Treasurer's / Financial Report was presented by Charlene Watt. Main bank account balance was \$9,189.97 on September 30, 2017. Psychic Day raised \$615.00. Committee Reports:

Membership Committee: Lorne Main advised that the Historical Society remains the same as the August report and has 26 paid Memberships for 2017.

Heritage Centres:

Schoolhouse Report: Wilma Bentley provided a written report on the schoolhouse 2017 operating season. Total visitors for 2017 was 612. Total visitors for 2016 was 451. The full written report is attached.

Farm House Report: Diane Brandt advised members that the total "signed in" visitors at the farm house from January was 381 with over 636 volunteer hours documented. Psychic Day was extremely successful with 20 people booked for each of the two sessions and raised \$615.00. Each session ran two hours long. The Halloween party that we celebrated this past Saturday (October 21st) brought in 17 families and raised \$85.00. The second annual Halloween Party was well received, thank you to our many volunteers, professional pumpkin carvers: Grant Ralston and Brad Crozier and to Collins Valu-Mart for donating 40 pumpkins (25 large and 15 small). Next year, we will consider having a haunted house event.

Archiving: Diane Brandt advised members that the handwritten accession records from 1996-2015 have been all been entered into a computer. Archiving books and artifacts from the schoolhouse is now being worked on. Diane has obtained help from Marg Burgess with the creation of catalogue cards. This task will begin in the New Year. Archiving is a large ongoing task.
