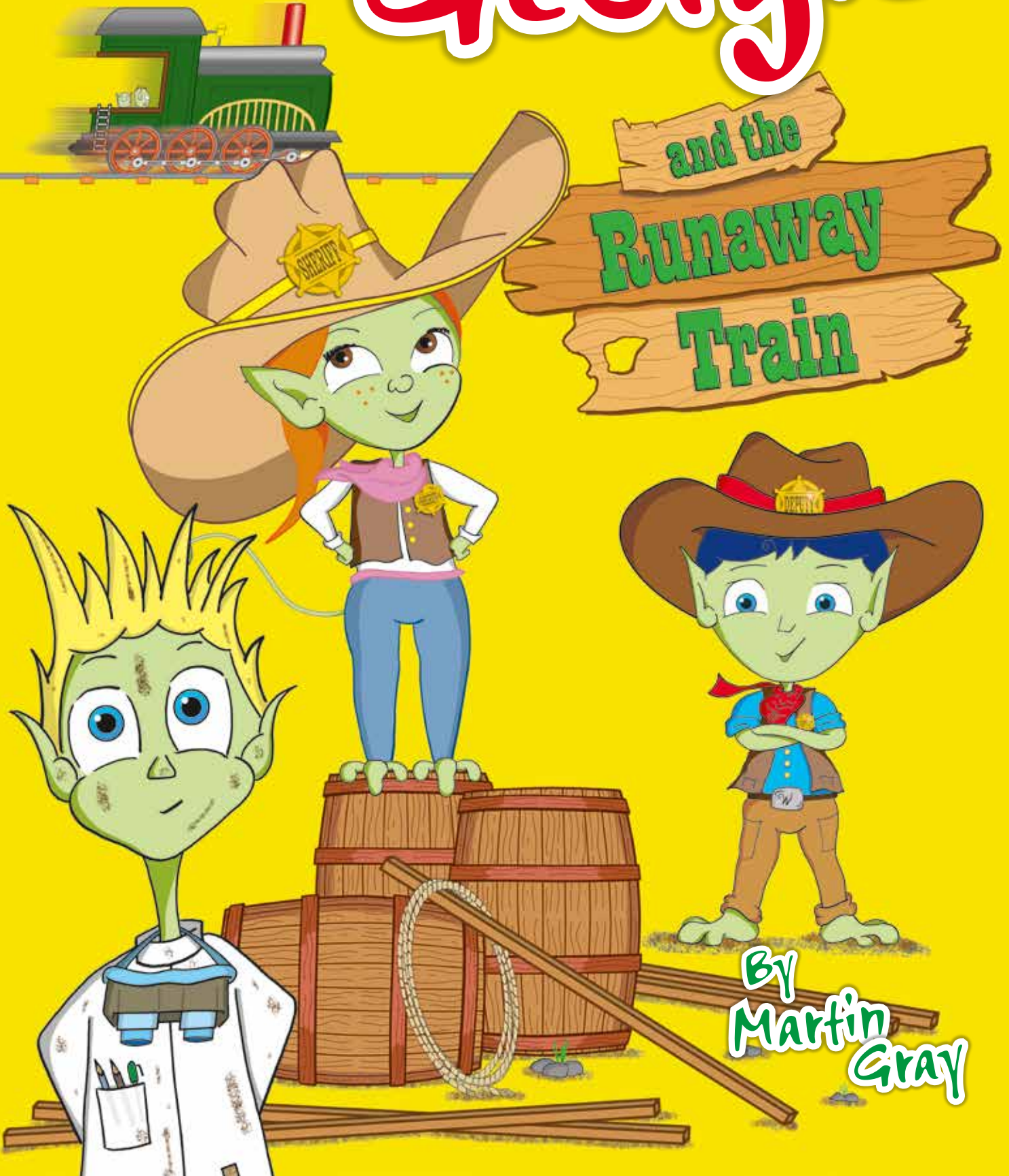


Sheriff Georgie

There was a party at Cooksville's train station that morning, to raise money to fix a broken bridge.

