Below is a summary of our public community meeting held regarding the above referenced zoning application.

Position: Opposition
Date of Meeting: April 14, 2015

Location of Meeting: Palumbo Recreation Center, 10th & Fitzwater Streets.

Participating RCO's: Bella Vista Neighbors Association (BVNA) Zoning Committee **Number of Attendees:** Approximately 20 excluding zoning committee members

Reason for Position:

The applicant seeks to convert an all residential RSA-5 district structure into a hair salon at the 1st floor with one accessory flat wall sign, and one (1) apartment to span the 2nd and 3rd floors. The application has been refused for the proposed commercial use, multiple uses in the district, and excessive signage area. The applicant did not present any hardship related to the zoning request.

Only one nearby neighbor attended this meeting. Of those in attendance who voted on this case, five (5) were opposed, and six (6) were not opposed. However, given that many neighbors who live on this block do not speak English, a neighbor and member of the Asian community canvassed the block and obtained ten (10) petition signatures from residents nearby and on the block who opposed the application.

Given the existing mainly intact residential character of this block of Washington Avenue, other than several businesses at 10th Street end, and at the 9th Street corner, BVNA feels that the block should maintain and reinforce its residential quality and integrity, and thus opposes the application.

BVNA therefore opposes the application. As always, we thank you for considering our report of the meeting discussion, and of our opinion in the matter.
