1. Correspondence:

Diane Brandt received an email from the Bradford Library offering the historical society a couple of newspaper editions from the Burk's Falls Arrow dated December 4, 1940 and July 20, 1938. Diane responded advising that the historical society would like the copies.

2. Heritage Day – Historical Society Update:

Members discussed the plans for the day. A guest book will be placed outside in attempts to get people to sign it. Flyers are still to be distributed throughout local businesses. Flyers have been dropped off at the local schools for circulation to students. The gift shop will need volunteers for the day. Mike Quinton offered to man the gift shop. Charlene will follow up with the Archives of Ontario regarding the anticipated date for the display's arrival. The tents will be set up a couple days before the event.

3. Heritage Day – Armour's Update:

Charlene Watt presented a written report on the events for the day and estimated costs incurred to date by the Township of Armour. A draft site plan was discussed. Volunteers for the day are required for parking, inflatable attendants and to monitor the grounds.

4. Watt Farmhouse Sign:

Rosalind Hall advised Members that BACED will not permit the heritage sites on their signs. A written request is to be sent to the Village of Burk's Falls asking for the directional sign to be placed at the corner of Yonge Street and Ontario Street.

5. Schoolhouse Repairs:

Rosalind Hall presented red siding samples for the schoolhouse. Members selected the Richmond Red colour. Rosalind expects a quote sometime this week and will look into obtaining funding for the heritage site's maintenance/repairs.

6. Schoolhouse:

Wilma Bentley reported that the schoolhouse has had 42 visitors since the 2018 opening weekend. We had 21 visitors since the Victoria Day long weekend. Revenue for June includes \$2 for a calendar and \$25 in donations.
