COURSE TITLE: Health and Safety in the Workplace Level 2 CIEH Award

COURSE LEVEL: 2

DURATION: One day

Introduction

A good knowledge of health and safety is essential to all employees in any organisation in order to ensure the maximum safety, security and welfare of all persons. This training course provides learners with the knowledge required of the broad range of health and safety related issues in the workplace and identifies the responsibilities of the employer and employee in ensuring everybody's safety.

Benefits of Attending

Learners will be required to complete a 30 question multiple-choice test paper as part of the training day, and will need to achieve a score of 20 out of 30 correct answers to achieve the Level 2 Award in Health and Safety in the Workplace which is accredited by the Chartered Institute of Environmental Health (CIEH) and Ofqual.
