What is a Limited credit programme? (LCP)

A LCP is a group of unit standards that that are designed for specific environments. A LCP is **not** a National or New Zealand Certificate, however the unit standards may be part of a National or New Zealand certificate.

How long will it take?

A total of 40 credits is required for this qualification, on average it will take 8 months to complete. We will check your NZQA Record of Achievement for any Unit Standards that you may have already completed toward this qualification; these will not need to be repeated.

Fees

The administration and material fee in required when we receive the training agreement. This is a non-refundable fee. The training fee is invoiced when a trainee submits an assessment to us for marking.

Instructor/Assessor qualifications
