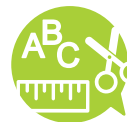
HOLIDAY TREE 3D CARD by Becky Fleck



suggested supplies

My Mind's Eye Cozy Christmas:

- 6x6 paper pad
- Spellbinders dies
- Office Supplies (notebook)
- Freckled Fawn enamel star
- Bazzill Basics cardstock (red, sage)
- May Road glitter (cherry red)
- PageMaps Exclusive Cutting Files



basic tools

- Favorite adhesive
- Paper trimmer
- Wet adhesive
- Foam adhesive
- Fine-tipped scissors
- Glue pen
- Electronic die cutter
- Manual die cutter



card dimensions

4.25" wide x 5.5" tall
opens on right



Designer Notes:

- 1 Inking the edges of the component pieces is optional and should be done before assembling the card.

Instructions:

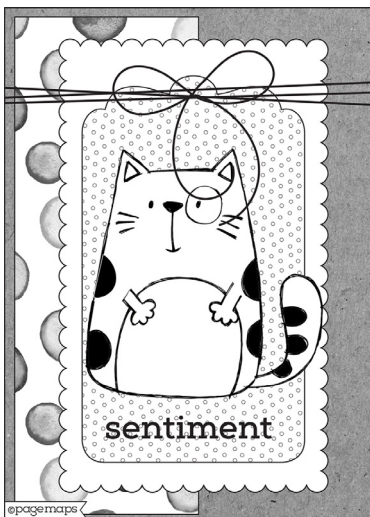
- 1 Trim an 8.5"x5.5" piece of red cardstock. Score and fold it in half to create a 4.25"x5.5" card base.
- 2 Trim a 3"x5.25" piece of Cozy Christmas houses paper. Adhere it to the left side of the card front, leaving an equal gap around the top, bottom and left edges.
- 3 Trim a 2.75"x4.75" piece of Cozy Christmas green dot paper. Adhere it to the right side of the card, 3/8" down from the top edge and leaving a 1/8" gap on the right side as shown.
- 4 Manually die cut a 2.75" x4" notebook piece from Cozy Christmas newsprint paper. Ruffle, fold and tear the notebook edge for added dimension.
- 5 Adhere the notebook piece to the center of the card.
- 6 Open the exclusive Week 4 electronic die cutting file. Die cut the following pieces:
 - five trees from sage cardstock
- 7 Score and fold each tree in half. Press firmly on the crease with a bone folder. Open each folded tree.
- 8 Using a glue pen, draw random dots across each tree and sprinkle with red micro glitter. Tap off excess and set them aside to dry.
- 9 Fold the trees in half again. Apply wet adhesive to one half of one tree and pair it up with another folded tree. Continue until all five folded trees are joined together. Open the glued trees.
- 10 Apply adhesive to the exposed back surface of the 3D tree and adhere it to the notebook piece, leaving enough room at the top for a star.
- 11 Apply an enamel star to the top of the tree.

If you do not have an electronic die cutter, you can print this page and hand-cut the shapes with a craft knife or small scissors.
