Site Visit Authorization Limited Release from Federal Quarantine

In response to the risks posed by the outbreak of COVID-19, a person entering Canada is subject to any order made under section 58 of the federal *Quarantine Act* (S.C. 2005, c. 20) requiring all asymptomatic persons who enter Canada to quarantine for a period of at least 14 days that begins on the day on which the person enters Canada, subject to certain limited exemptions. A person may apply for a limited release from quarantine for the following circumstances:

- To attend to the death of or provide support to a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, temporary resident, protected person or a person registered as an Indian under the *Indian Act* who is residing in Canada and who is deemed by a licensed health care professional to be critically ill.
- To provide care for a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, temporary resident, protected person or a person registered as an Indian under the *Indian Act* who is residing in Canada and who is deemed by a licensed health care professional to have a medical reason as to why they require support.
- To attend a funeral or end of life ceremony.

The Traveller has requested a limited release from quarantine for one of the above-mentioned circumstances. In order to confirm this purpose, this form should be completed and signed by an administrator of a health care facility, health care professional, homeowner/proprietor, or funeral/bereavement services provider (hereinafter "administrator") to confirm that the Traveller will be permitted to visit the premises for the specified period.

The conditions under the federal *Quarantine Act* applicable to the Traveller during the site visit are to wear a non-medical mask or face covering for the duration of the site visit, and maintain a 2-metre physical distance from others where possible. Notwithstanding, you may wish to institute additional procedures and protocols appropriate to address the public health risk posed by the visit at your facility or site.

Providing false information: It is an offence under the *Quarantine Act* to provide a false or misleading statement. Alternatively, you could also be issued a fine under the *Contraventions Act*.

Privacy notice: The personal information provided is governed in accordance with the *Privacy Act*. We collect the information needed for the Public Health Agency of Canada (PHAC) to administer and enforce the Minimizing the Risk of Exposure to COVID-19 in Canada Order (Mandatory Isolation), the Quarantine Program (authorized under the *Quarantine Act*), and for programs or activities of PHAC authorized by the *Quarantine Act* and/or *Department of Health Act*. This information is collected and used by PHAC in relation to the Traveller's application for "Exemption on Compassionate Grounds of COVID-19 Travel Restrictions" and/or "Limited Release from Quarantine" and may also be disclosed to the following entities: law enforcement (including, in particular, peace officers), other government institutions, as well as provincial, territorial, municipal governments or organizations as well as their institutions. In limited and specific circumstances, personal information may be used and disclosed without consent in accordance with subsection 8(2) of the *Privacy Act*.

Your rights under the *Privacy Act*: In addition to protecting your personal information, the *Privacy Act* gives you the right to request access to and request correction of your personal information.
