QUALIFICATION TITLE: Award in Work with Parents (intense support for families

with multiple and complex needs)

QUALIFICATION LEVEL: Level 4

Introduction

This award is designed for keyworkers delivering intense support to families with multiple and complex needs using the family intervention model. The award carries 12 credits and can usually be completed within 9-12 months.

Who should take this qualification?

People who are working in Family Intervention Projects, Social Care Settings or Children's Centres who require the skills to work effectively with families who are experiencing multiple and complex issues.

Qualification Content and Assessment Information

Study Location: Work based

How is the qualification delivered? There is an opportunity for attendance of 5 taught workshops where groups of learners (5 or more) are enrolled from one setting. For individual learners tasks would be set for independent study.

Unit one – Build and maintain relationships in Work with Parents

Unit two – Understand and use persistent and proactive intervention methods when working with families with complex and multiple needs.

Unit three – Work with families with complex and multiple needs to reduce and prevent antisocial behaviour and increase positive behaviour.

Assessment and Exams: There are no exams for this qualification. The qualification is an ongoing assessment of learners work plus Observation, Discussion, Expert Witness and Assignments. Learners are allocated an experienced assessor who will have competency in your

field and will support and guide the learner and ensure that the range of evidence produced fulfils the following criteria;

Valid is relevant to the standards for which competence is claimed Authentic is produced by the learner Reliable indicates that the learner can consistently perform at this level Current is sufficiently recent to create confidence that the same skill, understanding or knowledge persist at the time of the claim Sufficient fully meets the requirements of the standards

General Information

Payment Options: This qualification can be paid for in full or via our Flexi Payment Plan which spreads the cost over 4 consecutive equal payments.

Start Date: This is a rolling programme. Start date is by arrangement.

Entry requirements: There are no formal entry requirements although a good standard of English and Maths is necessary and initial assessments are offered to learners without prior achievement

Learners who achieve these qualifications could work in Family Intervention projects, Social Care settings and Children's Centres.
