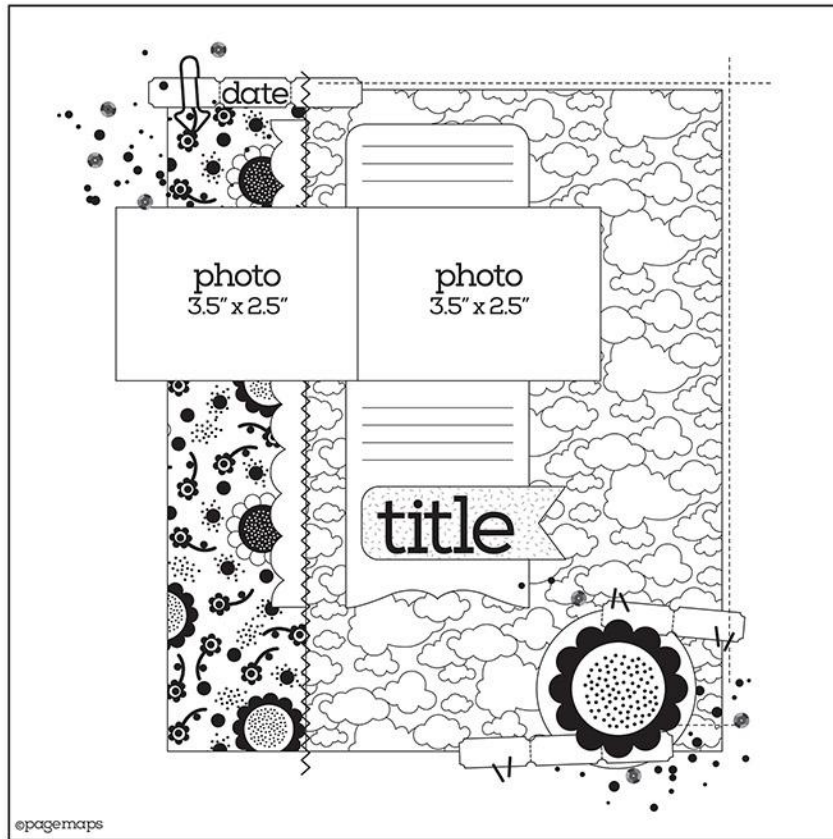

To advance the slideshow, press the space bar. To go back to a previous slide, press the arrow left key.



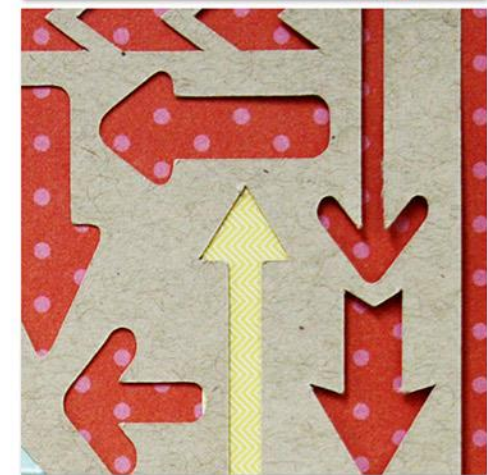
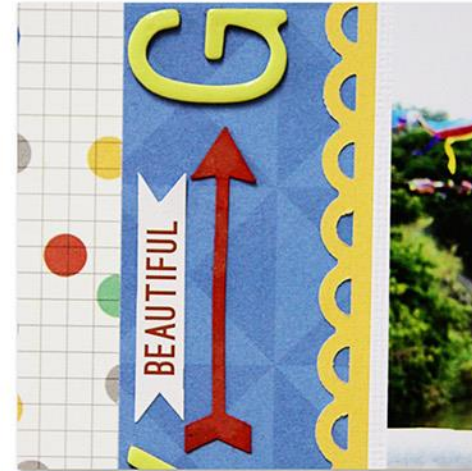

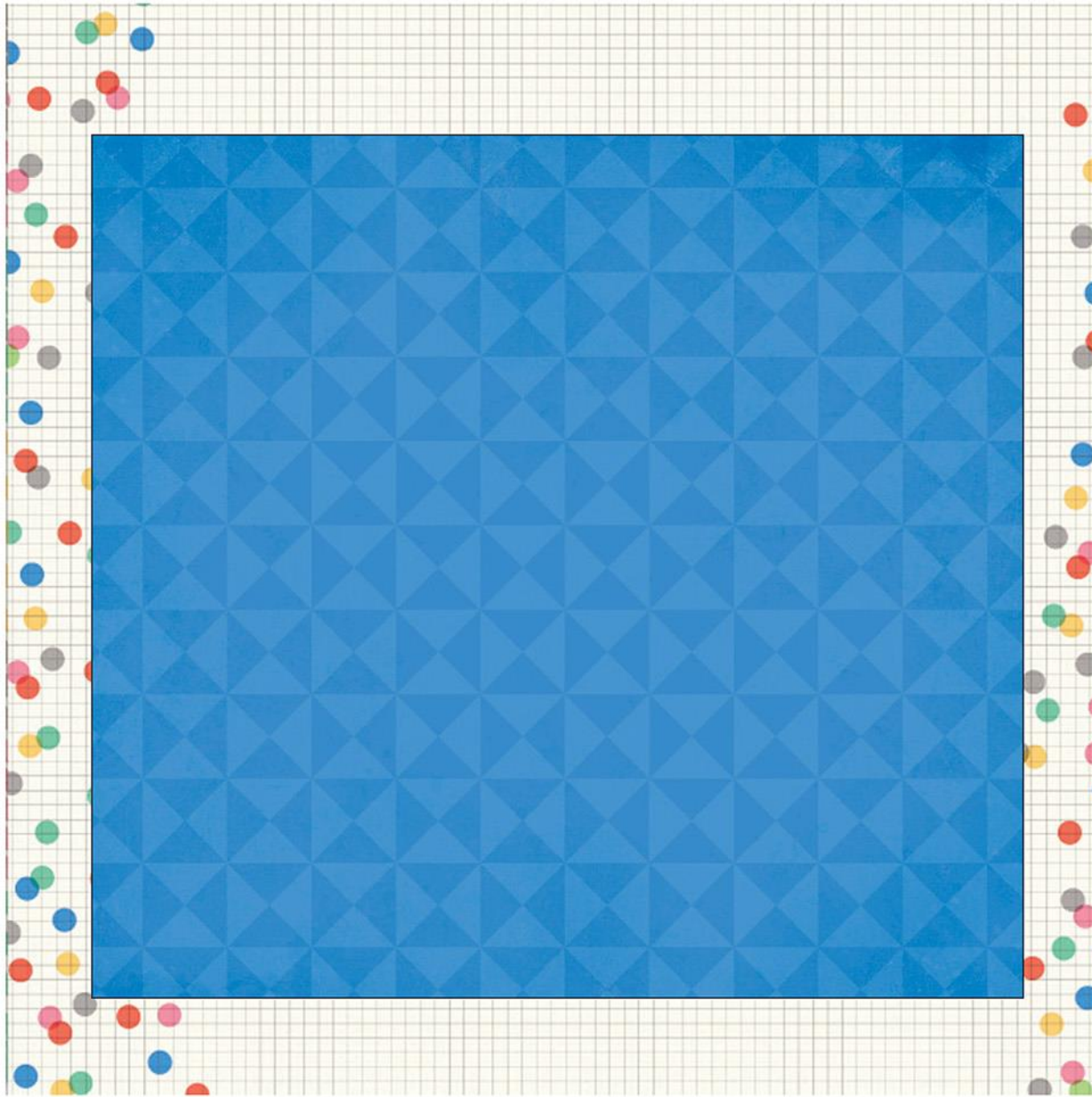






Trim the bar code tab  
from a sheet of Elle's  
Studio Saltwater  
Confetti.

This sheet will be the  
base for your layout.



Trim a 10.25" x 9.5" piece of Saltwater Pinwheels (blue side).

Adhere the piece to the center of the base page.

