### suggested supplies

*Jillibean Soup Saffron Yellow Pepper:*

- 12x12 Garlic Cloves

*Pebbles Happy Day:*

- 12x12 Puzzled

*Lawn Fawn Hello Sunshine:*

- 6x6 paper pad

*Me & My Big Ideas:*

- chipboard tag and star

*My Mind's Eye*

- yellow baker's twine
- enamel dots

*American Crafts:*

- Pinwheel
- Flag Clip (or paperclip)

*Blue grosgrain ribbon (3/4")*



### basic tools

*Favorite adhesive*

*Dimensional adhesive*

*1/8" high-tack tape (redline tape)*

*Paper trimmer*

*Fine-tipped scissors*

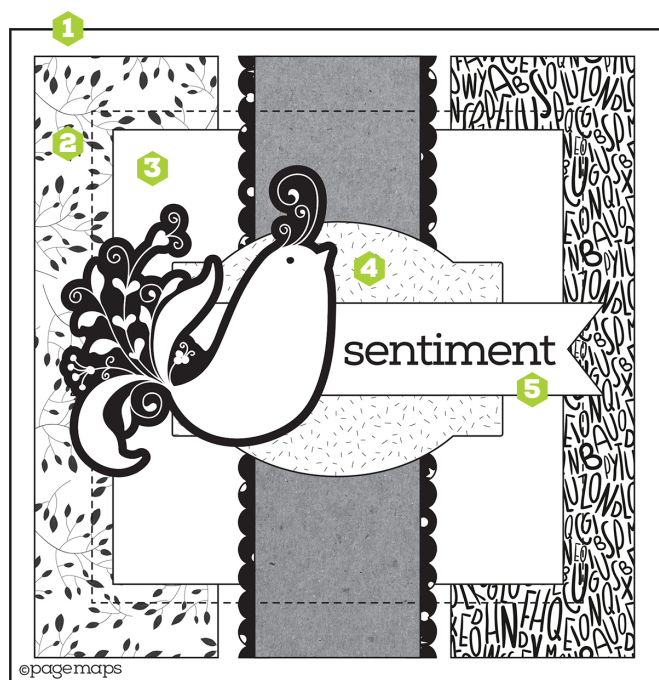
*Ruler, pencil*



### card dimensions

*finished size 4.25" x 5.5"*





## trimming dimensions

- 1 6" x 6" (base size of card)
- 2 1.625" x 5.5"
- 3 4" x 4"
- 4 2.25" x 3"
- 5 4" x 1"



## card instructions

- 1 Create a 4.25"x5.5" card base from white cardstock with the opening at the right.
- 2 Open the exclusive electronic die cutting file wk4/#2. Die cut the foundation card holder from multi-dot patterned paper.
- 3 Refer to the template on page 4 for scoring measurements. Fold on the score lines in this order: valley-mountain-valley—to create a slotted pocket in the inside center of the folded template.
- 4 Turn the template over to the back. Apply 1/4" strong tape adhesive (redline adhesive) along the very inside edge of the two main score lines. Close the template and press firmly to adhere the two sides together, forming a pocket. Keep the template closed.
- 5 Trim a 3"x3.5" piece of yellow patterned paper. Round all four corners. Adhere to the front of the bracket card holder.
- 6 Trim a 9" piece of blue ribbon. Wrap it vertically around the front bracket flap, 3/4" in from the left, folded edge, gluing the ends together on the inside of the flap.
- 7 Cluster and adhere the "happy day" tag and dimensional pinwheel to the front flap as shown.
- 8 Trim a 3.5"x1.25" strip of yellow patterned paper. Cut a v-notch into each end to form a banner. Adhere the banner vertically to the inside front panel of the notched cardholder slot.
- 9 Adhere a yellow chipboard star to the bottom, right corner of the yellow banner.
- 10 Trim an 8" piece of yellow baker's twine. Double the twine and tie it to a flag clip or paper clip. Temporarily tuck the clip into the right side of the dimensional pinwheel. Wrap the ends of the twine to the right and around to the back of the card holder, securing the twine with tape.
- 11 Trim a 4.25"x5.5" piece of orange check paper. Trim a 4.25"x5.5" piece of blue chevron paper. Cut each piece diagonally from the top, left corner to the bottom, right corner.
- 12 Adhere the one of the blue pieces to the top, right side of the white cardstock base. Adhere the orange piece to the bottom, left side of the base. Both pieces should cover the front of the card base.
- 13 Apply a few enamel dots to the inside of the bracket card holder, above the chipboard star.
- 14 Place a gift card or cash in the slot and close.
- 15 Adhere the assembled card holder to the front of the card base using strong adhesive.

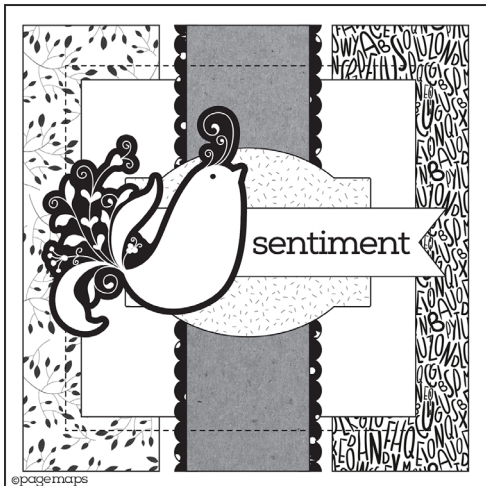

## cutting files

NOTE: exclusive cutting files are provided in .silhouette, .svg, .pdf and .dxf formats, and work with many leading electronic die cutters such as Silhouette, Boss Kut, Scan 'N Cut, Cricuit Explorer and Pazzle. If you do not have an electronic die cutter, you can print this pdf and hand-cut the shapes with a craft knife or small scissors (see note below).

*for step 4, apply 1/4" wide  
adhesive along these two edges*

NOTE: When you print these templates, it is important to tell your printer to print at 100% scale. Depending on your printer, this selection may say "Print To Scale," "Do Not Scale" or "Scale 100%." If you do not make this selection in advance of printing, the pdf template will print approximately 3%-5% smaller.
