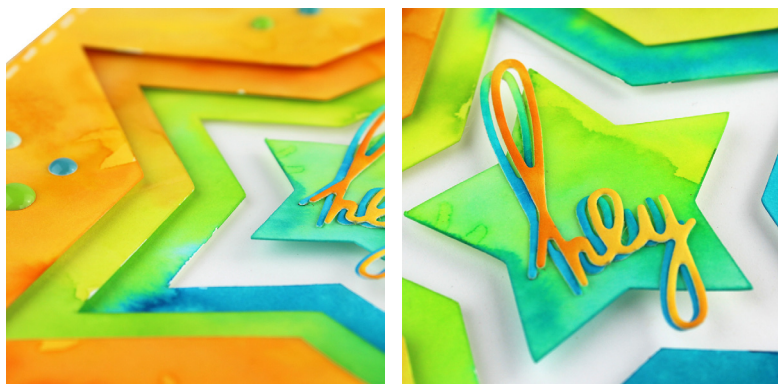
basic tools

Favorite adhesive
Paper trimmer
Wet adhesive
Foam adhesive
Fine-tipped scissors
White gel pen
Large watercolor brush
Electronic die cutter
Manual die cutter



card dimensions

5.5" x 5.5" square
opens on bottom





Designer Notes:

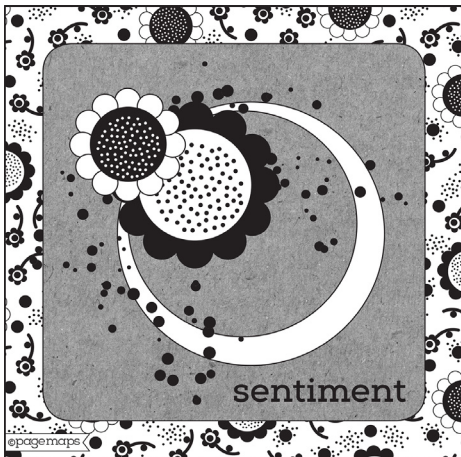
- 1 Inking the edges of the component pieces is optional and should be done before assembling the card.
- 2 Spray mist can be used as a substitution for watercolor medium.
- 3 To reduce the bulk of the card, use scrap cardboard in place of foam adhesive.

Instructions:

- 1 Open the exclusive Week 4 electronic die cutting file. Die cut the following pieces:
 - Each square star layer from watercolor paper
 - Small star from watercolor paper
- 2 Trim two 2" squares from white watercolor paper.
- 3 Trim a 5.5"x11" piece of white cardstock. Score and fold in half to create a card base with the opening at the bottom.
- 4 Spread out all die cut watercolor paper pieces onto your work surface. Watercolor each layer as follows:
 - large star frame: yellow to orange
 - medium star frame: orange to green
 - small star frame: green to turquoise
 - small star: green to turquoise
 - 2" square: yellow to orange
 - 2" square: turquoise
- 5 Allow all layers to completely dry. If they curl up, press them between two sheets of copy paper with a hot, dry iron.
- 6 Using a white gel pen, draw a faux stitching line around the inside edge of the largest star frame.
- 7 Using foam adhesive, layer the three star frames together from smallest star to largest star.
- 8 Adhere the layered stars to the center of the card front.
- 9 Manually die cut the word "hey" from each of the 2" squares.
- 10 Layer the two words together, offsetting them slightly and with the yellow word on top.
- 11 Using foam adhesive, adhere the single star to the center of the nested frames.
- 12 Adhere the layered word to the center of the star.
- 13 Apply enamel dots in clusters of three around the top star frame as shown.

cutting files

NOTE: cutting files are provided in .silhouette, .svg, .png and .dxf formats and work with most leading electronic die cutters (Silhouette, Boss Kut, Cricuit Explorer, Pazzle, etc.) that can open and read these file formats. If you do not have an electronic die cutter, you can print this page and hand-cut the shapes with a craft knife or small scissors.



Note: when cutting the star layers manually, each size should be cut from a 5.25"x5.25" square of white watercolor paper with the star placed in the center.
