Introduction

Equality, diversity and inclusion are important subjects that are often given little or no priority. They are about the most important of subjects; opportunity, rights, privacy, respect, empowerment, choice and dignity. This course gives managers an opportunity to have an unhurried and in depth look at the area and time to reflect on our practice in order to make real differences to real people.
