



Launching the plans for the brand new bus station in Bedford, **Dave Hodgson** said "For decades now it has been widely recognised that Bedford bus station lets the town down. It is a topic that comes up time and time again as I speak to people across the Borough whether they are bus users or not, and I could not agree more with all those who tell me that it is a deeply unattractive gateway to our town. That's why I am delighted to reveal our plans for a brand new bus station and other improvements to revitalise this area. The funding is all in place and the planning application has been approved. It will present a far more inviting sight and offer modern, improved facilities for bus users."

Clir Wendy Rider added "This is great news for Bedford. We have been waiting far too many years to get this area up to modern standards. It's great that the Mayor has cut through the obstacles and is delivering this."

Bus Station Area Redevelopment includes:

- ☑Demolishing existing bus station and building a brand new modern building.
- ☑Essential refurbishment of the old and run down multistorey car park.
- ☑A new surface car park on the site of the former blocks of flats across the road on Greyfriars.
- ☑Brand new public toilets, with the old ones replaced with clean, high quality new facilities.
- ✓ New paving, landscaping and seating in front of the multistorey car park, with new shop fronts too.

Tories propose Gypsy and Traveller Site in Brickhill

Mayor Dave Hodgson has rejected Conservative proposals for unnecessary Gypsy and Traveller sites throughout Bedford in urban and rural areas. The Tory proposals would see green spaces and crucial employment sites developed as gypsy and traveller accommodation in entirely unsuitable locations. This is despite the fact that all sites required in the Borough through to 2021 have either already been developed or have full planning permission in place. The Tories proposals include Little Park Farm, accessed from Hawk Drive in Brickhill, which they described as an 'ideal' location for a gypsy site. Little Park Farm contains buildings and pasture land and has been let for agricultural purposes for many years.

Hawk Drive is a heavily congested road, in particular because of traffic associated with Beauchamp Middle and Scott Lower Schools; adding the extra traffic associated with a travellers site may significantly add to the traffic problems and risks.

Mayor Dave Hodgson said: "We reject these unnecessary and indiscriminate proposals for new gypsy and traveller sites all over the Borough. We have a clear plan for dealing with this issue and have already made considerable progress for the first time in years. Already, an additional six pitches have been delivered at the existing Kempston Hardwick site and full planning permission is in place at Meadow Lane for the rest of the pitches required in the Borough. These proposals from the Conservatives would locate gypsy and traveller pitches at sites which are utterly unsuitable".

Liberal Democrat Councillor for Brickhill Ward Cllr Charles Royden added: "Brickhill residents will be shocked by the Conservatives' plans to build a site off Hawk Drive. These are simply not responsible, sensible proposals. We reject them and will continue with delivery of our clear plan in place on gypsy and traveller sites".

Local Tories try to hold Bedford Back



Local Tory councillors repeatedly throw cold water on and even try to hold up projects that come forward to regenerate Bedford Borough and bring jobs to our area.

Clir Charles Royden said "It is no wonder that when the Conservatives made the decisions locally, improvements were few and far between, even in the economic boom times. We are now seeing a whole range of new projects that will bring jobs and life to parts of Bedford, but each time we see the Tories rushing to the newspapers to have

a moan or even trying to put obstacles in the way at Council meetings. Even in reaction to the new bus station plan, they went straight to the press to raise concerns rather than welcome it!"

They have a track record of trying to hold Bedford back. Other recent examples include opposition to the new Morrisons Store; obstructing the decision that agreed the deal with the new town centre hotel because they want the council to remove MORE public car park spaces to give to the hotel; opposing the plans for the new town centre cinema and riverside restaurants; obstructing the decision to allow the developer time to put in a new doctors surgery in Goldington.
