Councillors Wendy Rider and Charles Royden are urging local residents to join Mayor Dave Hodgson and people from all political backgrounds in fighting for the survival of Bedford Hospital as we know it.

Charles said "Plans from NHS commissioners could mean the end of Bedford Hospital as a proper hospital. We may end up with a so called 'Integrated Care Centre' not a hospital. What is particularly worrying is that the downgraded A&E wouldn't be a full A&E at all, with any patients with a serious condition having to be driven miles away to another hospital."

Wendy added "The campaign is working. They have already been made to back down from proposals that the hospital would have no beds at all! But we must keep up the pressure or else we will end up with a huge number of the health services people rely on in a time of need moving to other hospitals in other towns and cities.'

Up-to-date bus info




Clirs Charles Royden & Wendy Rider in Tyne Crescent
