

# **Success you can see from the Lib Dems**



Lib Dems have allocated £2m extra over the last year to get more roads and pavements resurfaced. Now a new £25m four year programme has been launched to go even further

In the last few years we have seen resurfacing of all or part of Tyne Crescent, Brickhill Drive, Manton Lane and Torridge Rise. In 2019/20 Douglas Road, Hindburn Close, Connaught Way, Marlow Way, Norfolk Close and Regent Close will be resurfaced. We are determined to tackle the backlog of road and footpath maintenance.
