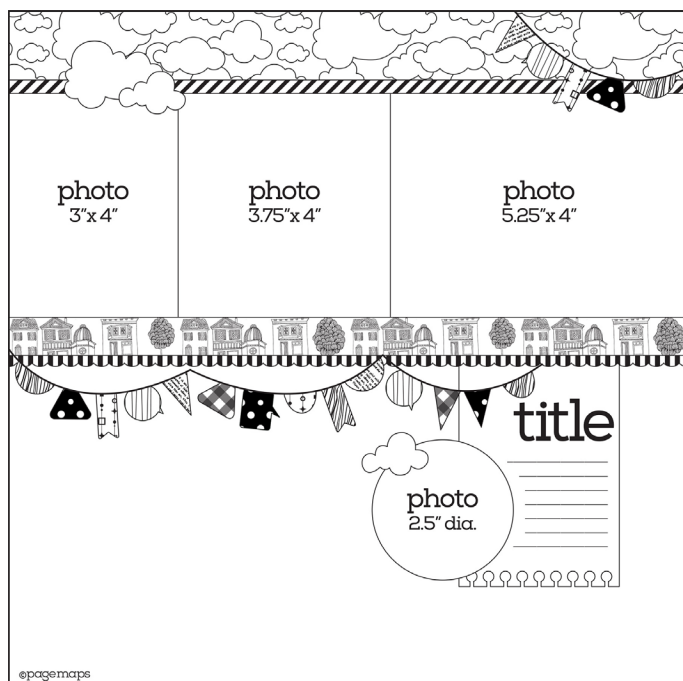

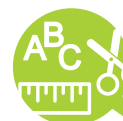

### basic tools

Favorite adhesive

Dimensional (foam) adhesive

Fine-tipped scissors

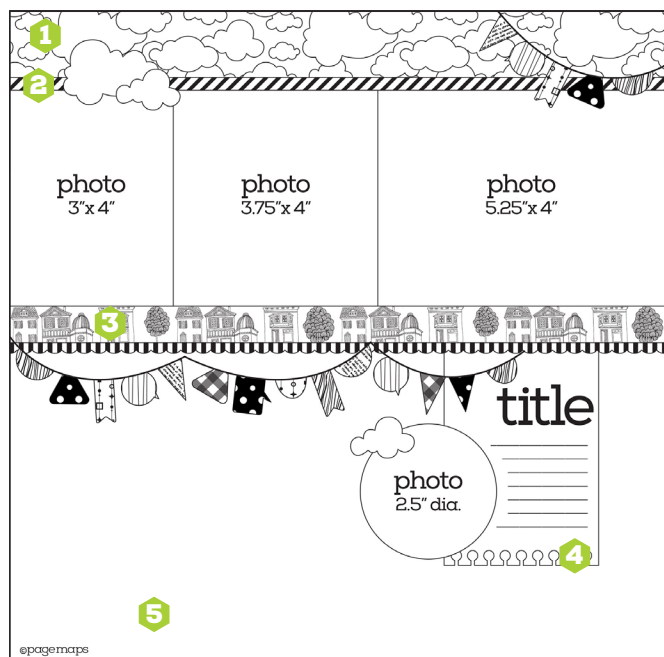


### photo dimensions

### trimming dimensions

### layout instructions

- 1 Locate sheet of Pretty Party Hat patterned paper (aqua/yellow floral) and remove tear strip from bottom of sheet. This piece is your layout base.
- 2 Trim a 12"x3" piece from Terrific Tunes (splattered teal) patterned paper. Trim a 3"x12" piece of Clever Card (splattered aqua) patterned paper from the right side. Trim a 4"x6" piece of notebook paper and a 4"x6" piece of yellow paper from the back side of the Clever Card patterned paper.
- 3 From the die cutting file, die cut clouds from the strip of Clever Card paper. Set clouds aside. Adhere the remaining negative strip over the teal splattered strip, as shown, and adhere horizontally along the top edge of your base.
- 4 Trim a 12" chevron strip from Flourishing Flowers (teal chevron). Adhere strip directly under the cut cloud piece.
- 5 Trim the tear strip from a sheet of Delightful Display (aqua stripe) and set aside. Trim two 12"x.25" strips against the grain so there are more stripes per strip. Adhere one strip directly under the chevron piece. Set remaining piece aside.
- 6 Trim a 12"x1" strip from Fascinating Friends (wood grain) patterned paper. Cut out two frames with 1.5"x2" openings and two frames with 2"x2" openings from the back side of the wood grain paper.
- 7 Adhere the 12"x1" strip of wood grain paper horizontally across the layout base, 6.5" from the top edge. Adhere the remaining 12"x.25" striped strip directly below it.
- 8 Adhere the four cut frames in the space between the upper striped strip and the wood grain strip as shown. Allow for overlapping to create visual interest. Adhere photos to corresponding frames.
- 9 Using a straight edge/ruler and a black pen, draw dashed lines along the top and bottom of the layout, as well as along the bottom of the splattered aqua strip as shown.
- 10 Trim out three sets of leaves from the floral side of Flourishing Flowers. Tuck cut leaves under the upper left and both lower corners of the third frame.
- 11 Locate Picture Perfect patterned paper. Cut a camera from the paper and remove tear strip. Set aside tear strip for later. Using dimensional adhesive, adhere the cut camera to the left lower corner of the third picture frame. Tie an 8" piece of linen twine around a yellow heart pin and tuck behind the camera, securing it in the foam.