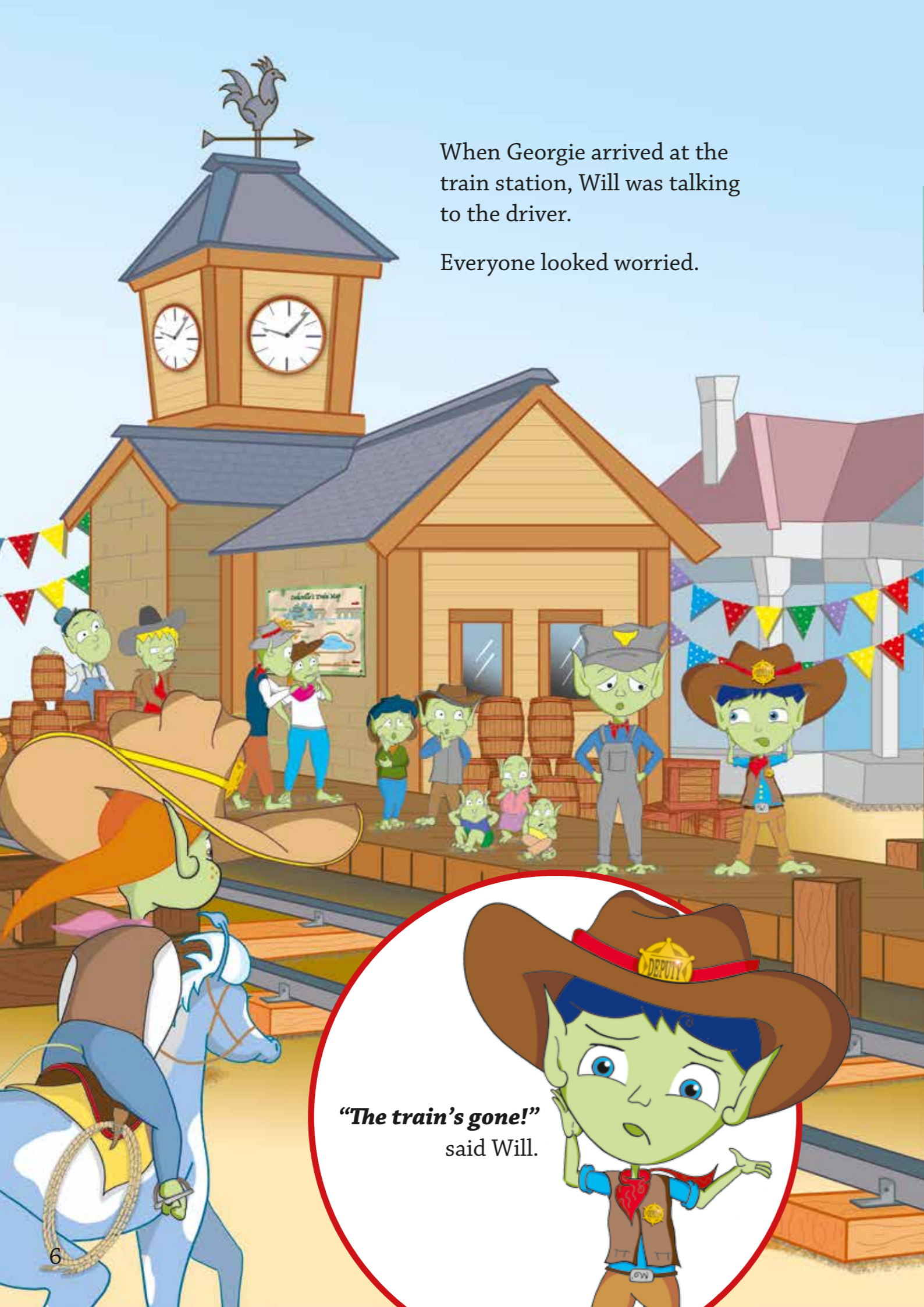
Will loved trains and couldn't wait to get there.

that she recognised.