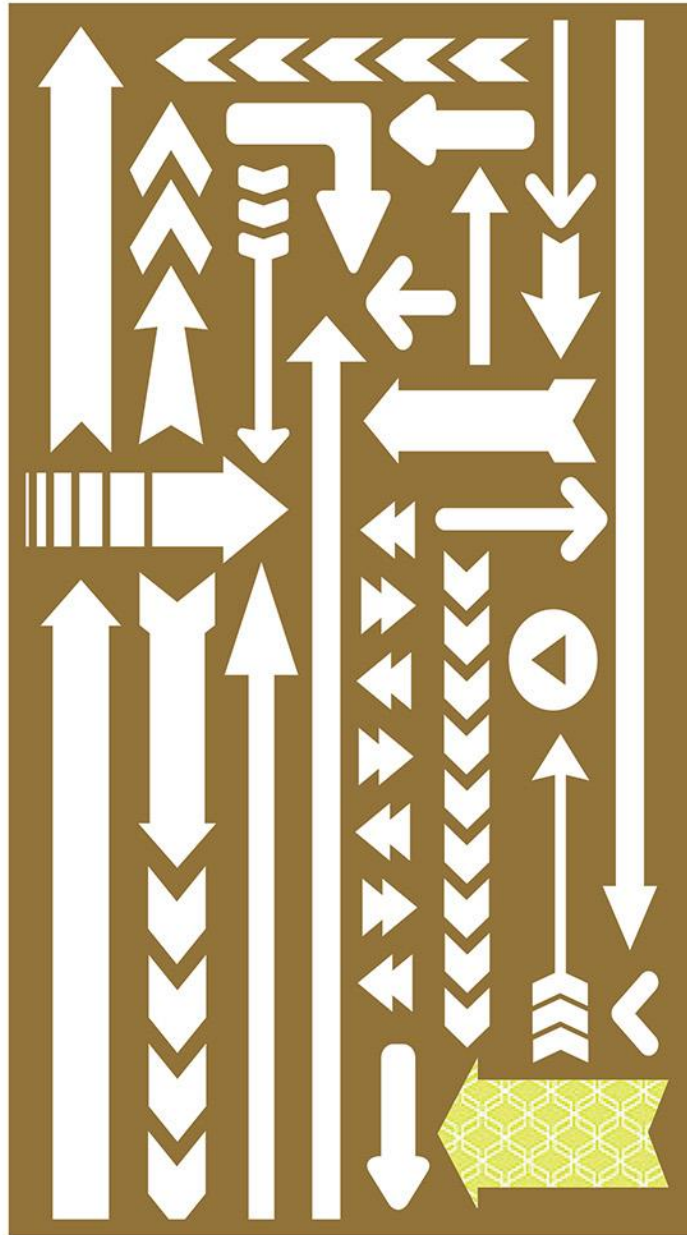






Trim a 5"x 9" piece of Saltwater Pennants (red side). Set this piece aside.

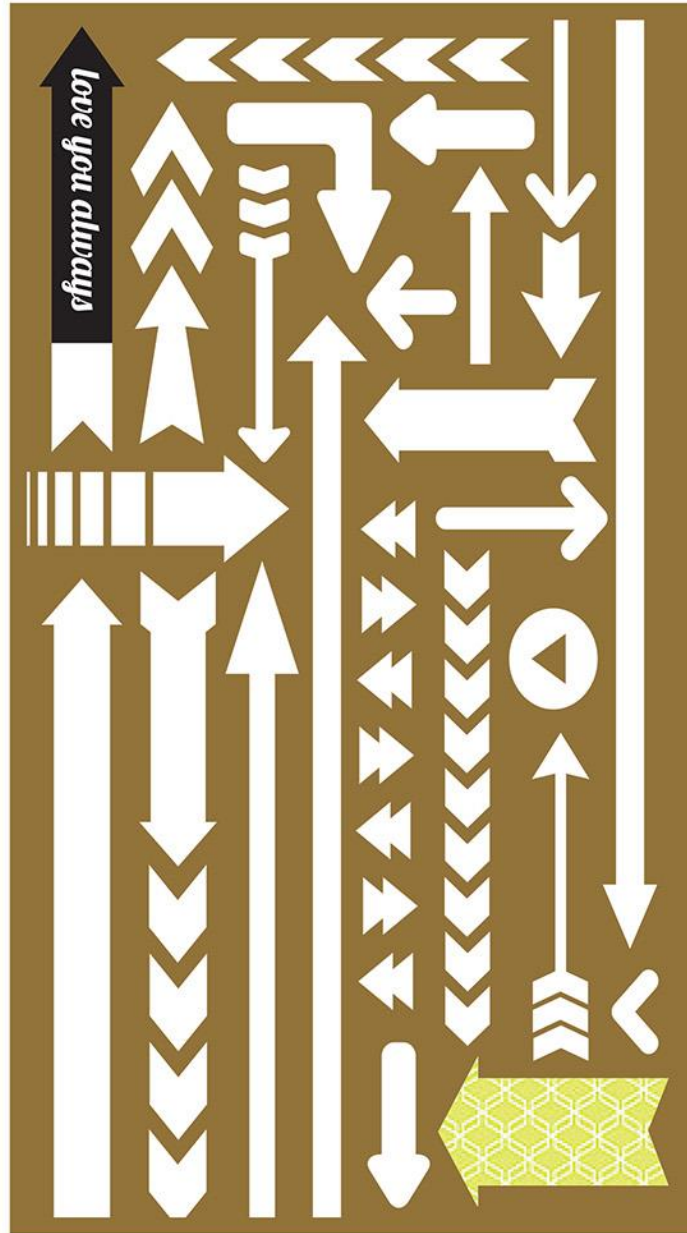




Trim a 1.125"x1.75" piece from Webster's Pages Sweets & Treats paper (green side) and use it to back the lower right-most arrow on the die cut negative as shown.

Note: you will need to trim a bit of excess so that it does not extend into another arrow.

