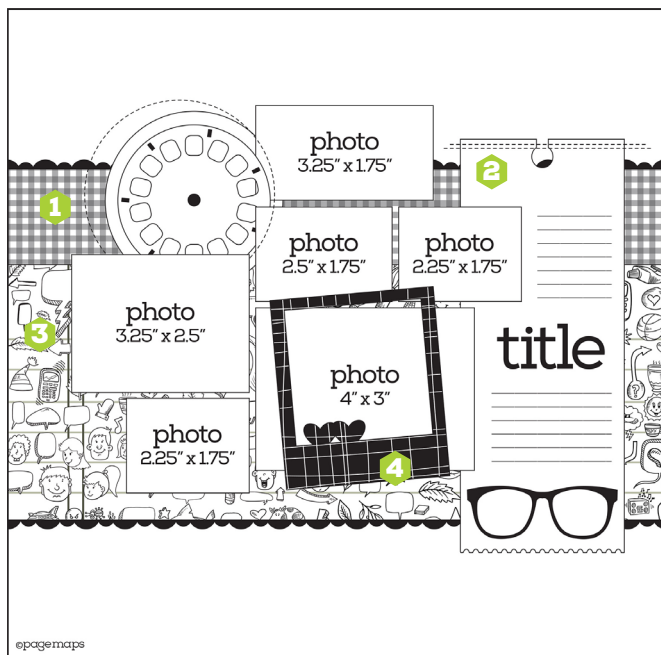

### trimming dimensions

### layout instructions

- 1 Locate the My Mind's Eye Cut & Paste Hello Greet (wood grain) patterned paper and remove tear strip. This will be your layout base.
- 2 Trim a 12"x8.5" piece from Jenni Bowlin Studio Modern Mercantile Novelties (blue geometric) patterned paper.
- 3 Scallop punch one 12" length of BasicGrey Knee Highs & Bow Ties Red Rover (red grid) patterned paper. Trim to 12"x1". Repeat to create a second 12" scallop piece.
- 4 Adhere red strips underneath the top and bottom edges of the blue piece from step 2, leaving .5" showing above and below. Center and adhere to base.
- 5 Trim a 3.25"x10.25" piece from Pink Paislee Portfolio Outstanding (yellow ledger) patterned paper. Trim a 3"x10" piece of Elle's Studio Cameron The Best (white ledger) patterned paper, center and adhere to yellow ledger piece.
- 6 Adhere yellow/white piece vertically, .5" from the right edge of the base and centered top to bottom.
- 7 Using the PageMaps U cut file, an electronic die cutter, and Elle's Studio You & Me Chalk Love (black chalkboard) patterned paper, cut the viewfinder die cut, sizing it to a 3.5" circle.
- 8 Cut a slightly less than 3.5" circle from Pebbles Love You More Blake patterned paper. Adhere to the back of the viewfinder die cut.
- 9 Cut a 1.75" circle from Echo Park All About a Boy Games (orange/yellow) patterned paper and adhere to the front center of the viewfinder die cut with dimensional adhesive. Spray a 1.5" wood veneer arrow with Schoolhouse (red) mist and allow to dry. Adhere on top of the arrow design on the paper circle.
- 10 Adhere a gray enamel dot to the center of the wood veneer arrow. Adhere entire viewfinder embellishment to the upper left corner of the layout as shown, overlapping the red scallop strip by .5".
- 11 Adhere the top 3.5"x2" horizontal photo 3" from the left edge of the layout base (overlapping the viewfinder embellishment) and .25" below the top edge of the blue paper piece.
- 12 Adhere the remaining 3.5"x2" photos in a second row, starting .5" from the left edge of the layout base and no more than .25" below the top photo. The left-most photo will overlap the viewfinder embellishment.
- 13 Adhere the 2.5"x3.5" vertical photos in a third row, beginning .5" from the left edge and just above the bottom edge of the blue paper piece as shown.
- 14 Adhere the 3"x4" vertical photo, allowing the bottom edge to rest on the gray wood grain base as shown. Layer the Polaroid die cut at an angle over the 3"x4" photo, allowing part of the photo to show outside the frame.
- 15 Place two word stickers on the bottom portion of the Polaroid frame, in the "Notes" section, as shown. Adhere two large gray enamel dots to the left ends of the word stickers. Adhere the year digits in the "date" section, overlapping slightly.
- 16 Using the PageMaps U sunglasses cut file, an electronic die cutter and the reverse side of the black chalkboard paper (red stripe), cut a 3"x1" die cut of the sunglasses. Flip lenses over to black chalkboard side and switch right with left. Adhere the glasses and lenses 4.5" from the bottom of the yellow/white vertical journaling piece.
- 17 Adhere two small blue enamel dots to the right and left corners of the sunglasses. Using American Crafts Sketchbook letter stickers, adhere title horizontally above sunglasses as shown.
- 18 Adhere the Elle's Studio Day to Day die cut along the top edge of the yellow/white journaling block.
- 19 Adhere an October Afternoon Travel Girl 1.5" die cut on the right side of the Day to Day die cut, 1.25" from the left edge. Adhere a green October

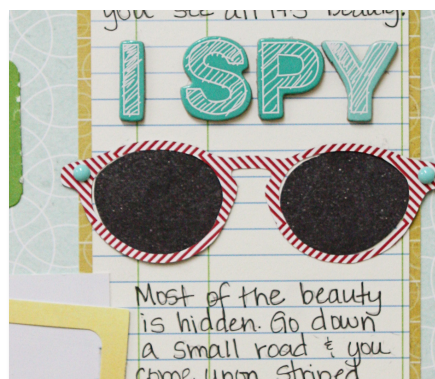


- Afternoon Travel girl sticker tab flush with the right edge of the right photo in the second row.
- 20 Trim an orange Travel Girl label sticker in half and adhere, flush with the right edge of the top photo.
  - 21 Cut an 8" piece of teal twine. Thread it through an orange button and tie off in a bow. Center button on label sticker and adhere as shown, slightly overlapping the photo.

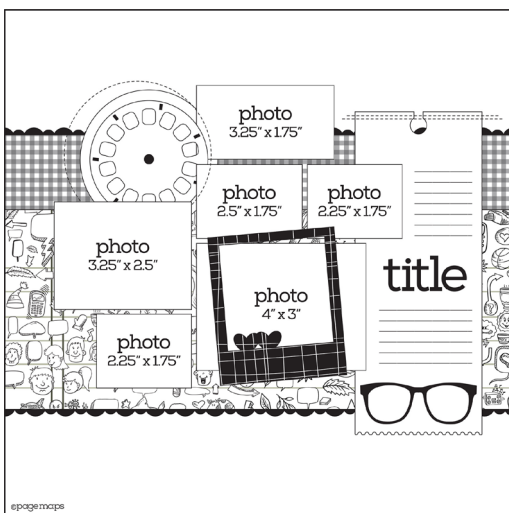
- 22 Machine or hand-sew 2.5" zig-zag stitch lines along the top and bottom of the journaling piece. Sew two more zig-zag stitch lines over the seam between the blue geometric paper and the red scallop trim.
- 23 Using a black journaling pen, hand-write journaling to finish layout.