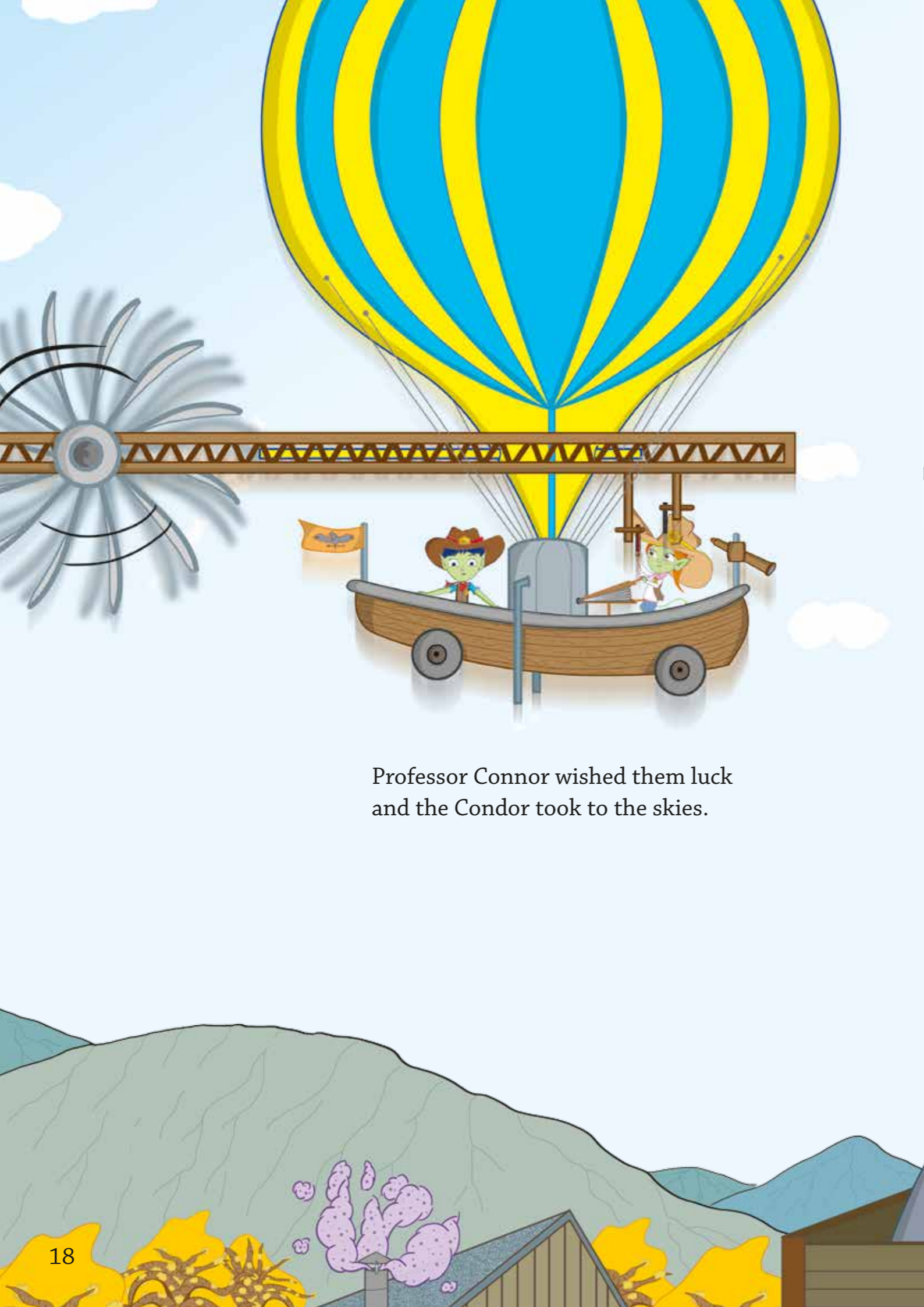


"I have an idea,"

the door **creaked** open.

