<p>Professional Service Charge includes the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 24/7/365 availability for a telephone or email response to a service request made by the Office of the Public Trustee (OPGT) Caseworker to discuss the details of the service request and the possibility for immediate services. • transfer of the deceased from the place of death to a maximum of 50 kilometres roundtrip from the respondent's place of business. A rate of \$1.13 per kilometre will be applied for all kilometres calculated after the initial 50 kilometres • communications regarding all services provided and matters related to these funeral services will be communicated through the licensed Funeral Director and the OPGT Caseworker • contacting all necessary agencies and completing all necessary documentation associated with conducting and concluding the funeral and burial or cremation. • completing all documentation to fulfil directive from the responsible survivor and/or OPGT for disposition • completing all necessary documents for the provision of CPP death benefit only • liaising with OPGT Caseworker and Decedents' Family regarding funeral arrangements • discussing with OPGT Caseworker or if directed, with the family the type of casket/alternative container to order, taking the receipt and preparing the item for service • providing vehicle and staff in a professional manner and to transport deceased to the place of disposition • preparing and implementing all public notices whether printed, radio or website based • posting obituary notice on Funeral home website, all necessary administrative and overhead costs to maintain, staff, vehicles, additional licensing fees, insurance, security, continuing education and taxes (federal, provincial and municipal) 	<p style="text-align: right;">\$1485</p>

<p>Facilities – includes the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • facility for professional care and accommodating the deceased until the time of disposition • use of arrangement offices and display areas • use of viewing rooms and chapel space • use of all facilities required within the funeral service provider’s premises or control • all necessary administrative and overhead costs to maintain the facilities • all other miscellaneous costs. 	<p>\$700</p>
<p>Ceremonial Farewell at Facility – includes the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • coordinating and attending an event that meets the cultural or religious needs of the deceased through a gathering for family and the community at a facility (community hall, religious facility, funeral home chapel, cemetery, crematorium, or other suitable location selected by the responsible survivor) within the funeral service provider’s municipality • the event may include a combination of a ceremony at the facility adequate staff and equipment costs specifically related to the facilitation of a ceremony at the cemetery or crematorium for either a casket or a cremation urn <p>NOTE: Food and refreshments are NOT included as part of this fee</p>	<p>\$800</p>
<p>Ceremonial Farewell at Cemetery – includes the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a committal service at the cemetery or crematorium if requested by the OPGT Caseworker or by the Decedent’s family • all other miscellaneous costs <p>NOTE: Food and refreshments are NOT included as part of this fee</p>	<p>\$490</p>
<p>Basic Preparation Open Casket – includes the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • bathing, disinfecting, purifying if required for a religious belief, and dressing the deceased in clothing provided for the Decedents dignity • all other miscellaneous costs 	<p>\$300</p>

<p>Basic Preparation Closed Casket – includes the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • bathing, disinfecting, purifying if required for a religious belief, and dressing the deceased in clothing provided for the Decedents dignity • all other miscellaneous costs 	<p>\$200</p>
<p>Embalming Preparation – includes the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • professional embalming preparation of the deceased by a licensed embalmer for sanitation, restoration, and preservation • cosmetics, hair styling, dressing, and casketing of the deceased for viewing, when requested or required • all other miscellaneous costs 	<p>\$600</p>
<p>Advanced Embalming Preparation – includes the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • if required, due to the autopsy, advanced decomposition, trauma, or Schedule 1 or Schedule 2 diseases • in addition to embalming preparation (surcharge) • could be required when disposition is delayed for any reason • all other miscellaneous costs <p>NOTE: Your fee (if any) for advanced embalming preparation should not include amount included in the regular embalming fee</p>	<p>\$375</p>
<p>Casket (burial) – includes the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lynx Brown (Batesville) • Hudson Select (Imperial) • or other similar casket approved by the OPGT Caseworker or Family Member • all other miscellaneous costs 	<p>\$2563</p>