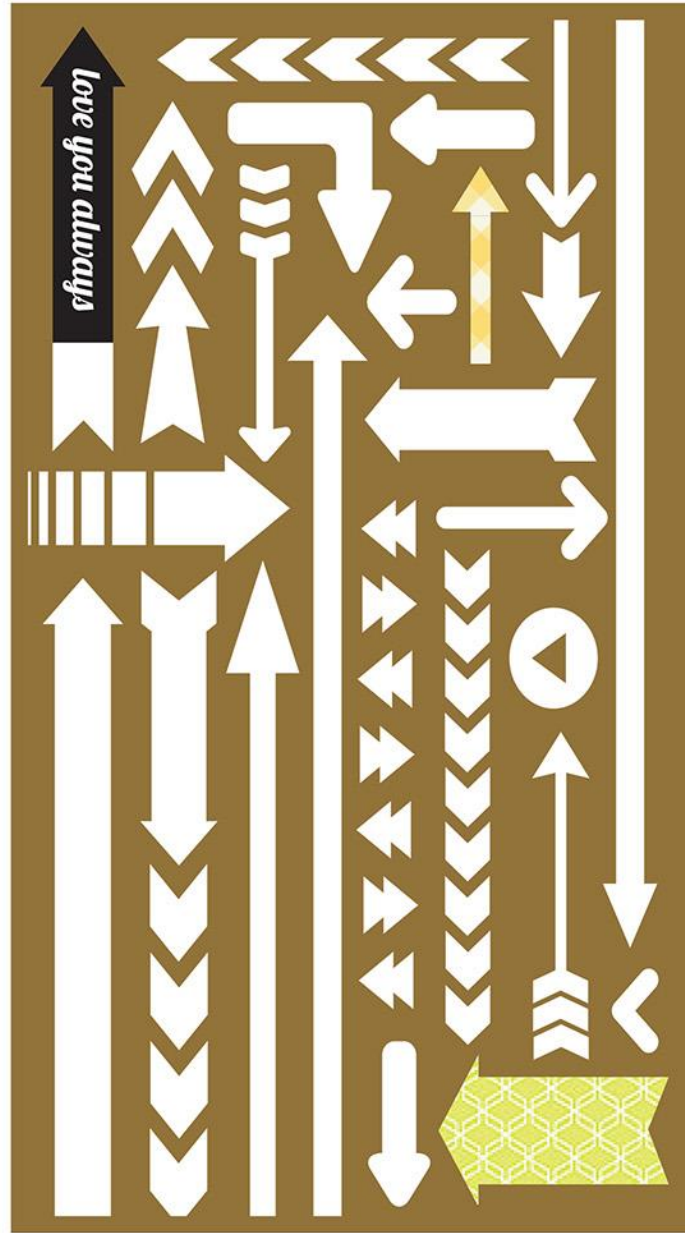

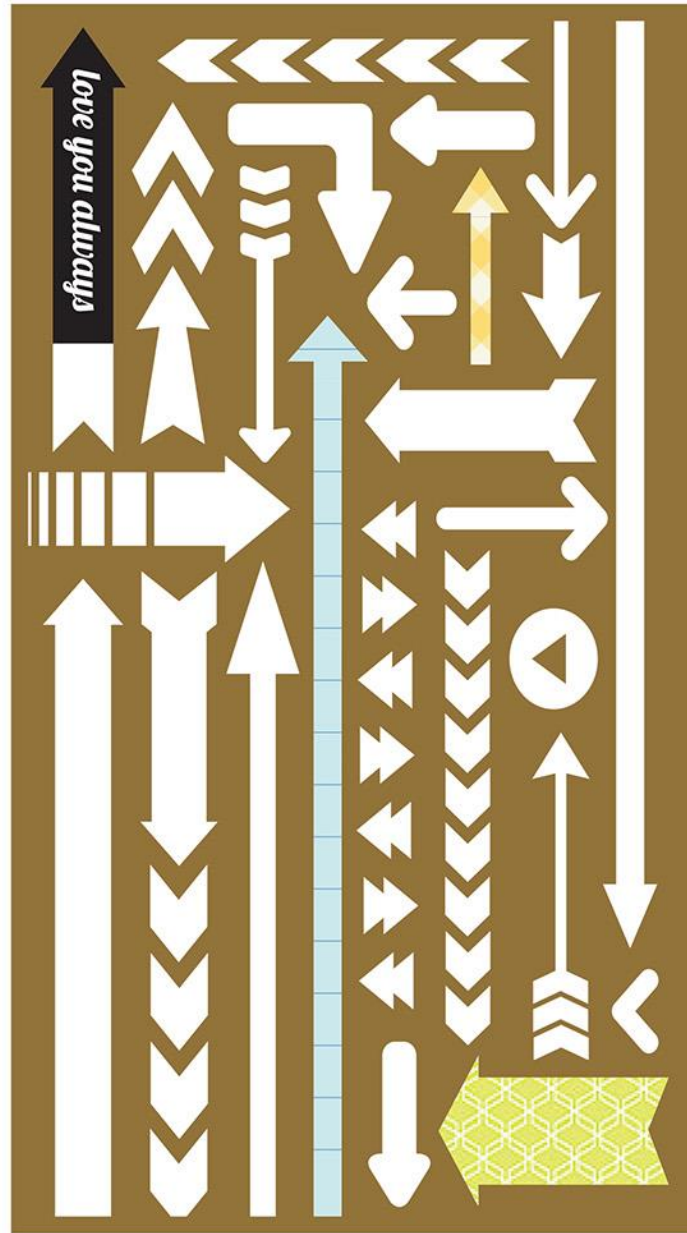
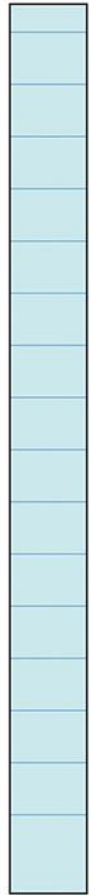
Cut the "love you always" sentiment from the American Crafts Mayberry pocket to .75"x2" and use it to back the upper left-most arrow as shown.

Note: The bottom part of the open arrow will be covered by your photo.



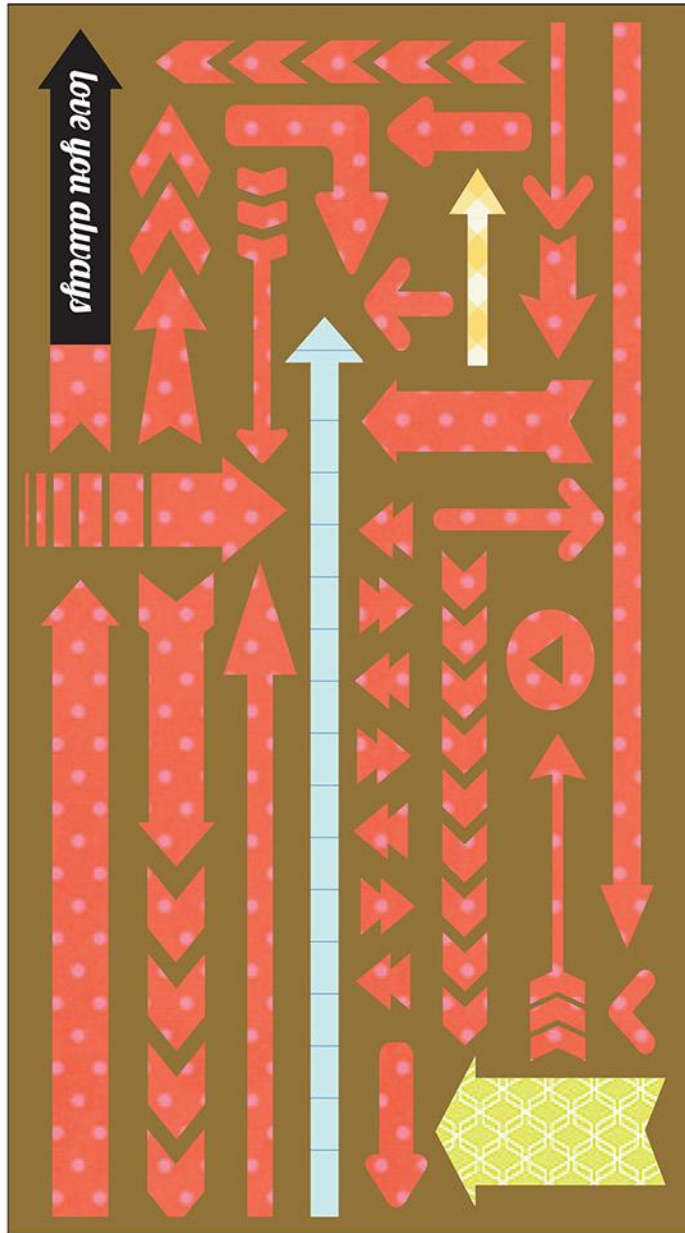


Trim a .5"x1.5" piece of Mayberry Berry Blossom (yellow side) and use it to back the upward pointing arrow located in the upper right portion of the die cut negative as shown.

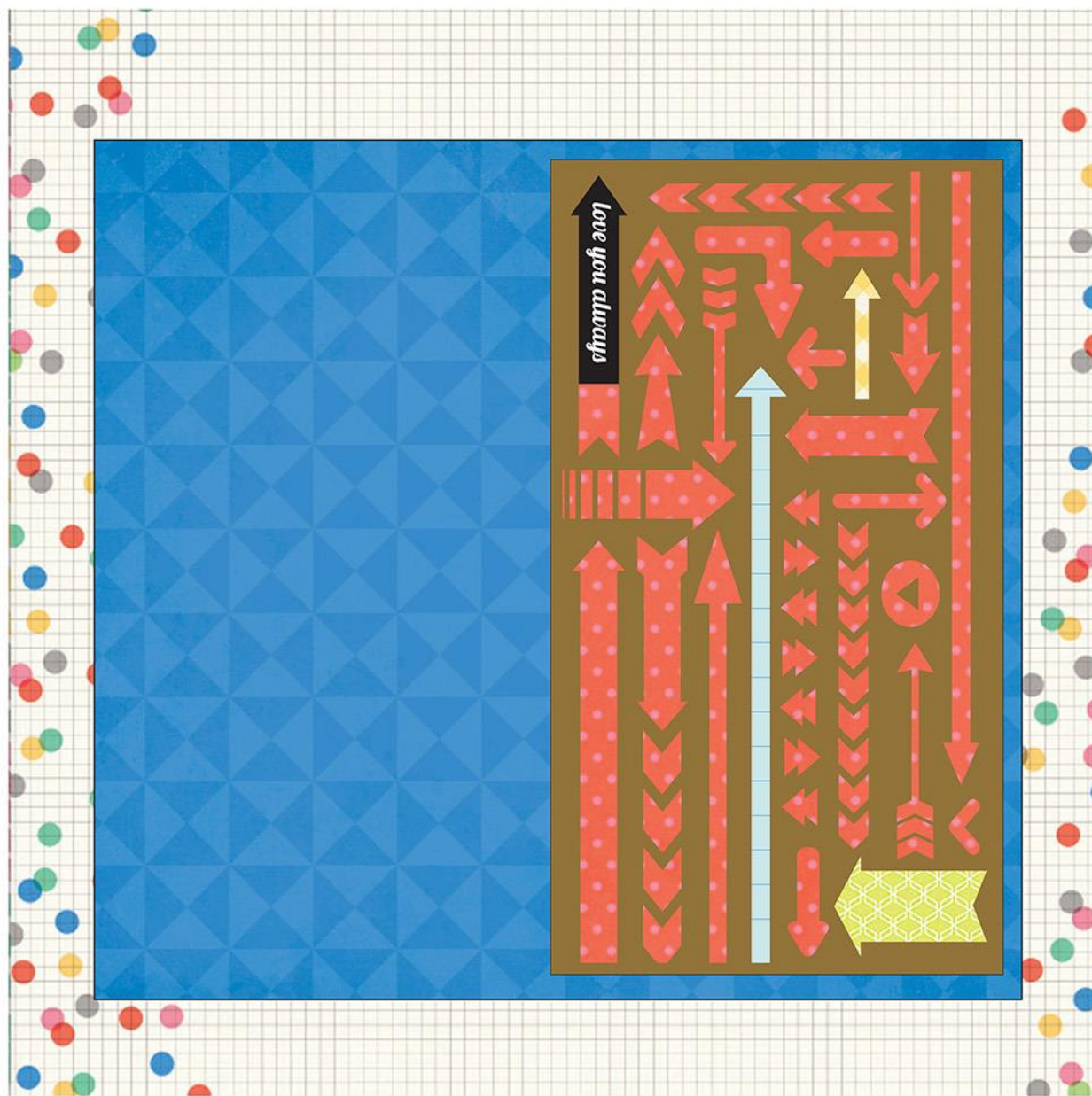


Trim a .5"x6.5" piece of Mayberry Picket Fences (blue side) and use it to back the long, narrow upward-pointing arrow in the middle of the die cut negative.