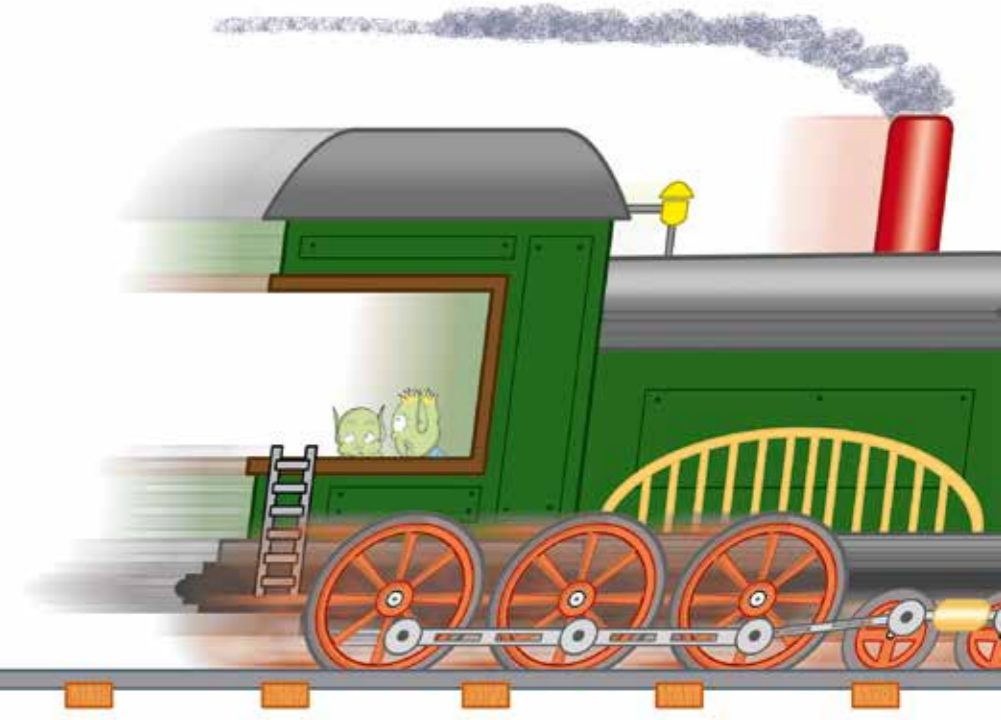


"Hello Professor Connor," said Georgie. "We need your help."