- 12 Locate the "truest of true" tear strip. Notch ends into a banner just to the right of the sentiment. Adhere strip next to camera on the right as shown.
- 13 Punch a 2" circle from the yellow 4"x6" block. Punch one 4"x.25" scallop strip and five 1.5"x.5" strips from the same yellow block. Adhere the yellow circle to the upper left cloud. Arrange the five 1.5"x.5" strips around the circle like sun rays.
- 14 Locate the aqua splattered clouds from step 3. Arrange, as shown, along the aqua splattered strip at the top of the layout.
- 15 Add three small yellow enamel dots to the bottom of the left-most cloud. Adhere a larger yellow enamel dot to the center of the camera lens.
- 16 Using small brown letter stickers, adhere the word "Home" to the two small clouds in the upper right portion of the layout. Adhere the word "TWEET" with aqua chipboard letters to the larger cloud.
- 17 Trim a 3"x3.25" piece from the 4"x6" notebook block remaining from step 2. Use a punch or die to trim one 4" edge into a notebook edge. Print or write journaling on block then adhere flush with the bottom of the lower striped strip and 1.5" from the right edge of the page.
- 18 Trim an 8" piece of the polka dot section from the Picture Perfect tear strip. Trim short edges into a banner shape then fold in each end to create a banner.
- 19 Lay banner over 4" yellow scallop strip section and secure with a stapler along the top edge of the notebook journaling block.



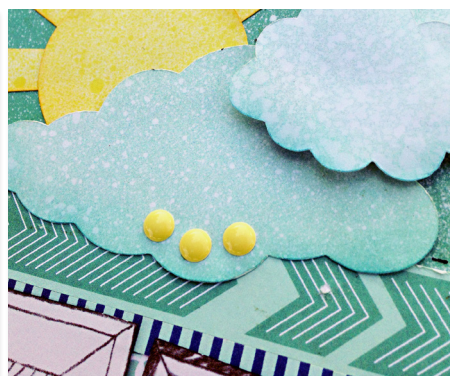
## close-up photos



Sometimes the smallest detail can complete a page, as Kelly proves here. By adding a yellow epoxy dot to the center of the camera lens, this very small embellishment really stands out!

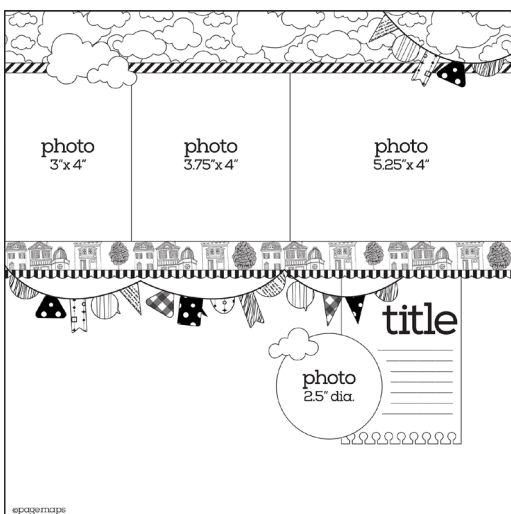


Does the thought of ink spray misting on a page give you shivers? Here's a cheater's way to get the same, beautiful result: choose spattered patterned papers as Kelly did on her layout.



Kelly's sharpened and defined her tone-on-tone pieces by inking the edges of the clouds with aqua chalk ink, then attaching them with foam pop dots.

## cutting files

NOTE: cutting files are provided in .svg and .dxf formats and work with most leading electronic die cutters (Silhouette, Cricut, Pazzle, etc.). If you do not have an electronic die cutter, you can print this page and hand cut the shapes with a craft knife.



note: the 12"x3" cloud cut out is saved in its own cutting file for those who have a 12x12 cutting platform. If you choose to hand cut this piece, refer to the layout photo for placement of the clouds above to create the same negative strip.
