The Lord opened the door for this study and the online group grew from 35 to 75 women that are currently going through the study.

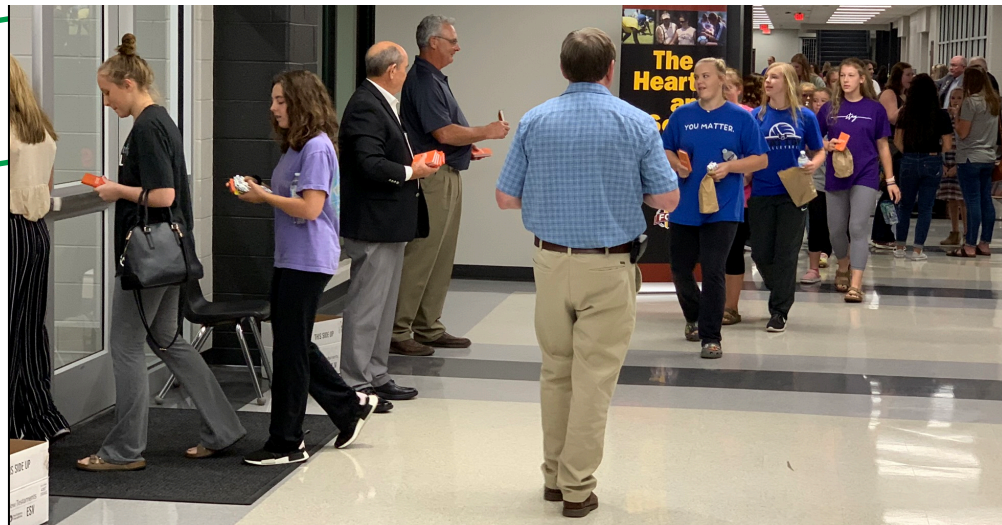
This fall I also began a weekly Bible study with the UNA Volleyball team as well as a monthly Bible study with the Athens High Softball