Back the entire piece with the 5" x 9" piece of red polka dot paper.

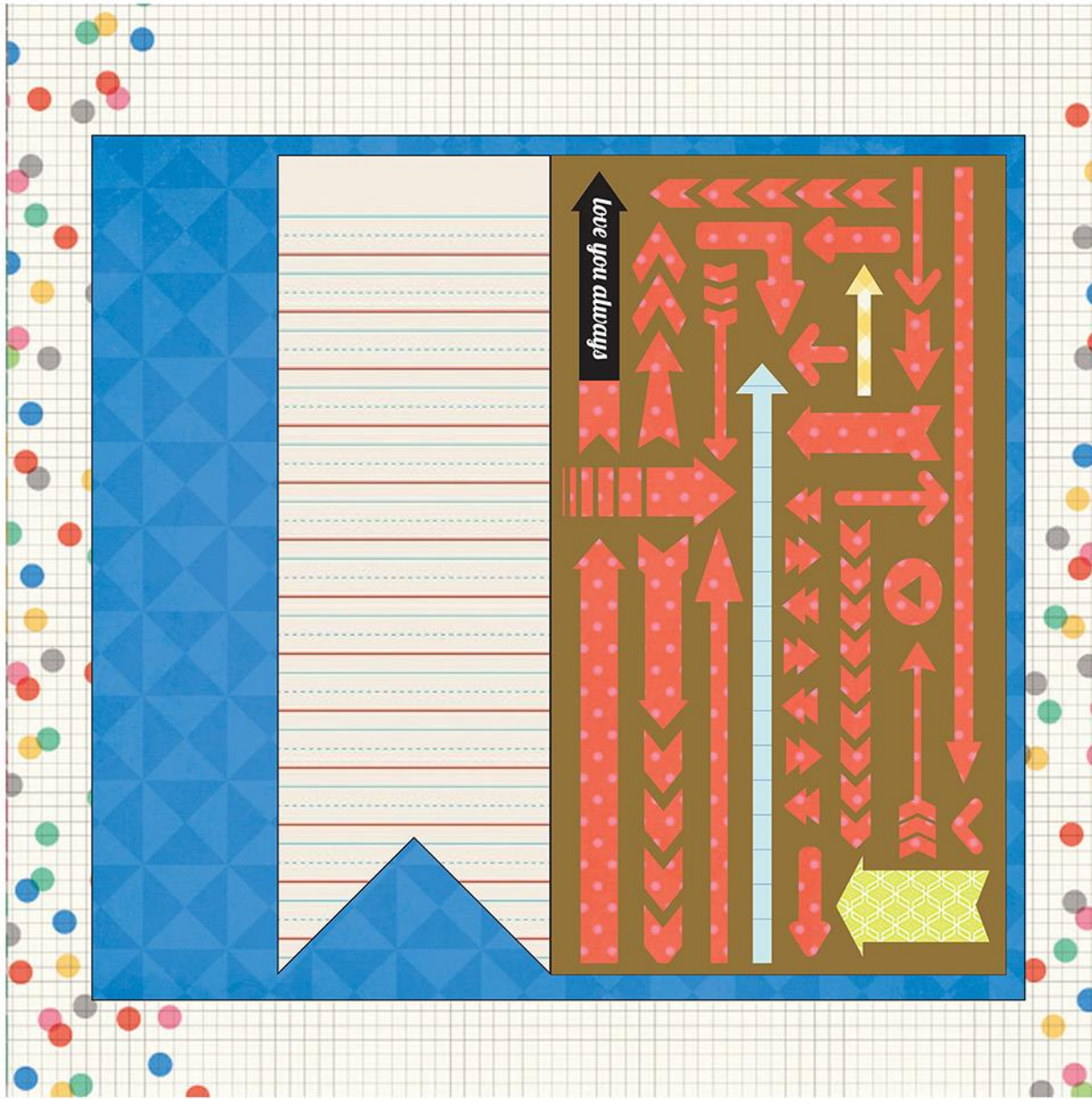


Adhere the assembled piece to the right side of the blue patterned paper, leaving a 1/4" margin around the three open sides.





Trim a 3"x9" piece from  
the Pebbles Love You  
More Andy paper  
(notebook side) and  
v-notch the bottom.



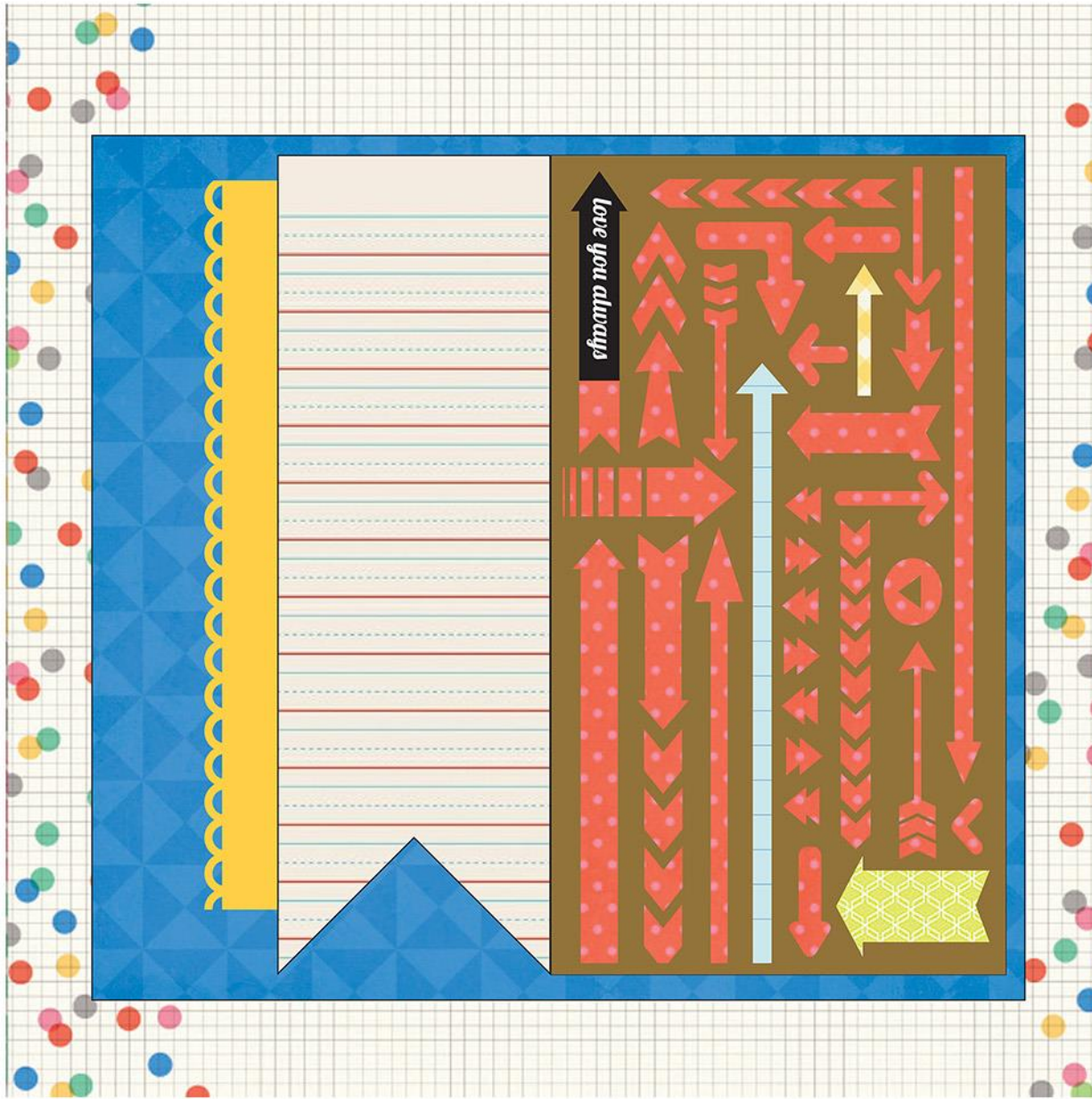
Adhere the banner to Pinwheels piece, flush with the left edge of the arrows piece.





