## **MODIFIED ROUTE INFORMATION TO RECREATION IN ISLAND COUNTY**

Island Transit is operating on a new Modified Service Plan to provide the community with more access to public transit as Island County advances to Phase 3 of Washington's Safe Start plan during the COVID-19 pandemic. The Modified Service Plan provides more service than has been available since March, and shifts some resources to high-demand areas to better serve the community.

Several Island Transit routes are running past state parks and trail heads. Below is bus route information to Island County recreational sites with links to current bus schedule information. ## **WHIDBEY ISLAND**

### **Clinton**

#### **Clinton Beach Park**

Take [Route 1 Southbound](#) or [Route 60](#) to the Clinton Ferry dock. Just north of the dock is a small park that's very friendly for those with mobility challenges. A blue mat is laid across the sand which allows people using wheelchairs or walkers access to the beach.

## Coupeville

### **Fort Casey State Park**

### **Kettles-Rhododendron Bike Path**

Take [Route 1 Southbound](#) or [Route 1 Northbound](#) to Main Street in Coupeville. The trail parallels the highway for 2 miles from Winter Hawk Lane to Rhododendron Park.

### **Keystone Spit**

Take the [Route 6](#) to the Coupeville Ferry Terminal and walk 2 miles east on the beach to Driftwood Park. You can flag the bus down at the east end or walk back to the Ferry Landing where there are restrooms and picnic tables.

## Freeland

Take [Route 1 Southbound](#) just south of Classic Road ask the driver to stop at Pacific Dogwood. There are 7 miles of trails here. This is a flag stop for the Southbound bus. (No access northbound.)

## Greenbank

### **Greenbank Farm**

Take [Route 1 Northbound](#) or [Route 1 Southbound](#) to the stop at the end of Smuggler's Cove Road. A gate in the fence allows pedestrian access to this park with 4 miles of trails in the woods and across the fields with views of the water to the east and west.

## Langley
