General Business:

- Review of Halloween Event: We hosted a Family Halloween party on October 15, 2016 at the Watt Farm House and had numerous families attend at a cost of \$5.00 per family. We had five professional pumpkin carvers participate at the event. Everyone had a great time. Pumpkins were donated by Collins' Valumart and Almaguin Parklands Campground. The Historical Society brought in \$110.00 in revenue for the event.
- 2. Christmas Craft Sale: A craft sale is being held on November 25-26, 2016 by the Agricultural Society. We will set up a table for the event. Volunteers for the craft table include Betty, Linda, Wilma and Dona. Betty will set up the table on the 25th and Linda volunteered to man the table from noon Saturday (26th) til close. Betty will co-ordinate times with the other volunteers.
- 3. Christmas Cookies with Mrs. Claus Event: On December 11, 2016 from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. we will hold a Christmas Event at the Watt Farm House. Admission will be \$5.00 per family Children will decorate cookies with Mrs. Claus, Santa will attend and Cathy Still will play Christmas carols on the piano. Diane Brandt advised that Nancy Kyte offered to help by making royal icing and Diane will confirm details directly with Nancy. Cookies will be made by Linda, Rakel, Betty, Lisa, Bruce and Nancy Kyte. Charlene will donate gingerbread cookies and the plastic bags for icing. Items that are required include food colouring, sprinkles, chocolate chips, smarties, etc. Charlene ordered a Mrs. Claus outfit through Open A Party, a party supply website along with crafts for the event.
- 4. *Heritage Co-ordinator Update:* Trina Chatelain reported on the last month's current and future projects. A newsletter was presented to Members for review and posting to the website. Grant application through Canada Cultural Spaces Fund is in the process of being submitted for shelving and display cases. Funding will be around 35-50% of the cost. Trina has been preparing for year-end close up of the Watt Farm House. Cataloging of artifacts continues.

Diane has also been in contact with Dick Watt and he indicated that he will look for a photo of the house and also check with Bill Watt to see if he has one.
- 6. Canada 150: Diane Brandt is the Historical Society's Representative and will report to Members on the event status once she meets with Canada 150 Committee Members from Ryerson, Armour and Burk's Falls. The meeting will take place once a response is received from the provincial funding request. Diane indicated that the Farm House event will focus on farming with a trapper, maple syrup and tractor display. Linda Maurer indicated that R.C. Weidmark in Magnetawan has antique tractors. The School House event focuses on logging and steamships. Archives of Ontario will loan a farming display to the Farm House for June-July 2017. (Since the meeting, Trina Chatelain confirmed with Charlene that Archives of Ontario will loan the farming display from June 12 July 31, 2017). Linda Maurer confirmed that she has been in contact with Steve Mulligan and he will put on the logging display for Ryerson's Canada Day celebration at the School House.

Trina will plant the tulip bulbs under the Watt Farm House sign.

- 7. *Kitchen Stove*: Jerry Brandt offered an Annex stove for the Watt Farm House. Members reviewed and declined on the offer as the item is not from the era that is being promoted in the Farm House. Members thank Mr. Brandt for his offer.
- 8. Santa Claus Parade: This year the theme is Silver Bells and is an evening parade on December 3, 2016, starting at 6:00 p.m. Linda will speak with Nieves to see if the Historical Society can share a float again with the library.
- **9.** *Farm House Christmas Decorating:* Linda, Betty and Charlene will meet on Saturday, November 19, 2016 around noon to decorate the Farm House for Christmas.
- 10. T-Shirts: This item was deferred. Additional input from Members is required.
- 11. 2017 Goals: Members focused on the Canada 150 Event.

Antique Cash Register: Linda Maurer informed Members that Steve Mulligan donated an antique cash register and two historical books to the Historical Society. The items were obtained from the old Thompson Machine Shop. We will use the cash register at the Watt Farm House gift shop.

TRI Council Meeting: Linda Maurer advised Members that she attended the October 24, 2016 Shared Services Meeting between the Village of Burk's Falls, Township of Ryerson and Township of Armour and presented our Annual Report. 

Summer 2016 in Review!

This year the Historical Society was able to hire two summer students: Luke and Victoria. Trina also worked on contract as Heritage Coordinator. This was made possible through the Young Canada Works and Canada Summer Jobs grants in cooperation with the Municipalities. They accomplished a lot over the course of the summer, and worked hard every day to further the vision of the Burk's Falls and District Historical Society.

As a first priority, the students worked on cleaning, updating, and refreshing the displays throughout the Watt Farm House. They also contributed significant support in the preparation for Heritage Day and showed amazing visitor service skills on the day of. They have created an updated gift shop inventory that lists all merchandise, and a sales record sheet to track all sales made. They were able to greet visitors to the Farm House and provide information on the displays.

They worked on updating our catalogue records, and organizing the collections storage areas. This has led to easier access of the collection for researchers and staff. Over the course of the summer they effectively photographed and scanned approximately 850 artifacts, inventoried 360 artifacts with updated locations, and catalogued 170 artifacts with detailed information on their appearance and condition.

We would like to formally thank Young Canada Works, Canada Summer Jobs, and the Municipalities for all their support.

This season the Watt Farm House saw a total of 315 Visitors. Wilma Bentley also reported that the Wiseman Schoolhouse saw a total of 451 visitors with a record number of 35 on Sunday Oct. 9th!

Heritage Day 2016!

Heritage Day took place on July 23rd at the Watt Century Farm House, and was a great success. The Historical Society was fortunate enough to host about 100 visitors. The event featured wagon rides, refreshments and various exhibits.

Our busiest exhibit was our 162nd Battalion exhibit, which was set up in the livingroom area. This exhibit featured summaries of service records of the 162nd Battalion, information on the medals awarded to the 162nd Battalion, and a WWII military style jacket, which was loaned to us by the West Parry Sound Museum. Another District popular attraction with the children was the gun display and military truck set up by the Algonquin Regiment. There was a great presentation of the Colours being brought in by the Burk's Falls Legion, which was accompanied by the Callander Pipe Band. This presentation then lead into various speeches and an unveiling of a new plaque to be put in the Farm House recognizing various donors in their financial support. On this day, the museum's regular exhibits remained accessible to the general public, and were operated bv the event's volunteers.

More about the Hearse...

The hearse on display in the Watt Century Farm House garage is currently owned by David Opatovsky and is on loan to the Burk's Falls and District Historical Society. This particular hearse was driven in the Magnetawan's Fall Fair in 2007 by David Opatovsky as well as Lisa Armstrong, who is the undertaker for Opatovsky Funeral Homes. The horses who pulled it also pulled the fire hose in town in their off-time. This hearse was driven by Nicholas Bennet and owned by Joseph Hilliar, whose names are plated on the hearse.

In Canada, black horses were common for funeral processions for men. Unmarried women and children were provided with white horses as an alternate. The processions would carry the individuals from their home to the cemetery, where the burial was completed.



British Home Children Day

On September 29th at the Watt Farm House the Historical Society hosted a British Home Children Day. Dona Crawford presented some of her amazing research, showed a video, and shared various artifacts and pictures. About 16 people attended the event. Everyone was really engaged in the material, and excited to learn more about British Home Children.
