






73 College Credit Hours Offered

FCS offers an extensive list of dual enrollment/dual credit opportunities; however, each university sets its own policy as to how many credits a student may transfer while still be considered for incoming-freshmen scholarships (as compared to entering as a transfer student).

In order to receive a Friendship Christian School diploma, students are expected to be enrolled at FCS a minimum of four semesters of their high school career.