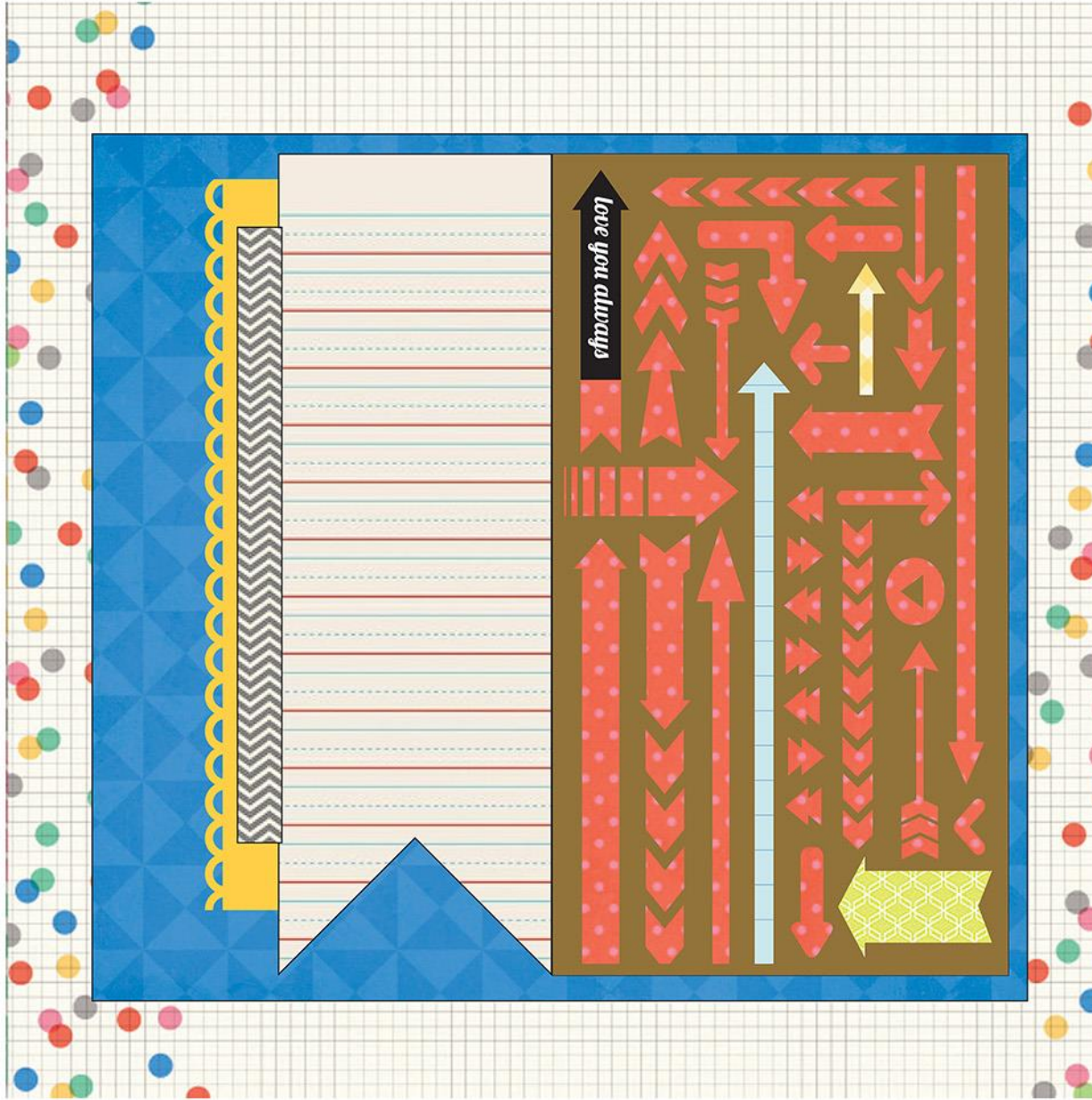
Trim a 1.25"x8" piece from yellow cardstock and punch along one long edge with the apron lace punch.

Trim a .5"x6.75" piece from the October Afternoon Travel Girl Guide Book paper (chevron side).



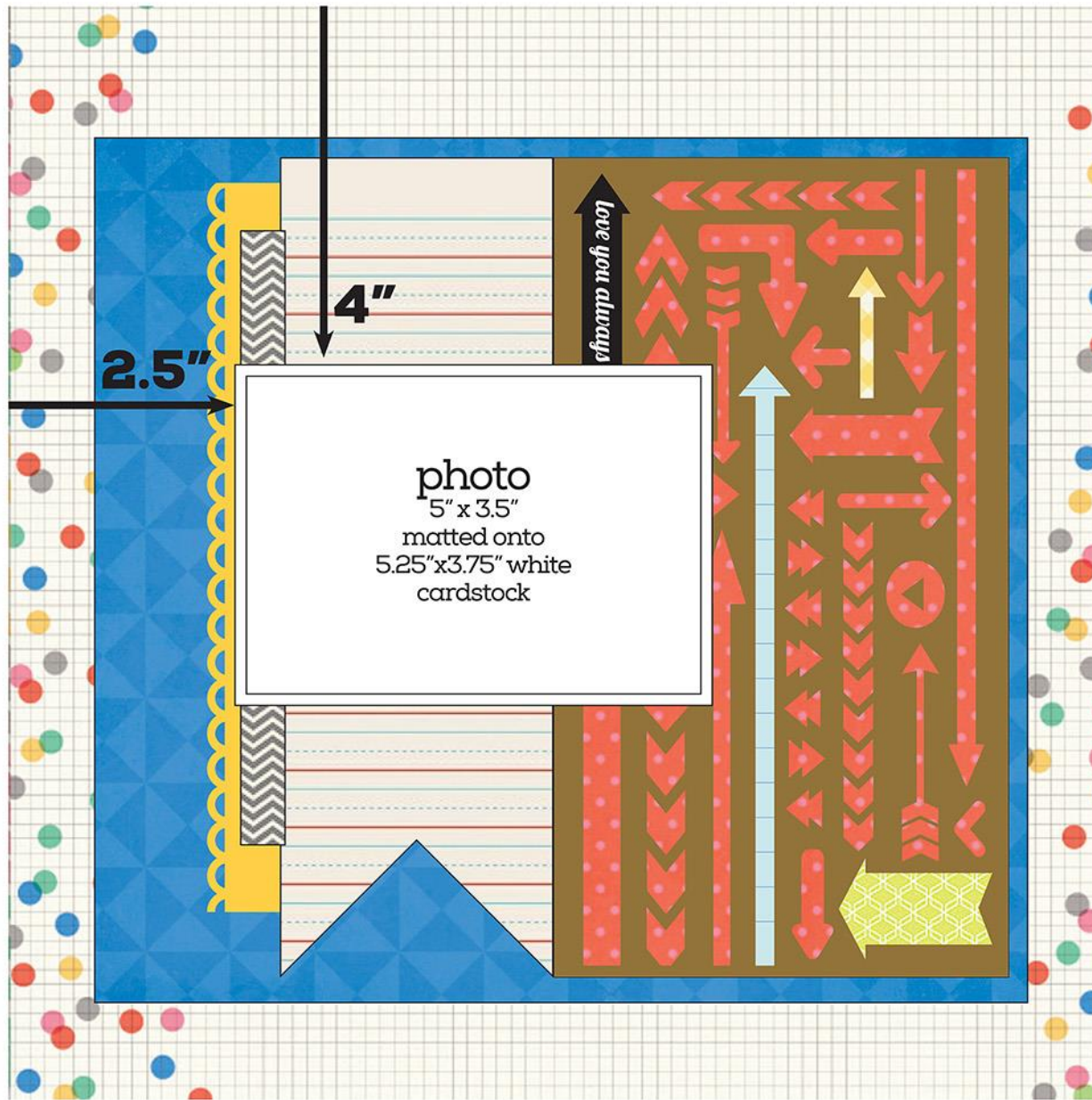
Tuck the punched yellow cardstock piece under the left edge of the Love You More Andy piece and adhere.