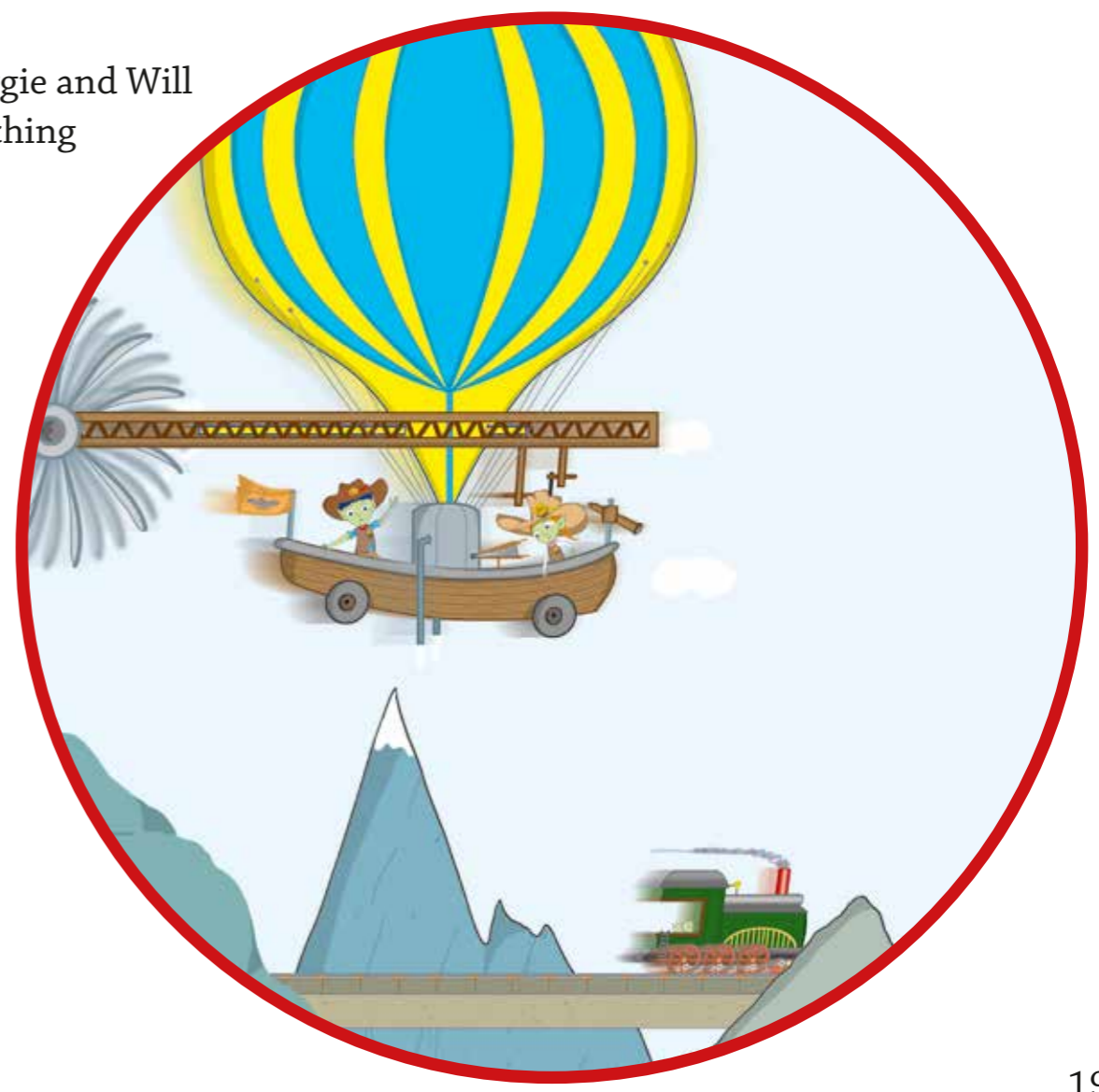


Professor Connor wished them luck and the Condor took to the skies.

Meanwhile, in the runaway train, Bobsie and Loulou were steaming closer towards the broken bridge.



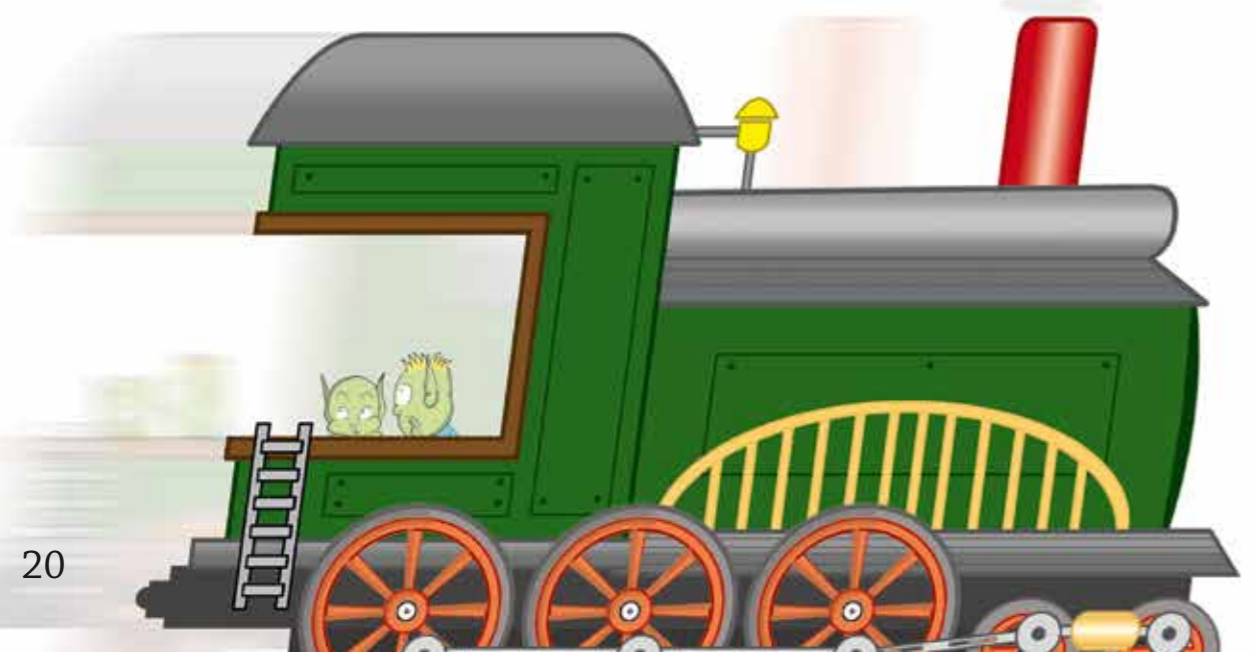
But Georgie and Will were catching up fast!
