It is now managed by RTITB (industry-led body) which allows DVSA to concentrate on driving test supply needs.

We can help you become a qualified LGV Instructor and join the register for the recognised NRI. We offer a choice of training programmes.

Choose the appropriate course according to your existing skills and qualifications. Training is conducted at our fully integrated Test Centre.

Training fees include a fully equipped training vehicle (either C or C+E) with a fully qualified, experienced instructor. Training is arranged on a 1 to 1 or 2 to 1 basis, depending on the type of course and qualifications you hold.

A duration of 4 to 8 hours per day is allocated for training, depending on experience and qualification held. Also, number of candidates.

Novice / Initial Course

A course for experienced LGV drivers who wish to deliver LGV driver training and who have not been formally trained as an instructor before.

10 days

Assimilation Course for a Qualified or Experienced Instructors

Example, RTITB FLT Instructors or ADI's, etc who are LGV Licence holders and have been formally trained.

7 days

Existing experienced LGV Instructor seeking formal qualification

Suitable for people with at least 2 years full time practical experience delivering LGV driver training. 5 days

Renewal of NRI LGV Instructor Qualification

3 days

Fees are quoted per candidate and subject to VAT at 20%.





Training content

All 4 Parts of the Examination is delivered on last day of training. Part 3 & 4 examination scenarios are provided 3 working days before your exam to allow for preparation time.

PART ONE- THEORY TEST - 90 minutes test, 100 multiple choice questions covering instructional techniques, legislation, The Highway Code and Safe driving and testing. The overall pass mark is 85% and you also need to achieve a minimum of 80% in each of the 4 subject areas.

PART TWO – PRACTICAL DRIVING ABILITY- A minimum 1 hour drive. You cannot incur any more than 6 driving faults and you must not incur any serious or dangerous faults. You will be asked to do one of two off road exercises (chosen on the day by the examiner).

PART THREE – IN-CAB TRAINING- A 60-minute role play in-cab training test. This test has 3 parts as follows:

- 1. 20 minutes Deliver training for a new skill 33/47
- 2. 20 minutes Remedial Training for a candidate suffering skill fade 27/39
- 3. 20 minutes Demonstration drive & commentary (post-test failure) 51/73

PART FOUR – CLASSROOM TRAINING a 30-minute role play/ test of classroom training. The pass mark is 84/120.

After Successful Completion of the 4-part examination, to finalise enrolment, a completed registration form agreeing to the terms and conditions must be sent with all documents for approval. The registration number / photocard will be issued within 10 - 15 days and will be valid for 5 years.
