Mike Quinton will look into selling picnic table raffle tickets at the Lake Cecebe Regatta on Sunday, August 6, 2017 at the Lions Club Park in Magnetawan. Diane Brandt will attempt to obtain a letter of support from Magnetawan Council.

<u>Schoolhouse:</u> Wilma Bentley presented to Members a report on visitors, sales and donations. Ryerson's Canada 150 Event of June 24, 2017 is estimated at 114 visitors, July 1 – 16, 2017 brought in 95 visitors. Total visitors to the schoolhouse this year is estimated at 255.
