- Inform the Community Connector of availability
- Respect confidentiality
- Immediately report incidences, accidents or concerns to the Resource Specialist

Time Requirement

Flexible. We prefer a commitment of an average of 2 hours per week

Requirements

- A current, valid "G" driver's license
- Satisfactory Police Vulnerable Sector Check (cost reimbursed after two months and 16 hours of driving)
- An annual 3-year uncertified driver's record with at most three demerit points (reimbursed after two months or 16 hours of driving)
- \$2M liability insurance
- A registered, insured and inspected vehicle
- Good verbal communication skills
