HIDDEN DANGERS

Watch out for low branches and trees in the river.

HIGH WATER

Unless you're an expert, rivers are very dangerous for canoeing in spate or flood - keep off if the water is brown or red in colour.

WILDLIFE

Keep your eyes open for kingfishers, otters, heron, water voles, red kites, dippers and salmon. Go quietly to avoid disturbing them.

ACCESS

From The Boathouse upstream to Fenni-fach rapids, there is year-round access to the river. For the rest of the river there are restrictions. Please see: www.wyeuskfoundation.org

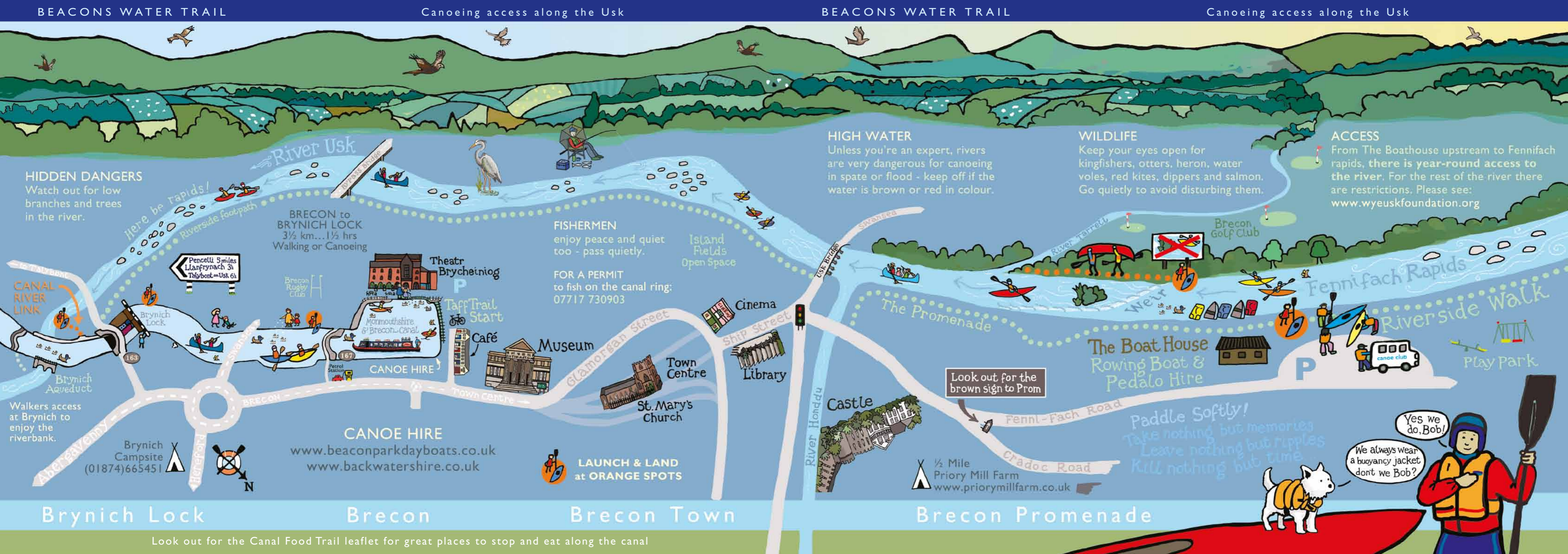
