He is a graduate of the FBI’s National Academy and holds a certificate in law enforcement education from the University of Virginia. He successfully completed the Crisis Leadership in Higher Education seminar at Harvard’s Kennedy Graduate School of Education. Ronnell resides in New Haven, Connecticut.

Lee Struble is President of WSM Trainers and Consultants (*est. 1996*).
