

# **COURSE OUTLINE**

COURSE TITLE: Risk assessments

COURSE LEVEL: 3

DURATION: Half day

## Introduction

This course is designed to give learners the knowledge and skills to enable them to complete child focused risk assessments which are balanced, and will reduce risks to children and young people, and everyone involved in the care of children and young people.

### **Benefits of Attending**

It will help learners to identify potential hazards, evaluate risk levels and potential frequency, plan and develop control measures, record and implement, and review and update child focused risk assessments. Risks include risks to self and risks to others.
