.
- 13 Apply adhesive to the top and bottom back edges of the assembled flower. Adhere it to the left side of the card, over the gap. Remove the temporary adhesive.