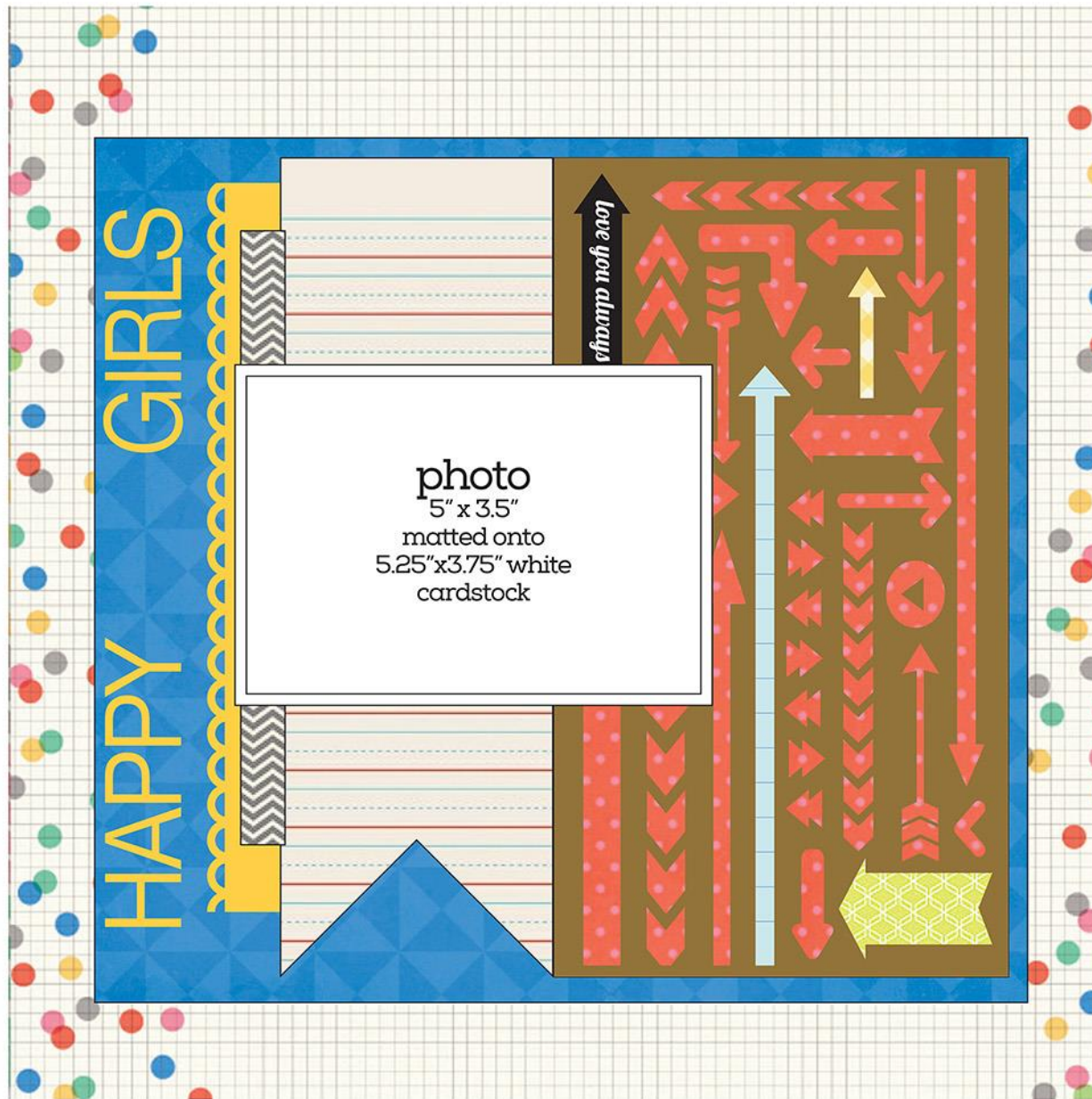


Adhere the chevron strip vertically on top of the yellow strip, leaving .75" of the cardstock exposed at the top and bottom, and slightly overlapping the banner.





Mat your photo as shown and adhere it over the banner, 4" down from the top edge and 2.5" from the left edge.



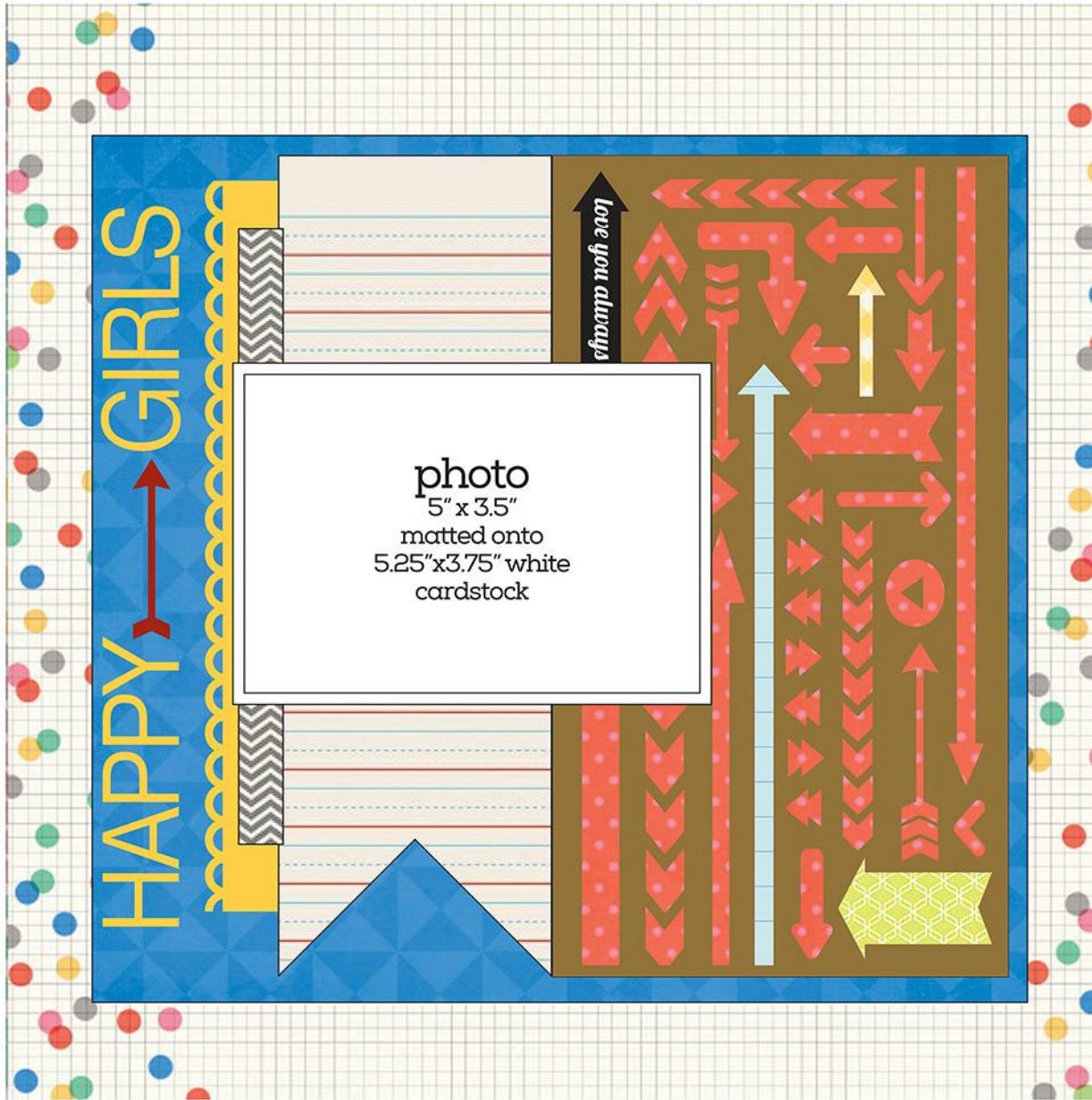
Spell out your title vertically along the left side of the blue paper, leaving a 2" gap as shown.



Select one of the leftover kraft arrows from the die cut and color it with red spray mist.



