There will be no increase in parking charges this year thanks to the decision by Mayor Dave **Hodgson** and colleagues.

This includes the two hours free parking deal. The deal was first introduced by Mayor Dave **Hodgson** in 2013. As well as two hours free on Saturdays in council town centre car parks, Queen Street car park is free for the first two hours every weekday as well.

Charles Royden said "This is great news for residents as well as our local town centre shops. I know that local people want to see a thriving town centre in Bedford and this free parking deal really helps. With the Queens Street Car Park offer, you can park for two hours free every day."

Brickhill Parish Council news

The Lib Dem led parish council has set its Council Tax for 2019/20, with a small reduction of 4p compared to last year. The total precept is £121,000 and the budget was agreed unanimously. Mark Fitzpatrick is the chair of the parish council: "Next year we aim to replace some play equipment on Waveney Green, continue to put on the free 'Gathering on the Green' event in the summer, invest in an additional CCTV camera, carry out more

Northamptonshire council tax payers are going to be asked to stump up an extra five per cent on their council tax payments for county council services from April.

With Mayor Dave Hodgson and the Lib Dems, Council Tax rises have been kept under tight control, including 5 years of no increase at all.

This contrasts with our neighbouring Conservative-run council in Northamptonshire where they are proposing a 5% increase this year.

Dave Hodgson said "My priority is to protect frontline services without hitting the pockets of hard pressed local taxpayers. We do that by cutting costs at the council to protect the services that residents rely upon."
