COURSE TITLE: Safeguarding for managers COURSE LEVEL: 5

DURATION: One day

Introduction

An in-depth look at the subject of child protection from the manager's position of responsibility. Looking at how planning and staff training can assist in promoting a safe environment. Looking at how to promote safe working practices

Understanding how to deal with incidents and difficult situations, understanding what to report and when to report. Looking at issues of dangerous practice. Looking at how to deal with operational tensions within organisations.

Benefits of Attending

A chance to gain a greater understanding of safeguarding responsibilities, to examine your own attitudes and values and understand the guidelines for dealing with child protection incidents. Look at issues of sexualised behaviour and aggressive or violent behaviour including bullying.