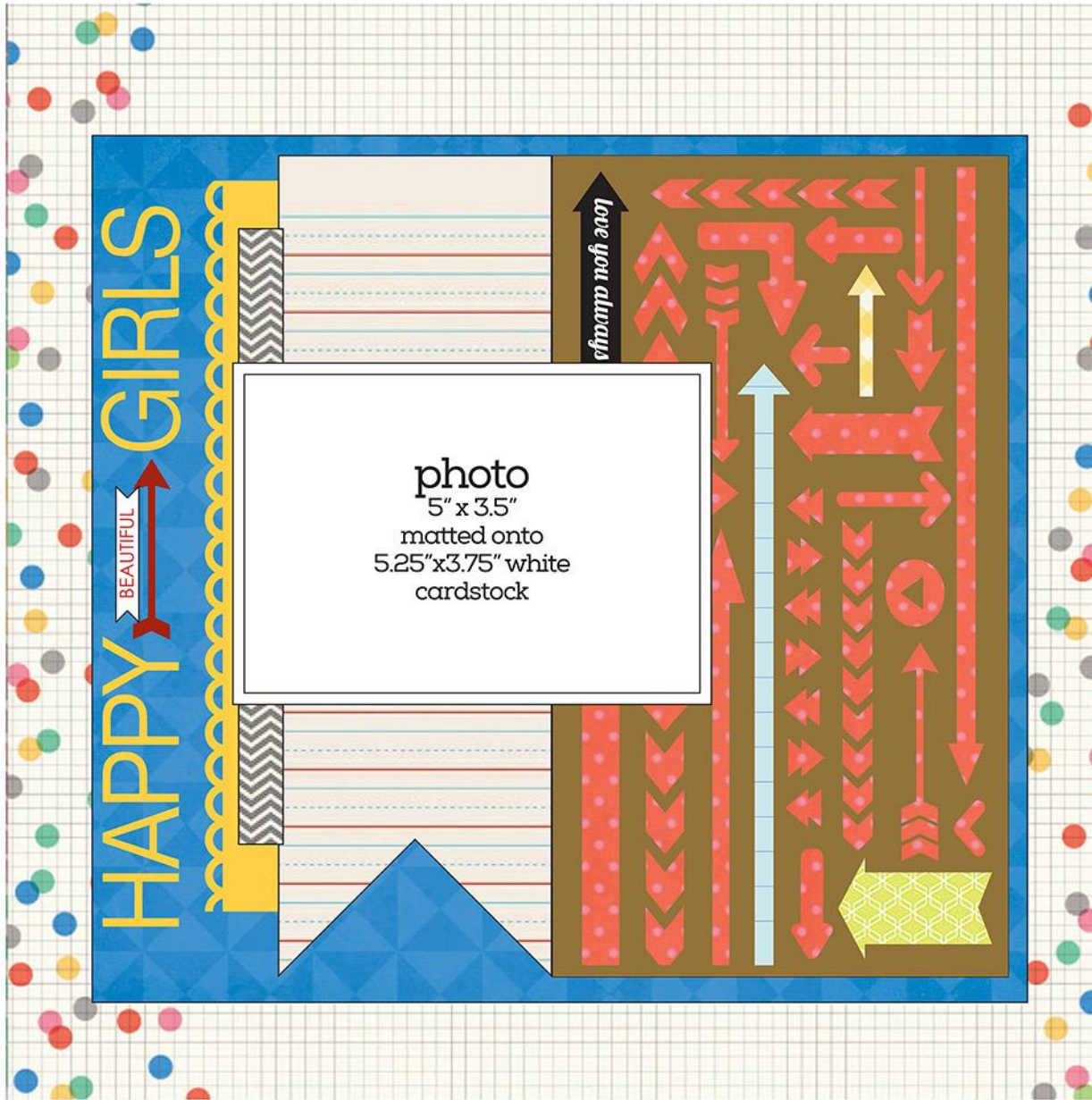




Adhere the red arrow in the 2" gap of your title.



Cut the "beautiful" word sticker from the Echo Park Photo Freedom sticker sheet into a .25"x1.5" banner and adhere to the left side of the misted arrow.

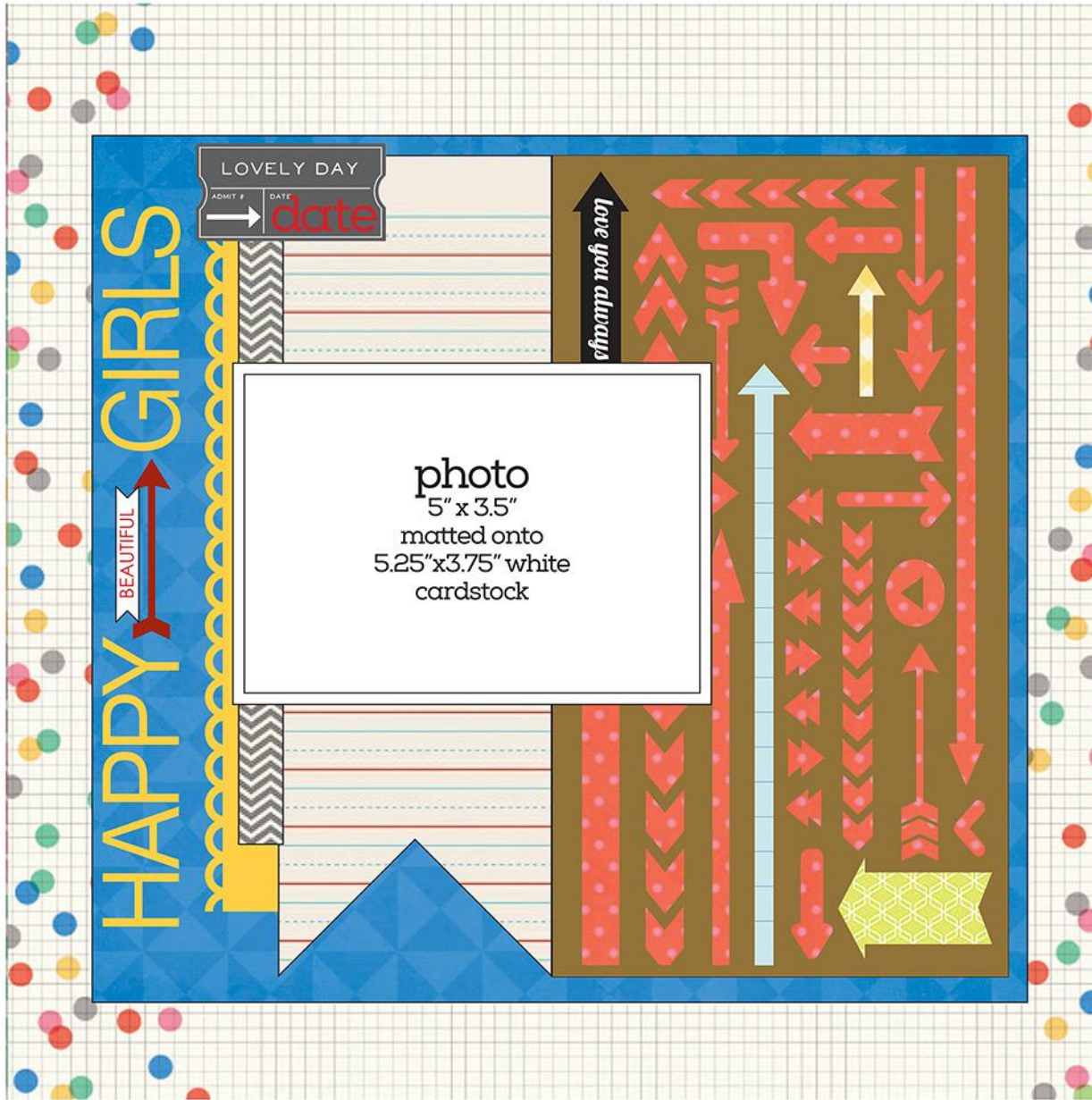


Adhere the "beautiful" sticker directly to the left of the red arrow.





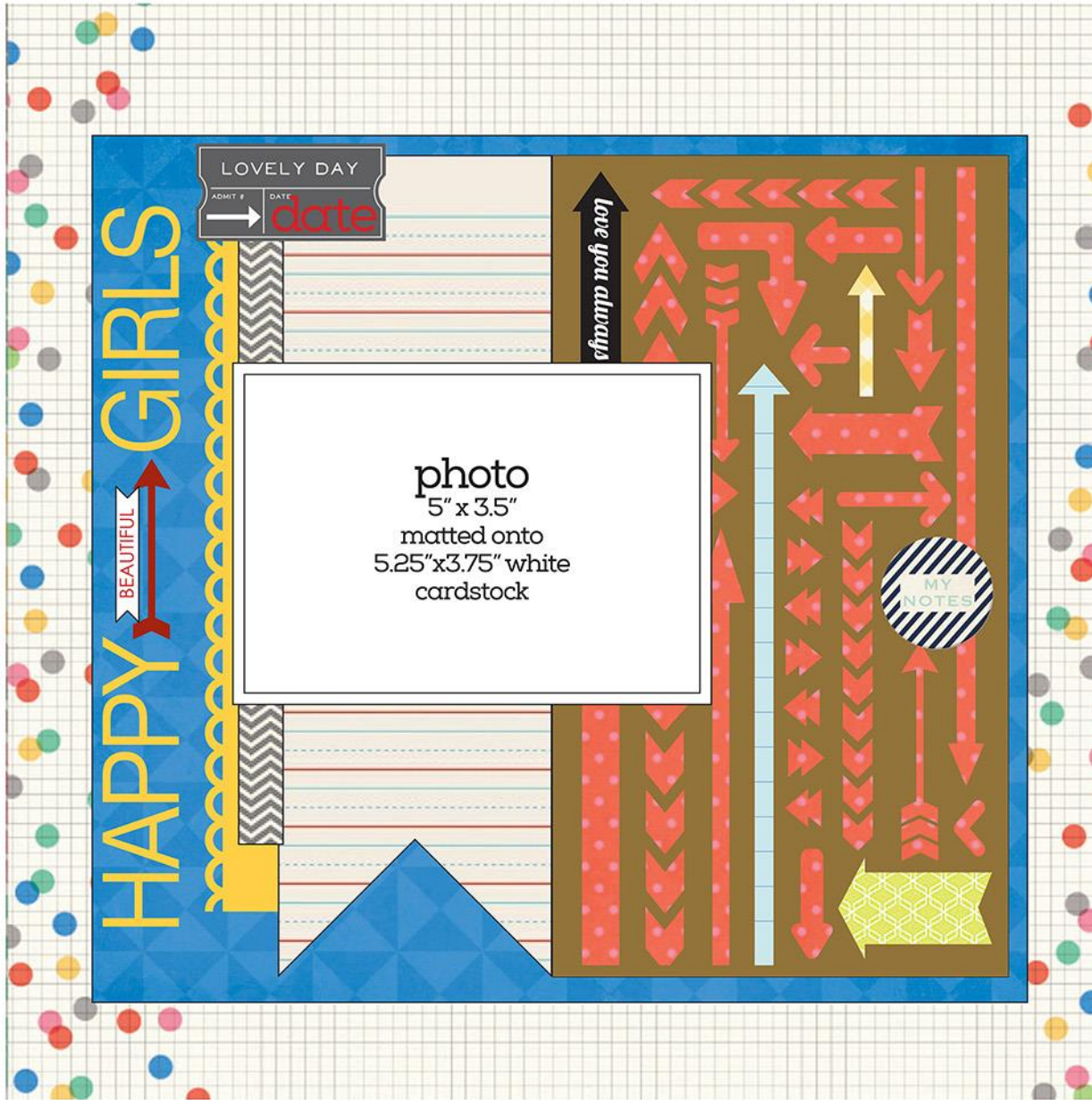
Trim out a grey ticket from American Crafts Lemonade Stand paper. Add a date with red letter stickers in the date area and a small, white arrow sticker in the "admit" area.



