

Proper grooming is important when entering your dance class, therefore please review this document carefully. Uniform items can be found at Energetiks (Ivanhoe) or Bloch (Doncaster) under Studio V lists. Should you have any questions about your uniform please speak with your teacher.

BALLET

Level 1 & 2 Ballet Exams

- Pink leotard (ensure this is the correct shade of pink when visiting in-store)
- Pink full circle skirt (ideal skirt is sold at Energetiks in Ivanhoe)
- Pink tights (convertible style) • Pink leather ballet shoes
- Hair in a bun

Level 3 and above Ballet

- Black velvet bust/cotton lycra bodice area leotard (ideal leotard sold at Energetiks)
- Pink tights (convertible style)
- Pink leather ballet shoes with elastics for Level 1-4; ballet ribbons

Level 5+

- Pointe shoes required for Pointe Students (12 years and above, post approval)
- Ballet ribbons must be added to ballet slippers from Level 5 onwards
- Hair in a bun
- No ballet skirts are worn in either classes or exams from level 3 and above

JAZZ & TAP

Level 1 & 2 Jazz & Tap

- Black velvet bust/cotton lycra bodice area leotard (ideal leotard sold at Energetiks)
- Tan Jazz tights (convertible style)
- Black hot pants (shorts)
- Black leather Jazz shoes for Jazz (no laces, slip on jazz shoes)
- Tan Tap shoes for Tap (flat tap heels)
- Hair in a high pony tail/bun

Level 3 and above Jazz & Tap

- To wear the exact same uniform as listed above for Level 1 & 2 Tap
- Tan Tap shoes for Tap (Level 5 and above can have Cuban Tap Heels)



PLEASE NOTE: If students are going straight from Ballet class into a Tap/Jazz class, change of tights or leotards is not necessary for classes. Levels 1 & 2 students will need to change into the appropriate shoes when changing dance styles and remove their ballet skirts for jazz and tap. Hot pants should be worn underneath the skirt when arriving to class for a quicker change. For Levels 3 and above, students will just need to change their shoes and put on their hot pants over their leotard.
