COURSE TITLE: Child care law standards and guidance LEVEL: 3

COURSE

DURATION: One day

Introduction

This course is designed to provide participants with an outline of the relevant legislation that covers working in residential child care, including the 1989 Children Act, the National Minimum Standards (Children's Homes) and Every Child Matters. It also looks briefly at Criminal law in relation to Young people, at Children's Rights and Discrimination Legislation.

Benefits of Attending

Staff will have a clear understanding of the legal framework in which we work and in particular the requirements of the Care Standards Act 2000 and the National Minimum Standards for Children's Homes, and their role in meeting and improving the required standards.