Adhere the ticket 1" from the left edge of the Saltwater Pinwheels piece, overlapping the journaling banner as shown.

Add hand-journaling to the banner above and below the photo.





Adhere a flair button on the right side of the arrow die cut negative piece as shown.





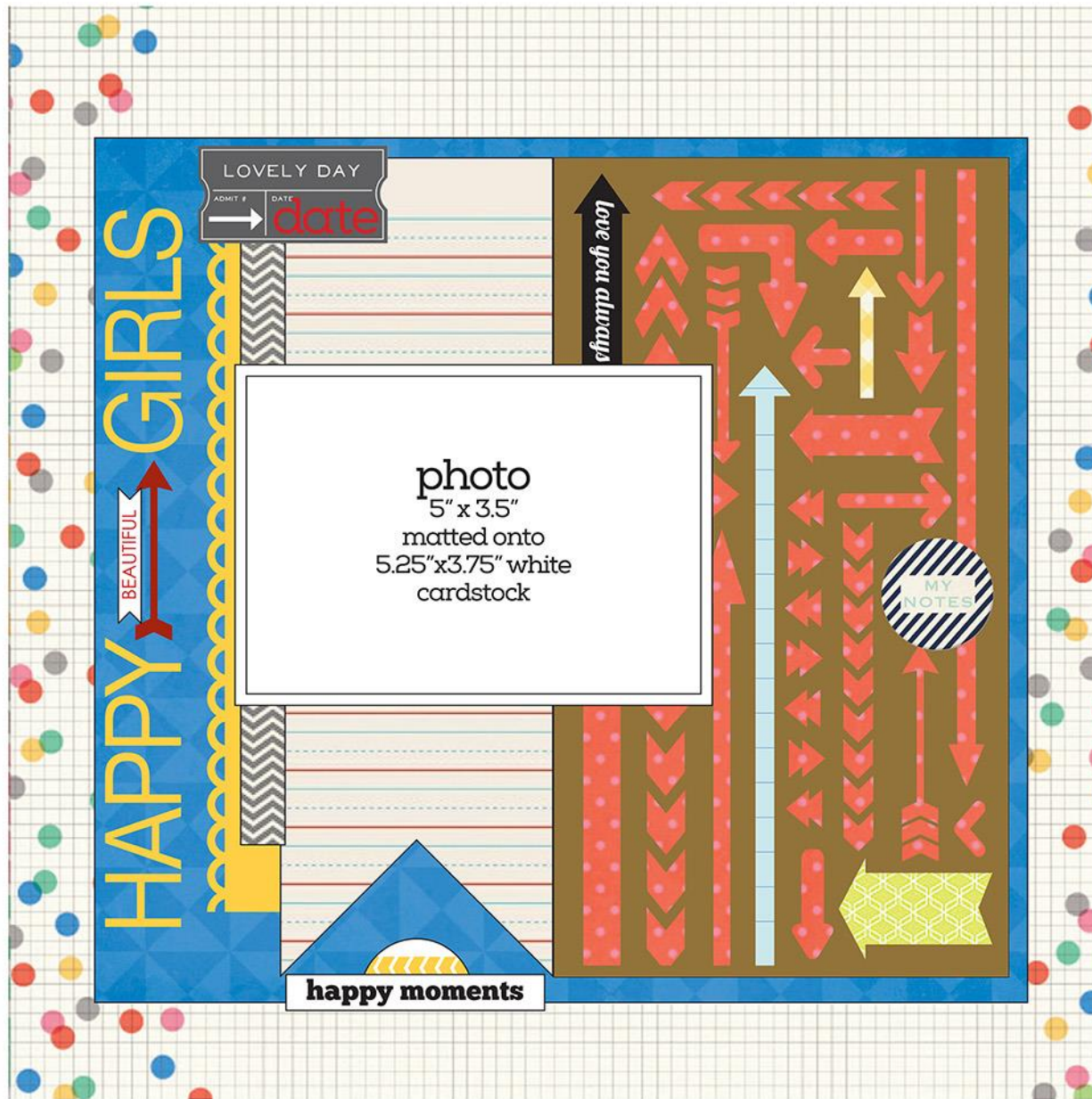

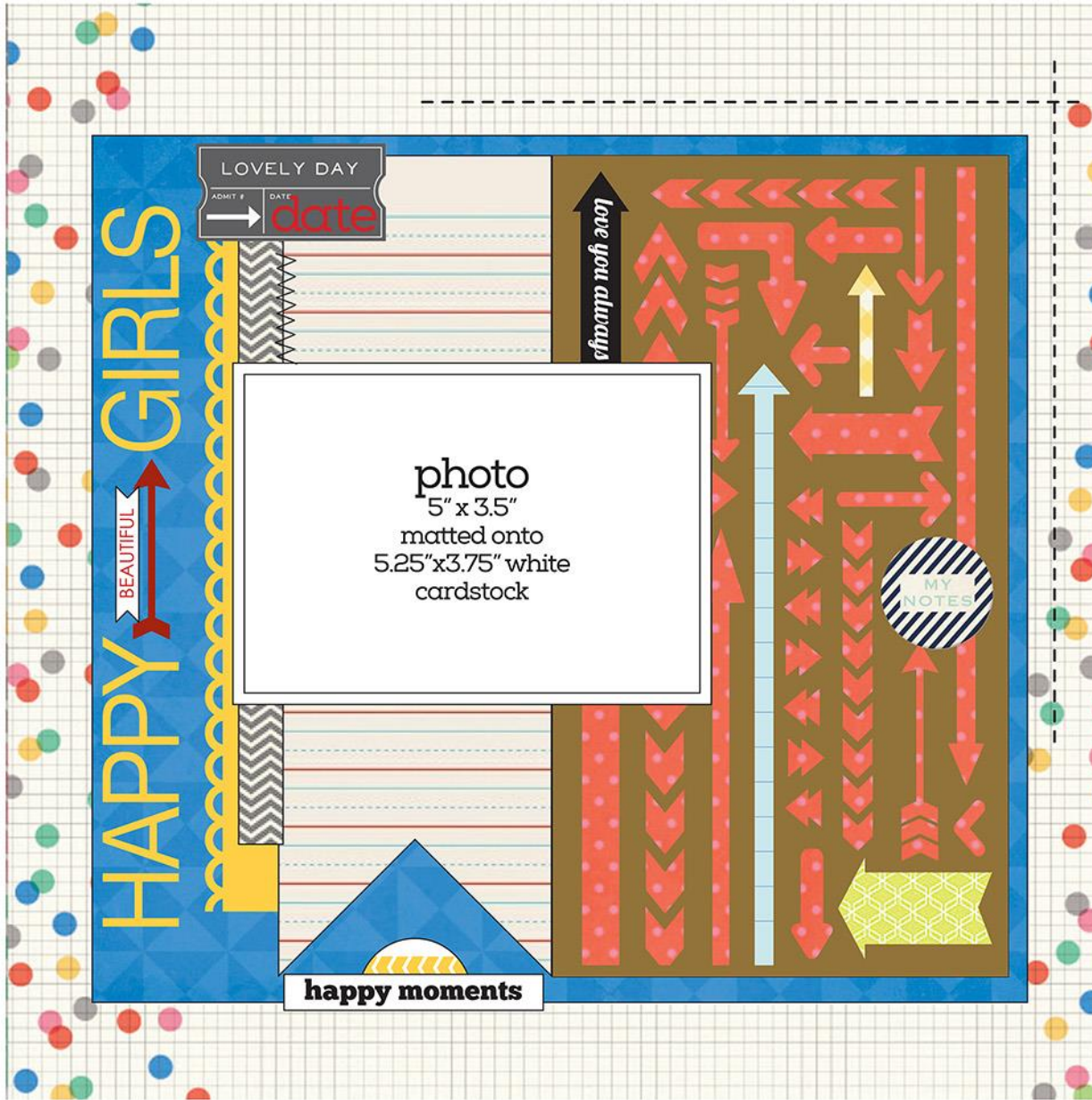
Trim the Elle's Studio Day to Day die cut to 2.75"x.25," leaving only the "happy moments" sentiment.

Cut the yellow Elle's Studio Serendipity circle die cut in half and place, centered, above the "happy moments" die cut.



Adhere the assembled pieces below the V-notch of the journaling banner as shown.





Add machine or faux hand stitching to the top, right side of the layout as shown.

Zig-zag stitch between the date ticket and photo.
