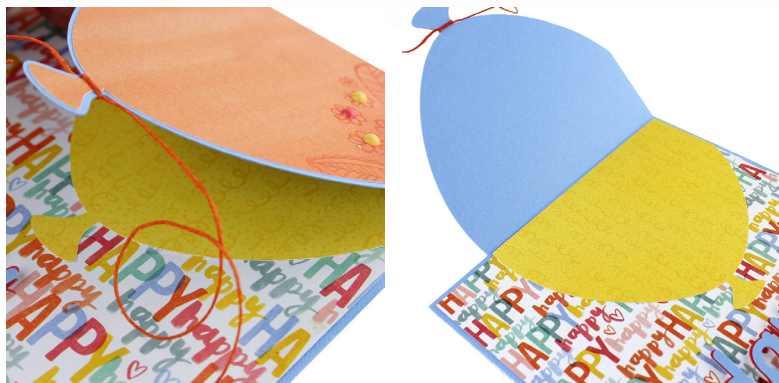

suggested supplies

Amy Tangerine Oh Happy Life

- 6x6 paper pad

Photoplay Paper Party Boy

- 6x6 paper pad (yellow streamers)

American Crafts cardstock

- blue, dark orange

Waxed linen cord (dark orange)

My Mind's Eye enamel dots

basic tools

Favorite adhesive

Paper trimmer

Wet adhesive

Foam adhesive

Fine-tipped scissors

Electronic die cutter



card dimensions

5.5" x 5.5" square

opens on bottom



Designer Notes:

- 1 Inking the edges of the component pieces is optional and should be done before assembling the card.

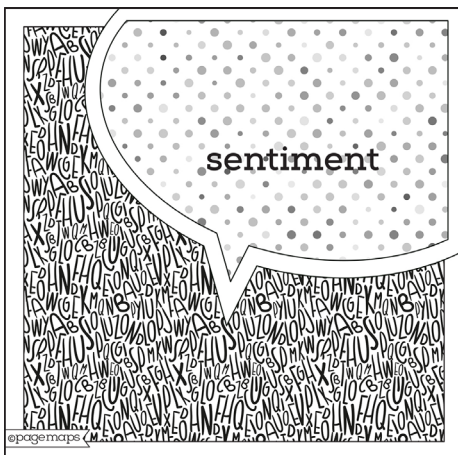
Instructions:

- 1 Open the exclusive Week 4 electronic die cutting file. Die cut the following pieces:
 - Card base from blue cardstock
 - balloon from Oh Happy Life orange ombre, capturing the floral print in the top, right corner
 - balloon from Party Boy yellow streamers
 - "bday" from blue cardstock
 - "bday" from dark orange cardstock
- 2 Score the balloon card base as shown and fold the balloon down. Open the balloon flap.

- 3 Trim a 5.375"x5.375" square of Oh Happy Life "happy" paper. Adhere it to the center of the inside card.
- 4 Adhere the yellow balloon to the happy paper, aligning it to the top and right edges. Close the balloon flap.
- 5 Adhere the orange ombre balloon to the center of the balloon flap.
- 6 Apply enamel dots to the center of the flowers on the orange balloon.
- 7 Trim a 6" piece of dark orange waxed linen. Tie it to the bottom of the balloon. Curl the waxed linen into a loop.
- 8 Adhere the blue "bday" to the dark orange "bday" offsetting the two layers slightly.
- 9 Using foam adhesive, adhere the "bday" to the bottom, left corner of the card.

cutting files

NOTE: cutting files are provided in .silhouette, .svg, .png and .dxf formats and work with most leading electronic die cutters (Silhouette, Boss Kut, Cricuit Explorer, Pazzle, etc.) that can open and read these file formats. If you do not have an electronic die cutter, you can print this page and hand-cut the shapes with a craft knife or small scissors.
