suggested supplies

BasicGrey South Pacific:

- 6x6 paper pad
- 12x12 alpha sticker
- 12x12 journaling card sheet

1/2" dark pink button

White twine



basic tools

Favorite adhesive

1/4" strong tape adhesive (redline)

Paper trimmer

Craft knife

Fine-tipped scissors

Pencil, ruler

White gel pen

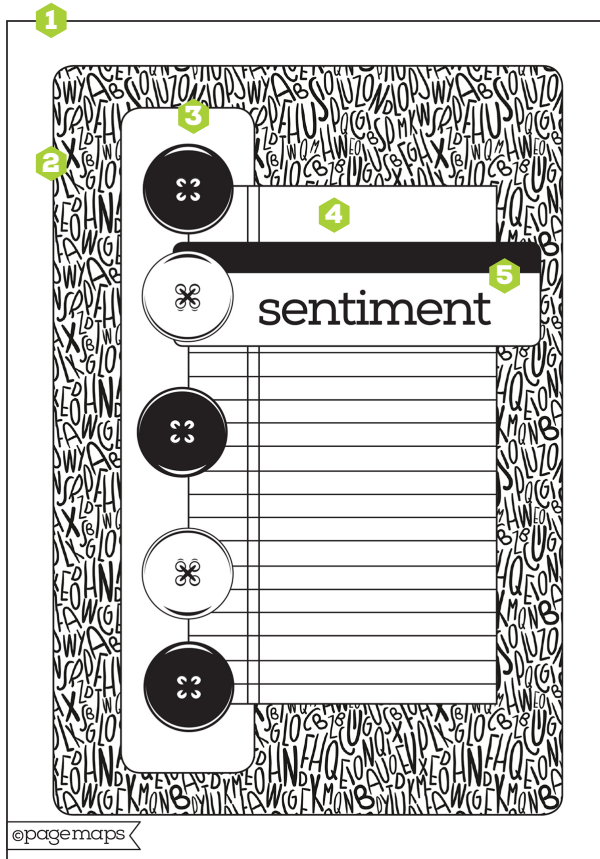
Corner rounder



card dimensions

4.25" wide x 5.5" tall

false foundation, untie to open



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card instructions

- 1 Trim a $4\frac{1}{4}$ "x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " piece and a $1\frac{3}{4}$ "x $\frac{3}{4}$ " strip from blue/cream scallops paper. Trim a 4 "x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " piece from pink striped paper. Round the top left and bottom right corners of both pieces.
- 2 Adhere the pink striped piece to the center of the blue scallops piece. This will be your card foundation. Set it aside.
- 3 Trim a 6 "x 4 " piece of white cardstock. Fold the piece in half to form a 3 "x 4 " card. Corner round the top left and bottom right corners.
- 4 Trim the 3 "x 4 " gold/oval/floral journal card from the 12 x 12 journaling card sheet. Round the top left and bottom left corners. Adhere it to the front of the 3 "x 4 " card.
- 5 Trim the 3 "x 4 " blue/cream journal card from the 12 x 12 journaling card sheet. Trim the piece to fit the inside of the 3 "x 4 " card. Corner round the bottom right corner and adhere to the inside right panel of the 3 "x 4 " card.
- 6 Spell out "THX!" across the center of the blue/cream piece using gold letter stickers.
- 7 Trim a 2 "x 4 " piece of the pink striped paper. Round the bottom, left corner. Apply $\frac{1}{4}$ " tape adhesive to the top and bottom short ends and the left edge. Adhere it to the inside front flap to form a pocket.
- 8 From the travel labels patterned paper, trim out the two-tone green label. Fold the label in half and adhere it to the center right edge of the 3 "x 4 " card front flap, with half of the label going to the inside of the card.
- 9 Using a piercing tool, poke two holes into the left edge of the green label on the front of the card. From the inside of the card, thread the two ends of a 4 " piece of white twine through both holes. Thread those same ends into a two-hole button and tie off in the front.
- 10 Round the top two corners of the $1\frac{3}{4}$ "x $\frac{3}{4}$ " strip of blue/cream scallops paper. Adhere it to the center top portion of the journal card oval.
- 11 Spell out "HEY!" across the blue/cream strip using gold letter stickers.
- 12 Trim 12 " of white twine. Lay it centered horizontally across the matted foundation piece assembled in step 2 and tack it down in the center with a piece of tape or glue dot.
- 13 Adhere the assembled card to the center of the foundation piece, ensuring that both ends of the twine come out on the left and right sides.
- 14 Using a white gel pen, draw a faux stitching line around the assembled card.
- 15 With the card closed, wrap each end of the twine, one at a time, around the button, similar to a banker's envelope.

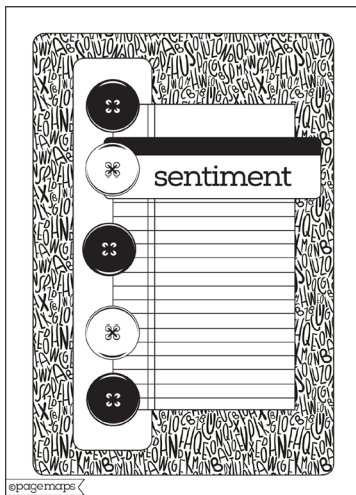
